tremendous explosion. Although debris was located over a large area, only small pieces of an airplane could be located. No body parts could be located at that time, with the exception of what appeared to be a face lying on the ground. Since it was just the frontal skin, with no form or skull, the identity of the person could not be determined. Several small items of personal identification were located, which indicated this was almost certainly the aircraft that Governor Carnahan was on. After approximately 15 more minutes of searching the area for survivors, I believed it was apparent there could not possibly be any survivors of the crash. The deputies, fire personnel, and troopers then left the crash site so it could be sealed as an evidence scene. Two deputies remained as site security, and two troopers joined them a short time later. They remained at the crash scene for the rest of the night as security for the evidence scene.



- 10. This investigation continues.





#### COLLECTION OF ITEMS FROM ROGER CARNAHAN'S OFFICE

1. In continuing the investigation into the death of Missouri Governor Mel Carnahan and his son, Roger A. Carnahan, which occurred on October 16, 2000, in Jefferson County, Missouri; on October 19, 2000, at 0930 hours, I received a telephone call from request ing assistance gathering information pertinent to the investigation.  advised that Roger Carnahan's remains had not been positively identified. He requested that I go by Mr. Carnahan's law office in Rolla, Missouri, and attempt to lift latent fingerprints from his desk, which could be used for comparison with prints collected from one of the victims, for identification purposes.
2. At 1000 hours, October 19, 2000, I contacted date of birth a secretary employed at the Law Office of Carnahan, Carnahan, and Hickle, 406 North Main Street, Rolla, Missouri, telephone number 573-364-5134. allowed me access to Roger Carnahan's office and advised that it had not been used since his death. She also authorized the removal of any personal items from the office for processing of latent fingerprints by the Highway Patrol's Crime Laboratory. The following items were collected and delivered to the crime laboratory in Jefferson City:
a. twelve (12) latent fingerprints, lifted from Roger Carnahan's office desk;
b. metal notary seal;
c. black plastic notary seal;
d. assorted campaign papers and client case log;
e. computer mouse;
f. microphone from Mr. Carnahan's "Dictaphone";
g. white plastic cosmetic bottle;
h. black desk telephone; and

She stated she would have more tissue samples ready to relay to the laboratory at approximately 1200 hours. contacted and requested he relay the additional samples to the laboratory in Jefferson city. relayed several samples and more samples were relayed via Patrol aircraft later in the afternoon. A total of nine tissue samples were taken to the laboratory and DNA testing was initiated at approximately 1500 hours. I was advised by Director of the Laboratory Division, that the testing process would be completed in approximately 12 hours. I advised him to contact me when the results of the testing were known. 6. At approximately 0300 hours on October 21, 2000, contacted me at the Holiday Inn in Festus, Missouri. He advised that six of the nine tissue samples had been positively identified through the DNA testing process as those of Roger Carnahan. Two had been identified as those of Chris Sifford and one as Governor Carnahan. At approximately 0800 hours, I contacted and advised her of the test results. She advised she would make arrangements to return the remains to the family for burial later that day. 7. On Saturday, October 21, and Sunday, October 22, 2000, I assisted with the actual search of the crash site. Each cordoned off section was thoroughly searched with the aid of metal detectors. On Saturday, small portions of human remains continued to be located along with small pieces of aircraft wreckage. On Sunday, only small pieces of wreckage were located. On Monday, October 23, 2000, the scene was released. Prior to its release, and agents with the Federal Bureau of Investigation made one final walk through. They photographed and video recorded the scene to document its condition at the time of release. Aerial photographs were also taken. 8. the lead investigator for the NTSB, requested that the Patrol complete a 72 hour history of the activities of Roger Carnahan, the aircraft pilot, prior to the crash. She also requested we investigate any possible cellular telephone calls made from the aircraft by the three occupants prior to the crash. I assigned to complete the requested investigations and report back to







On Friday morning, October 20, 2000, at approximately 0845 hours, used a total station to record the remote elevations of the tree tops that were obviously struck by the plane as it approached impact with the ground. They continued mapping the area to reference the crash scene to Old Lemay Ferry Road, the closest roadway. They concluded this mapping at approximately 1400 hours.
1.	At the conclusion of mapping each day, I prepared a diagram from the data that was collected on that day to document the progress made in the recovery of the body parts and debris. Because they were not complete diagrams of the crash scene, I did not retain those files or diagrams.
m.	In total, three electronic data files were generated with data recorded by the total stations. Electronic file #00-1016body-parts contains Sokkia map data, DXF file, and two diagrams that I generated showing the location of the body parts recovered at the crash scene. Electronic file #00-1016planeparts contains Sokkia map data, DXF file, and two diagrams that I generated showing the location of the significant plane part debris at the crash scene. Electronic data file #00-1016remote contains Sokkia map data, DXF file, and two diagrams that I generated showing the remote elevations of the tree tops that were struck. These diagrams can be produced at larger scales using a plotter at the office of Crash Team Two.
n.	With regards to the electronic data that was generated in this crash investigation, I maintain it in the case file that is stored at the office of Team Two, Missouri State Highway Patrol Major Crash Investigation Unit, Wentzville, Missouri.
0.	At this time, my part of the investigation of Governor Carnahan's plane crash is closed.


