## STARTING THE GAME

## TO START THE GAME;

1, Moke sure your Nintendo Entertainment System (NES) is tumed off.
2. Put the Chompianship PoaiGame Pak in pour NES.
3. Turn on the NES.
4. At the title screen, press Start to open the Gome Mode screen.

5. Use the Control Pad to seloct a Game Mode then press A. Ses Uting Menus.

Challenge - One plaver con proctioe six gomee and pool skils. such as shopting, speod. aceuracy, and touch.

Party - Up to eight ployers con parly down with fungames and special gome tecture
Freestyle - Woke lo you own games! Drag balk for a unique fack of place them anywhere for o trick shot.

If you chocse Freestyle. you ge drectly to the poo toble. For other modes, more screens appeor to help you set up the game you want to ploy
4. Press $\sqrt{ }$ or $A$ and $A$ to select an option.

## MAIN MENU

From onv gome you con press Start to gpen the Man Wonu Press v or $\Delta$ and $A$ to select an option, including

Move Cue Ball - Awailable whenever vou hove boll in hard. See glossory
Show/Hide Numbers - In an cverheod view shows or hides numbers on object bolls.

Game Control-Gpen the Gome Controlment.
Actions - Open the Actors menu.
Back to Game - Retum to the gome in progress,

## ACTIONS MENU

From the Mon Menu you con press For $A$ and A to open the Ackors menu, which includes these options:

Special Actions - You can Call a Safety, Reject and Break, or return to the game in progress. See the Glossory:
Insla-Win - In Party mode vou can declare yourself an insta-winner return to the game in progress, see the Glossary,

View Reploy - Watch an Instant Replay of the last shot.
Scorebeard - Soe plaver scose for the game in progreas. Not ovolcable in Freestyle.
Ledve (or End) - End current mode. At the "Are you sure? prompt. choose Yes.

Bock to Game - Return to the gome in progress.

GAME CONTROL MEND
From the Monin Monu, you con press $\overline{\text { F }}$ or $A$ ond $A$ to open the Game Controf menu, which includes these options:

Move Balls Around - Use the Control Pod and A to select a bal, then use
the same control to ploce the ball. This cption is only cualable in Freestyle
Spol Balls - Spot balls which were sunk on the previous shot, or spot the lowest numbered ball that has been sunk. This cption is only cualicible in Freestyle.

Set Power - Adjust the power of your stot. See Soeciol Fectures.
Set Spin - Aciust the spin of your cue ball. See Speclol Features.
Zoom In/Out - Same ass pressing select to chonge the toble viow between overheod and closeup.

Jukebox - Tum music on or off.
Back to Game - Return to the game in progress.

## SPECIAL FEATURES

## SET POWER

On the Gome Contrimenu press For $A$ and $\mathbf{A}$ to choce Sel Power and open the power meter,


1. Press ond to set the power of the shat,
2. Press A to go back to the gome.

## SET SPIN

On the Gome Contol menu, press w or $A$ and A to choose Set Spin and open the spin meter.


1. Presp and 4 and $A$ and $v$ to set where the cue hits the ball.

While in the closeup vew, you can look around the toble without movig the curar. To do this, hold down the Select button while Presing $\boldsymbol{\Delta} \boldsymbol{V}$ - or 4 . To move the cursor, jut use the Control pad.

## HISTORY OF THE SPORT OF BILLIARDS

Tthe sport of billiards. or poo, hos been popular since the 15th Century. Originally ployed orby by kings cnd noblemen, pool started as a kwn game similar to croquet. The general public culckly adepted it, however. and brought it indoors, on to a wooden toble covered with green cloth to simulate gross. Rails, supposed to resemble river barks, were added to the table to keep the bols from falling off. Shot made by bouncing talk off the roils, or "bonks." came to be called "bankshols.

The term "billiad" is probcbly deriwed from the French "billart" tor wooden stick lagtead of usirg croquet mallsts, the bulls were shoved using wooden sticks called maces. The mace had a large heod and was difficult to use when the bull by near the rail of the toole. When this hoppened, the ployer would tum the moce around and use the hondle to hit the ball. The honde was caled a "queue." meoning toil. which later becume the modern word cue."

No one seens to know exacty how billigros come to the United States. but it was pobobly orought over by the Dutch and English setters in the 1600 s. The game was enjoved in the Colones ond George

Wothinglon reportedy won a math in 17.48. Its populatty peaked during the Clvil War period. when biliads resulls received more nows covergge thon the wor. Todcy. Eillord scenes in current movies and novels couse surges in the numbers of now enthusiosts, who fock to local pool holls to try their hand at this oge-old skill.
Pool has waged a constant bottle fo Iespectability The very nome "pool' means c collect ve bet or ante, and it was the ossociction with betting proctioes that sulied the reputation of the gome, In the 19 th century, a poolrgom was a place for betting on horse roces. These betting patios often hod pod tobles installed so the patrons could poss the time between races. Even though questionoble activitios were more likely to hove come fron the betting ond not the billiards. the two become connected in the puklic mind.
Fortunately, oillidd hos regoined espectobily, Contemporony billiord hals cater to upscale clientele. offering quality equipment ond exper instrustion. Wen and wamen are onse agoin erioying the game of kings and queens.

CHANAPONSHIP POOL

### 14.1 CONTINUOUS

## GAME DESCRIPTION:

Each oloyer must call both the boll and the pocket. You get a point for every correctly colled, gall' pocketed boll, and continue a turn until you miss or toul

## OBJECT:

The tist player to score a set number of points (is, 25.50. 100, of 150 ) wins the garme.

## RULES:

- The first ployer must either call which ball will be pocketed. or make the cue ball hit the bols and then a custion, olus make two cbiect bulls hit a eushion. If this kn't done, a two point penalty is assesed.
- llegcily pooketed talls cre spotted with no penalty
- A plaver who gets three fouk in three successive shots is asessed a 15 pont penalty. The foul count is then clecred to zero.


## ROTATION

## GAME DESCRIPTION:

Each boll has o point walue equal to its rumber, The lowest numbered acil must be hit first

## OBJECT:

The plyer with the most points wins the gome.

## RULES:

*The cue ball must contact the lowest numbered ball first, ony legaly pocketed ball counts

- You don't have to coll the shots.
- You keep shooting until vou miss or foul.
- You lose after three consecutive fouls


## FIFTEEN BALL

GAME DESCRIPTION:
In Fifteen Ball the player does rot hove to call either the bull or the pocket. Scores ore awarded bosed on the numerical volse of the ball.

## OBJECT:

The plaver who soores the greatest number of polnts cusucly inwolwes pocketing the balls with the highest numerical value) wins the game.

## RULES:

- You shoot until you miss
-Alter the break. the cuo boll must hit on object ball and ether pocket it or the cue boil must rit the cushion.


## STRAIGHT POOL

## GAME DESCRIPTION:

Stralght Pool is o combination between Conthuous and Fliteen. While the ployer coes hove to cal the object ball as in Continuous, the pocket does not need to be coled. Eoch ball pocketed is one count orscos.

QBJECT:
The player who seores eight bals betore the opponent does wins he gome.
RULES:

* You shoot unt you miss.
- You must call the oblect ball but don't need to cal the pocket


## CHAMPIONSHIP POOL

## EQUAL OFFENSE

## GAME DESCRIPTION

There are a set number of rounds (1,3,5.7. of 10$)$ with a moximum of 20 points per inning. You shoot until you miss, foul, or pocket the moximum number of allowed bolls for eoch inaing

## OBJECT:

The ployer who sccres the most points after aset number of incings wins the gome

## RULES:

- You can shoot any ball but must call both the ball and the pocket.
- Additionall pocketed bolls do count toward the score.
* The player shoots unt he misses,
- The shoofing order depends on the soore of the prevous inning. with the highest scorer shooting tirst. If a tie, the order remcins lle seme.
* Sudden deatn" determines the whoner if there is a tie at the end of the set number of rounds.


## SPEED POOL

GAME DESCRIPTION:
In Speed Pool the ployer coes not have to coll elther the ball or the pocket, Soores ore owaided bosed on the time taken to pocket the bolls

OBJECT:
The player who pockets all 15 bolls in the fastest tme wins the game. In Challenge. you must beat the clock.

RULES:

- Each player koeps shooting until all bols ore pocketed.
- If vou scratch. vou get the cue ball in hand anywhere on the toble ond keep gong.


## GLOSSARY OF BILLIARD TERMS

## BALL IN HAND. Cue ball can be put into play arywhere on table.

BANK SHOT. A shot where the object ball is bounced againt a cushion
before it is pocketed.
BREAK. The frit shot of the gome
CALL A SAFETY. Position the cue ball in a spot that leoves the next plaver with the toughest shot.
CALL SHOT. A shot where the olayer must declare in aovance which ball will go into what pocket.
CENTER SPOT. The exgot center point of a toble's ploying surfoce.
CENTER STRING. An imogirary line between pockets 2 and 5 that
oloses the center spot.
COMBINATION. The cue ball propels one object ball into another to make line shot.
COUNT. A score or successful shot.
CUE. Wooden stick used to strike cue boll.
CUE BALL. White unnumbered ball struck by the cue.

CUSHION The cloth covered rubber that borcer the inside of the rols CUT SHOT. A shot where the cle ball drwes the object ball at on angle (also coled asice).
DIAMONDS. Maraings on toble rails that are used as target or
reterence points.
ENGLISH. Side spin appled to the cue ball by striking it off center; used to alter the notural roll of the cue boll andior ebject boll.
FOOT OF TABLE. The end of the poo toble where the balls cre roeked
at the beglning of o game.
FOOT SPOT. The peint on the toot end of the tatle where imoginary Fines intersect.
FOOT STRING. An imoginary line between the fifth diononds of the bng rols that croses the foot spot.
FOUL An iniraction of the rules which usually results in a penaly,
GAME BALL. The boll which produces a win when pocketed.
HEAD OF TABLE. The end of the pool table from which the opening break is made.

HEAD SPOT. The point on the heod end of the toble where imgginary lines intersect.
HEAD STRING. An imaginory line between the sesond diomonok of the long rais that croses the head spot
INNING. A ployer's turn of the foble.
KISS. Contoct between balls
MISCUE. Cue doesn't contact cue boll propery
OEJECT BALL. Any called ball except the cue boll ona shot.
OPEN BREAK. Requirement in sorne games where tour object bolls must hit the cushion on the break.
PASS AFTER FOUL. Atter a tout, ooss your tum to the next plover.
PASS AFTER PUSH. Make a push shat, then pass vour tum to the plaver thot mode the push shot.
POCKETED. A ball hos been surk in a pocket.
POCKETS. There are sixpockets on a pool toble inte which vou shoot the bolls.
POSITION. The cue boll's resting proce after a shot enos

PUSH SHOT. The cue lip maintains contoct with the cue ball longer thon the spit second allowed for a nomal legally stroked shot,
RACK. Trangular device used to put balls into position before breck.
RAILS. The edges of the table, The heod and foot ralls are short, the right and left rais are bong and are defined from the hecd of the table focing the foot
REJECT AND BREAK, In certain games you can rorack and rebreak.
REJECT AND PASS. Reject a break, then pass your turn to the next Pocyer.
RUN. Tolol of conseculwe scores made in one inning
SCRATCH. A shot sending the cue ball into a pocket.
SHOT. Begins when cue touches cue boll and ends when all balls stop moving
SPOTTING BALLS, Replocing pocketed balls on the table in a specific place.
TRIANGLE. Some os rack.
SPOT BALLS IN KITCHEN. Replocing bolls in the oreo behind the head string.
