and that an Alternative Writ of Mandate and Stay Order should issue,


IT IS ORDERED that an Alternative Writ of Mandate issue in this case directing

1 Respondents City of Los Angeles and Police Chief Michel R. Moore and their agents,
2 employees and representatives to refrain from retroactively enforcing or applying Senate Bill
3 1421's amendments to California Penal Code sections 832.7 and 832.8 in any manner which
4 would result in the disclosure or production of peace officer personnel records and information
5 regarding incidents or reflecting conduct occurring prior to January 1, 2019, or in the
6 alternative, to show cause before this Court in Department 45 located at 111 N. Hill Street,
7 Los Angeles, California on February 5, 2019 at 1:30pm why Respondents have not done
8 so; Opposition to be filed and served by 1/22/19
9 Reply to be filed and served by 1/22/19
10 The written return shall be filed on or before _____, 2019.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pending such return and hearing, and until this Court
12 otherwise directs, a Stay Order is hereby ordered prohibiting Respondents City of Los Angeles
13 and Police Chief Michel R. Moore and their agents, employees and representatives from
14 retroactively enforcing or applying Senate Bill 1421's amendments to California Penal Code
15 sections 832.7 and 832.8 in any manner which would result in the disclosure or production of
16 peace officer personnel records and information regarding incidents or reflecting conduct
17 occurring prior to January 1, 2019.
