Payment of the balance of the requested project funds (\$34,629) is expected within the next two weeks. Project expenditures during this report period were reduced and ERIM will not begin new data processing efforts until receipt of funds is confirmed. Two EREP S-192 CCT's (tape nos. 700564 and 700565) were received by the Northern Prairie Wildlife Research Center on September 6, 1974 and immediately forwarded to ERIM. An evaluation of these tapes will be undertaken in the near future.

Expected Accomplishments During the Next Reporting Period:

The S-192 CCT's will be evaluated for their quality. If satisfactory, they will be converted to ERIM format and water recognition processing begun.

A major processing and analysis effort will be undertaken in the processing of S-192 digital data.
