AN URGENT REQUEST FROM JAMES H. MADOLE TO ALL MEMBERS AND SUPPORTERS OF THE NRP:

Dear Racial Comrades:

The National Renaissance Party won its greatest legal victory in July, 1967 - at which time, by a vote of six to one, the New York State Supreme Court recognized the NRP as a legitimate political party with both the right to pursue ballot status and the right to utilize public buildings for mass rallies. Hundreds of our members in the New York-New Jersey area will recall the many times we have rented private halls and studios only to have the owners cancel our meeting and refund our rental at the last minute. Many times our people travelled a long distance to excercise their right to "freedom of assembly" only to find the doors of the prospective meeting place slammed in their faces because fearful owners had been intimidated by threats of picket lines, personal violence directed against themselves or their property, or loss of business through boycott directed against restaurants or bars whose owners had dared to grant the NRP the right to meet on their premises.

We held our first major indoor rally in the last 4 years at PS 169, in the heart of York-ville, on December 8, 1967. Some 100 faithful racial comrades attended this initial rally together with a mere 4 Jewish hecklers wearing Mashe Dayan eye patches. These idiots were promptly silenced and the meeting proceeded without any further disturbance with speeches by James Wagner, Cammander of the uniformed Security Echelon (SE), Richard Bayer, a dynamic new NRP speaker, and myself, James H. Madole, as National Director of the NRP. An extremely stimulating question and answer period followed the meeting.

It is my intention to organize the American public into a potent force representing the interests of the White race in the United States. This could not be accomplished while our right to hold organizational rallies was prohibited through fear of private hall owners to rent us their facilities. Now that our right to peaceably assemble has been enforced by the courts, I intend to hold at least one mass rally each month. I further intend to distribute, both through the mail and on the public streets, at least 5000 announcements of each rally! These flyers will also be recruiting leaflets so that recipients may fill out coupons to either join the party or its militant fighting arm, the Security Echelon!

The proverbial 'fly in the ointment' lies in the fact that users of public buildings may neither collect funds nor sell literature on the premises during the course of meetings. Each meeting costs us, including the fee payable to the New York Board of Education, cost of flyers and postage for mailing invitations, at least \$ 75 with no remuneration in the form of collections or book sales !

Unless we take advantage of this legal victory the White people of America can never be organized effectively. If we cannot speak to the public and present our viewpoint of Racial Nationalism for their careful appraisal and debate how can we expect to build an effective political mass Movement that can effectively compete with the entrenched Jewish Liberal Establishment?

We know that Communists, Negroes, and Jews rush to support their organizations whenever appeals for specific goals and purposes are mailed out. Will those who profess concern for the future of their White race do the same?

I can only plead with people in New York and New Jersey to attend our rallies and I urge every recipient of this letter who desires these meetings to bring masses of disenfranchised Whites into the organizational framework of the NRP to obey that patriotic impulse and send the largest contribution you can afford to promote the continuation of these rallies. The clipping below, taken from the June, 1967 issue of "CHALLENGE", organ of the pro-Maoist Progressive Labor Party, will show you the effectiveness of the young White fighters in my Security Echelon far better than any words of mine. Your contributions help build this white militia through mass rallies at which recruits are obtained.

## Nazis Recruit White

## "Army"on West Side

The National Renaissance Party—a Nazi organization which follows the racist theories of Adolph Hitler—has started a recruiting drive to build a private army on the West Side. This group openly calls for violence and terror against Negroes and Jews in the community...with the ultimate goal

of racial extermination.

A leaflet mailed from a West Side post office—and giving a West Side return address—calls on all "physically fit White Americans." It asks them to join the "Security Echelon (SE) or uniformed section of the NRP. (which) is being organized to defend White neighborhoods from rampaging Black Mobs and to counteract the hordes of filthy

Jewish Beatniks, sexual deviates, and Communist organizers."

THE RACIST LEAFLET continues: "The blood-crazed hordes of Black revolutionaries must be beaten into the ground by thousands of young white men in the gray, black and gold uniforms of a militant white man's party.

A Black worker on the West Side was mailed the leaflet by mistake. Outraged, he called CHALLENGE.

"It is clear," he said, "that this Nazi recruitment is part of the government's plans to engineer race wars this summer. It fits in with the government's arming of white racists in Cleveland and other cities... and with the use of police helicopters to patrol the ghettos.

"If the government can stir up lynchings and race wars," he said, "then they will divert attention away from their war of genocide in Vietnam."

"I HOLD THE GOVERNMENT responsible for this leaflet," he ended. "The cops probably paid for it. And the leaflet only states openly what the government is already practicing in Vietnam."

CHALLENGE asked the opinion of several Latin American workers who are influential in the community. (The Newstalso consider Latin Americans a "slave race" and hence as targets of genocide.)

Said one worker, a Dominican: "The Nazis better think twice before coming into our neighborhood. We Dominicans know how to fight; we proved that in the 1964 revolution when we fought against the Nazi types in our own country."

AND ANOTHER LATIN-AMERICAN said, "The government tried to use the Cuban gusanos for the same purpose two years ago. Everyone remembers what happened at 109th St. and Columbus. Now the gusanos don't dare to show their faces around here."

"The Nazis," he predicted, "will have the same fate."

CHALLENGE interviewed an authority who has spent many years studying ultra-rightist groups. He pointed out that the National Renaissance Party, based in New York, is the most dangerous and serious of the Nazi groups in the U.S.

"WHAT MOST PEOPLE DON'T KNOW is that, in spite of its racism, it works in a united front with Harlem ultrafascist groups such as the African Universal Church and African Nationalism, Inc. In fact, the NRP once had a Black Brotherhood auxiliary."

WILL THESE FASCIST GROUPS be used to help stagemanage the government's race riots this summer?





The entire meeting seemed to be a shouting match between the NRP supporters and the hecklers in the audience, with most of the supporters hurling anti-semetic comments and the audience responding with similar anti-Nazi remarks. ### DETAILS:

### I. ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

### A. Headquarters

The "National Renaissance Bulletin," Volume 19, Numbers 1, 2 and 3, January, February and March, 1968, reflects the headquarters of the National Renaissance Party (NRP) to be at 10 West 90th Street, New York, New York, Apartment 8, 4th Floor.

A characterization of the NRP is contained in the appendix attached hereto.

### B. Officers

JAMES H. MADOLE, founder of the NRP, continues to serve as National Director and HENRY S. POTWOROWSKI serves as the National Secretary.

### C. Objectives

On June 7, 1968, NY T-2 furnished a copy of a National Renaissance Bulletin dated January, 1968 captioned "An Urgent Request From James H. Madole To All Members and Supporters of the NRP", which reflects in part as follows:

"The National Renaissance Party won its greatest legal victory in July, 1967 at which time by a vote of 6 to 1, the New York State Supreme Court recognized the NRP as a legitimate political party with both the right to pursue ballot status and the right to utilize public buildings for mass rallies. Hundreds of our members in the New York - New Jersey area will recall the many times we have rented private halls and studios only to have the owners cancel our meeting and return our rental at the last minute...

"...We held our first major indoor rally in the last four years at PS 169, in the heart of Yorkville, on December 8, 1967. Some one hundred faithful racial comrades attended this initial rally together with a mere four Jewish hecklers wearing Mashe Dyan eye patches. These idiots were promptly silenced and the meeting proceeded without any further disburbance with speeches by James Wagner, Commander of the Uniformed Security Echelon (SE), Richard Bayer, a dynamic new NRP speaker and myself James H. Madole, as National Director of the NRP...

"...It is my intention to organize the American public into a potent force representing the interests of the white race in the United States...Now that our right to peaceably assemble has been enforced by the courts, I intend to hold at least one mass rally each month. I further intend to distribute, both through the mail and on the public streets at least 5,000 announcements of each rally! These flyers will also be recruiting leaflets so that recipients may fill out coupons to either join the party or its militant fighting arm, the Security Echelon!"

On March 1, 1968, JAMES H. MADOLE was interviewed by Special Agents (SAS) of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). and at NRP Headquarters, New York City. MADOLE stated in part, he will continue his activities as in the past such as distribution of NRP literature, street rallies, counter-demonstrations etcetera, as long as he feels that he can act as an effective counter-measure to "communist and communist inspired activities".

He stated there is no question in his mind that the current JOHNSON administration is playing right into the hands of the United States enemies with its continued policies of operations in Vietnam. The American people according to MADOLE are "fed up and disillusioned with heavy tax burdens to support the 'Welfare state' in this country". He does not have to exert himself to gain support and members for the NRP because the continued lack of confidence the people show in the JOHNSON administration and what it stands for plays right into his hands. He merely has to sit by and wait until the day dawns when the NRP philosophy of less government control of business, proper waging of the Vietnam war and return of America to the prominent position it deserves in this world is achieved.

MADOLE said the white people of this country are becoming increasingly alarmed over the cries "Black Power," and violent exhortations of such individuals as RAP BROWN and STOKLEY CARMICHAEL. The people who built this country are not going to sit back and watch it being destroyed by irresponsible black hoards.

School Meetings NRP school meetings were held at PS 169, 113 East 87th Street, New York City, on February 2, March 22, April 26, and June 14, 1968. The activities which took place at these meetings are as follows: On February 2, 1968, spoke about the SE, stating that they are good white Americans who do not want drug addicts or hippies. The main purpose of the SE is to get out in the streets and get word to people about how the Negroes and Jews are ruining America and if it is to be saved, white men must stick together. stated that the Jews do not want the Vietnam war to end because they would lose billions of dollars a year in Government contracts. The third speaker, stated "there is no such thing as a Jew." They are Nomads who stole land from the Arabs and call it Israel. They are a bunch of long nosed, kinky hair, ugly creatures." During MADOLE's speech, he stated he respects North Vietnam because they are fighting for their own land. We had no right or reason to be there in the first place. He does not expect the black man to fight for America just as black men could not expect white men to fight for Africa. The Negroes obviously do not love America and would be

better off in Africa where he belongs.

A woman in the audience stood up and denounced MADOLE as one who was against the American Indian. She said MADOLE did not give a damn about America. While she shouted, MADOLE smiled and said "I don't hear anything. Some people have big mouths, but I don't hear nothin."

NY T-5 February 2, 1968.

On March 25, 1968, NY T-6 advised that before the meeting at PS 169 on March 22, 1968, approximately 140 Jewish War Veterans milled around the entrance to discourage people from entering the meeting. The audience consisted of approximately 40 persons. The meeting began at 7:30 pm, and lasted until 10:00 pm. JAMES MADOLE stated during his speech that the government wants employers to hire unskilled Negroes and fire skilled whites. Police forces are being handcuffed so they are not allowed to stop riots by "lawless Blacks". Jews want control of the world finances and are using Negroes for this end. Negroes, however, will kill the Jews first when they try to take over.

On March 23, 1968, NY T-3 advised at the above meeting the Jewish War Veterans left shortly after MADOLE started speaking. During MADOLE's speech, he spoke against Jewish organizations which control this country, and criticized the United States (US) Government for policies dictated by such organizations which policies can only serve to destroy the position of the US as a world power.

On March 25, 1968, NY T-7 advised that at the above school meeting National Broadcasting Company (NBC) Television crews were on the scene and a very drunk unknown man demanded that the television crews stop taking photographs of the Jewish people in the audience. The man was arrested when he struggled with members of the New York City Police Department (NYCPD) who attempted to eject him from the hall.

During the speech by MADOLE he stated that no country on earth will tolerate the Jews the way the US does.

On April 29, 1968, NY T-8 advised that at the school meeting on April 26, 1968, there were numerous arguments among the audience. During the speech by MADOLE he stated that MARTIN LUTHER KING was a Communist. Jewish publications were responsible for the "no win war". Jewish leaders such as BENJAMIN SPOCK were responsible for defection of American soldiers because of agitation on the home front.

On June 14, 1968, NY T-6 advised that at the school meeting that day, the audience consisted of approximately 40 persons for the meeting which lasted from 8:00 pm, to 10:00 pm. Speaker number one was who tried to speak about the SE. The second speaker, JAMES MADOLE, tried to speak about Jewish influences on the world and the nation. LOUIS MOSTACCIO tried to speak about how the white race	,
must stand up and fight for itself.	
About 15 Jewish youths led by a "Jewish lawyer" made so much noise they drowned out the speakers.	
The lawyer tried to take a photograph of who knocked the camera out of her hand. She ordered	
a policeman to arrest on an assault charge. requested the policeman to arrest her on an invasion of privacy charge. Both were taken to the police precinct. Later they appeared back at the meeting.	\
On June 17, 1968, NY T-9 advised that at the school meeting on June 14, 1968, there were approximately 50 persons present which included 20 NRP supporters and 30 hecklers. The entire meeting seemed to be a shouting match between the supporters and the hecklers, with most of the supporters hurling anti-Semitic comments, and the audience responding with similar anti-Nazi remarks. Approximately 10 New York City Policemen were present throughout the meeting to maintain order. Among those present was who follows the activities of extreme Right-Wing and Left-Wing groups.	\

## D. NRP Outdoor Rallies

public schools reopen in New York City.

The NRP announced they would hold rallies in New York City, on August 3, and September 7, 1968. The following events transpired at these rallies:

On August 1, 1968, NY T-6 furnished a flyer announcing the NRP was sponsoring an open air "White Power" rally on August 3, 1968, at York Avenue and 84th Street, New York, New York, between 7:00 pm, and 10:00 pm.

On August 5, 1968, NY T-6 advised that approximately 10 NRP members were assembled on the corner of 84th Street and York Avenue in connection with the rally scheduled to be held on August 3, 1968.

At approximately 6:50 pm, the rented sound truck pulled up to the location and stopped. The driver looked at the crowd of approximately 200 spectators, the police barricades and approximately 50 police officers; without making contact with JAMES MADOLE or any other NRP member the driver drove the truck away.

MADOLE upon seeing the sound truck depart, called off the street meeting.

On September 9, 1968, NY T-3 advised that the NRP had a rally at 86th Street and Second Avenue, New York City, on September 7, 1968, from 8:00 pm, to 10:00 pm.

The principal speaker at the rally was JAMES MADOLE who delivered his usual anti-Semitic distribe. He received little attention except that he was pelted with eggs by some of the onlookers.

## E. Literature Distribution

Literature distribution by members of the NRP took place in New York City, on the corners of 86th Street and Third Avenue, 86th Street and Lexington Avenue, Battery Park, and the Coliseum.

On February 2, 1968, NY T-8 advised that literature was distributed for the rally to be held at PS 169 on February 2, 1968.

On January 27, 1968, NY T-6 advised that 3,000 invitations to the PS 169 rally on February 2, 1968, were distributed at 86th Street and Lexington Avenue.

On March 3, 1968, NY T-6 advised that 1,500 recruiting leaflets for the SE were distributed on March 2, 1968, at the New York Coliseum Sports Show. Many favorable as well as unfavorable responses were received from persons who were given the leaflets. A Xerox copy is on page 26.

On March 19, 1968, NY T-6 advised that 2,500 invitations for the NRP school meeting to be held March 22, 1968, were distributed at 86th Street and Lexington Avenue.

On April 15, 1968, NY T-6 advised that literature for the school meeting to be held April 26, 1968, would be distributed on April 18 - 19, 1968.

On June 10, 1968, NY T-6 advised that on June 8, 1968, 2,000 invitations were distributed at 86th Street and Lexington Avenue, for the school meeting to be held June 14, 1968.

On June 24, 1968, and July 1, 1968, NY T-6 advised that SE recruitment literature was passed out at Battery Park on June 22 and June 29, 1968.

On July 31, 1968, NY T-6 advised that literature was distributed on July 26, 1968, announcing the NRP rally to be held on August 3, 1968.

## F. NRP Counter-Demonstration

On April 29, 1968, NY T-8 advised that on April 27, 1968, the NRP counter-picketed a peace parade which was held on Fifth Avenue between 92nd and 72nd Streets. Nine NRP members were on the corner of 86th Street and Fifth

Avenue where they held posters including "Keep White Power or America Will Die", "Karl Marx was a Jew", "Zionist is same as Communist", "NRP Supports Wallace for President".

# G. Attendance at Right-Wing Convention April 20 - 21, 1968

On April 23, 1968, NY T-6 advised that a meeting of Right-Wing organizations was held at the Continental Hotel, Washington, D.C., on April 20-21, 1968, which was sponsored by the White Party of America under the name of the Assembly of Racists Movement.

The object of the meeting was to consolidate the forces of the various Right-Wing groups throughout the country in order to fight the Jewish and Negro problems existing in the country today.

Some of the ideas proposed were the exchange of speakers and advertising with a list of RightsWing organizations and immediate releases throughout the country of press releases concerning an issue that should be brought to the attention of the people of the US as soon as possible.

Four members of the NRP including JAMES H. MADOLE attended the convention.

### IV. FINANCES

The primary source of revenue for the NRP is from the sale of NRP publications. There are no known benefactors currently supporting the NRP.

### APPENDIX

### NATIONAL RENAISSANCE PARTY

On May 29, 1968, a source advised that the 'National Renaissance Party (NRP) was founded in 1949, by JAMES H. MADOLE, who continues to serve as its National Director and is in complete control of the NRP.

The source further stated that the NRP has its headquarters in the residence of JAMES H. MADOLE at 10 West 90th Street, New York, New York. Weekly meetings are held at this location on Thursday evenings.

The source described the NRP as an anti-Negro, anti-Semitic and neo-Fascist organization.

This source stated on July 28, 1966, that JAMES H. MADOLE, as of October, 1965, distributed a printed "program of the NRP", which program had as its announced purpose the establishment of a "Racial Nationalist State". According to the program, this would be accomplished by calling a Constitutional Convention to ratify the necessary amendments to the United States Constitution in order to carry out the NRP program for the establishment of a "Racial Nationalist State".

This source further advised that as of May 29, 1968, this "program of the NRP" remains in effect and that the anti-Negro and anti-Semitic nature of the NRP is exemplified by the following excerpts from this program:

- l. Enact and rigidly enforce legislation to restrict the benefits of American citizenship to mentally and genetically sound members of the Caucasian race.
- 2. Enact legislation to prohibit intermarriage between white and non-white.
- 3. The Jewish race shall be deprived by suitable legislation of their American citizenship and shall henceforth be prohibited from holding any professional, political or educational posts within the Racial Nationalist State. The Jew constitutes an alien virus in our national bloodstream and, as such, he must be purged from our cultural, economic, and political life.
- 4. Enact legislation to hasten the repatriation of American Negroes to the newly independent black nations on the African continent under the auspices and guidance of black nationalist leadership in the United States.

On November 26, 1957, a source advised that the United White Party (UWP) was organized at a convention held in Knoxville Tennessee, on November 10, 1957. An article in the November 26, 1957, issue of the "Greenville Piedmont", a newspaper of Greenville, South Carolina, reported "the recent formation of a new political party, to be known as the United White Party."
According to the article, the party was formed at a recently held meeting in Knoxville, Tennessee, at which many klansmen were

National States Rights Party" (NSRP), reported that rank and

In November, 1958, a source advised that NSRP is composed of past members of the Klan-type organizations and notorious anti-Semites.

Issue No. 19, dated June, 1960, of "The Thunderbolt" announced the address of the headquarters of the NSRP had been changed from Jeffersonville, Indiana, to Post Office Box 783, Birmingham, Alabama.

Issue No. 69, dated July, 1965, of "The Thunderbolt" announced the address of the new headquarters of the NSRP as Post Office Box 184, Augusta, Georgia.

On August 4, 1965, a source advised that EDWARD R. FIELDS, the Information Director of the NSRP and Editor of "The Thunderbolt", is the individual who actually controls the NSRP.

Issue No. 72, dated November, 1965, of "The Thunderbolt' reflects Dr. EDWARD R. FIELDS to be National Director of the NSRP as well as Editor of "The Thunderbolt".

"The Thunderbolt" continues to publish articles attacking Negroes and persons of the Jewish faith.

### WHITE PARTY OF AMERICA

On September 16, 1965.

who identified himself as the White Party of America (WPA), advised that he, along with several other former members of the American Nazi Party (ANP), formed the WPA during the early part of 1964, in order to advance the cause of the white man in the United States and eventually throughout the world.

This organization was officially launched on April 11, 1964, when it sponsored picketing in Washington, D.C., Richmond, Virginia, and Baltimore, Maryland, in opposition to civil rights legislation and civil rights demonstrations. Its national headquarters was transferred from 1216 New York Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C., to 1019 King Street, Alexandria, Virginia, on April 1, 1965.

It was initially the alm of the WPA to sponsor picketings and demonstrations where it was believed such would be of value and to publicate its program through pamphlets and similar media. The WPA has been inactive due to a lack of funds and its only publications to date have been the April and May, 1964, issues of its official publications, "The White Letter."

He added that the WPA is still in the formative stage but it will uphold the Constitution of the United States and will always act within the limits of the law. He noted that the WrA will serve as a "home for people who want to preserve the white race" and cannot find a home for themselves in either of the major political parties in the United States.

A characterization of the National Socialist White People's Party, also known as the American Nazi Party, is set out separately.

The National Renaissance Party (NRP) is the only hate-type organization active in the NY Division.


The NRP headquarters is located at 10 West 90th Street, New York, N. Y.

JAMES H. MADOLE, the founder of the NRP continues to serve as National Director and is in complete control of the Party.

HENRY VON SIENNO POTWOROWSKI is currently serving as the National Secretary of the NRP.

There are no officers in the NRP other than MADOLE and POTWOROWSKI.

Currently membership is approximately 20.

The only persons in the NRP for whom reports are submitted on a continuing basis are MADOLE and POTWOROWSKI.

### OTHER ORGANIZATIONS

The headquarters of the Minutemen is in Norborne, Missouri. There is no local headquarters in the NYC area.

The National Coordinator of the Minutemen, ROBERT BOLIVAR DE PUGH, is the subject of 10 #4176 issued 3/20/68 in connection with a Federal warrant issued at Seattle, Wash., on 2/20/68, charging DE PUGH with conspiracy to commit bank robberies. DE PUGH currently runs the Minutemen from "Minutemen Underground Headquarters." No officers are known to exist in the NYC area.

The Minutemen arrested 10/30/66 by the NYCPD are still awaiting trial. They are not known to be collectively engaged in Minutemen type activities. One of the Minutemen arrested 10/30/66 is known to have indicated during October 1968, that the Minutemen desired to expose a "communist camp" through newspaper publicity to coincide with the second anniversary of their 10/30/66 arrest. The camp referred to was identified as the Old La Salle Riding Academy, Cherry Valley, N. Y.

Re let reflected the National Renaissance Party (NRP), acts as a clearing house for individuals who are prone to violence, who are emotionally or mentally unstable and who would under proper leadership, engage in militant acts. Under the leadership of JAMES H. MADOLE, such acts are not tolerated, and such individuals, if detected by MADOLE, are denied affiliation with the NRP.

The NRP continues to be ineffective as an organization, the informant coverage by present standards is adequate, and the organization continues to serve as a meeting place for persons who alone or in a concert with like minded individuals might perpetrate acts of violence if it were not for the restraining influence of MADOLE and his policy of nonviolence.

It continues to be the opinion of the NYO that any counterintelligence proposal against the NRP at this time would be unwarranted, and not serve the best interest of the Bureau in discharging it's responsibility in the Internal Security field.

UACB the NYO will review the status of the NRP with respect to this program on a six month basis, and advise the Bureau by letter on an annual basis, unless reason to the contrary exists.
