Gentlemen

at the last regular meeting of the above
body held on Tuesday April 15th the following resolution
was passed

That in connection with the City Council
& inform them that as strongly protest any effort to
grant a right of way for a new line for the City.

We the members of the Board of Trade & Commerce
have a clear recollection of the confusion & inconvenience as
experienced when the last improvement in daylight saving
was adopted by this city. This is best substantiated when
we realize that the railways will still retain standard
time which means that our members of the family will be
obliged to follow on time while the rest of the family
will be governed by another creating endless confusion.

We submit that if the following is adopted in the city
and to take advantage of the law of daylight then we
may & must go then to be so without incurring

the railway men who represent a large ~~and~~ population
of the citizens of New York & an irreparable situation

that the proposed daylight saving law be not adopted
or that a vote of the citizens be taken before
so doing.
