Due to the diversity of composition, texture, color and characteristics peculiar to the various Marbles used throughout the world, the MARBLE INSTITUTE OF AMERICA, with the knowledge gained in extensive practical experience of its members in handling Marble, has classified Marbles into FOUR groups, the basis of classification being the CHARACTERISTICS encountered in FINISHING.

These groupings should be taken into account when

specifying or purchasing Marble for use in buildings. For the convenience of the buyer, these groups are designated by the letters A, B, C, D. While the characteristics of the various Marbles are important in connection with the work of FINISHING the material, they do not indicate relative excellence and do not interfere to any great extent with the installation at the building. Only with Groups C and D is an exception made; the setting space and thickness should be increased if necessary, if liners are required for reinforcement.
