

GETTING STARTED

Congratulations on your choice of "ESPN® Golf: Lower Your Score with Tom Kite by IntelliPlay®"! This title is designed to increase your knowledge of the game of golf and help you enhance your shotmaking skills through the use of live-action video, sound, text and slides.

This IntelliPlay title is very easy to use:

- **1.** Turn on your 3DO Multiplayer.
- 2. Put the IntelliPlay CD-ROM in the CD-ROM tray with the label side up. When you


close the tray, the program begins playing.

- **3.** Read this booklet to learn more about how the program works.
- **4.** To exit the title at any time, or rotate between discs, press the Open/Close button on the Multiplayer and remove the CD-ROM. Or simply turn off your Multiplayer.

Before you begin, make sure that you read the notice on the back cover of this manual.

Technique



CONTROL PAD

It's a good idea to get familiar with the 3DO Control Pad before you get started.

Directional Pad: Allows you to move up, down, left and right among selections and highlights them as you move.

Rewind (Left and Right Shift): Returns to the beginning of the sequence that is currently playing

- Play (A): Plays the item that is highlighted.

Search (B): Expands/collapses the topics/subtopics lists.

Exit (C): Returns you to the previous screen.

Exit Help: Allows you to return to the Main Menu from the Help Mode only.

Pause/Resume: When pressed once, allows you to pause the sequence that is currently playing. Pressing it again allows the sequence to continue.

Shot Selection

SHOT MAKING (Discs 1 and 2)

The Shot Making discs were created as instructional programs to help you master some of golf's most difficult shots. PGA great Tom Kite, along with sports psychology consultant Dr. Bob Rotella, deliver detailed instruction and helpful tips to enable you to lower your golf score by learning the intricate details of shot making.

ASK THE PRO (Disc 3)

The Ask The Pro disc was designed to increase your understanding and appreciation of golf. Tom and Bob give you insightful answers to many of golf's most intriguing questions.

TITLE SCREEN

After inserting the disc, a musical introduction to the program plays. Immediately following the introduction, the IntelliPlay program begins and you will see a title screen with two buttons.

- Press the Play (A) button to go to the Main Menu screen.
- Press the Credits (B) button to view a list of the people who created this golf program.

MAIN MENU

When you press the Play (A) button from the title screen, you advance to the Main Menu screen. From this screen, you can explore the various features of the specific disc you are viewing (Each Main Menu selection is explained in greater detail on the following pages.)

To select an item from the Main Menu:

1. Use the left side of the controller, or the directional pad (up, down, left or right), to position the highlighter on the selection you want to play.

- **2.** Press the Play (A) button (on the right side of the controller) to activate your highlighted selection.
- **3.** At any time during the program, press the Exit (C) button (on the right side of the controller) to go back to the Main Menu screen.



MEET TOM KITE, MEET BOB ROTELLA (Disc 1 only)

When you highlight and select either one of these options by pressing the Play (A) button, you are introduced to the pro of your choice.

Tom Kite is the all-time leading money winner on the PGA Tour, with earnings in excess of \$8.5 million. Kite credits Rotella for much of his golfing success, including his 1992 U.S. Open win, and for helping him achieve a winning balance between the mental and physical aspects of the game. In addition to his busy playing schedule, Tom is also involved in designing golf courses around the world.

Dr. Bob Rotella, or simply "Doc" to many of his clients, is a noted sports psychology consultant who specializes in performance enhancement. He has worked closely with Tom Kite (since 1984) and approximately 30 other PGA, LPGA and Senior PGA touring pros including: Nick Price, Davis Love III, Curtis Strange, Larry Laoretti, Pat Bradley and Juli Inkster. Rotella serves as a consultant to amateur and professional athletes in a variety of sports, as well as to national sports organizations and corporate business executives. He is the director of Sports Psychology at the University of Virginia. Rotella is also a columnist for Golf Digest magazine.

(Discs 1 and 2 only)

- 1. When you highlight and select the Instruction icon from the Main Menu, you advance to a new screen.
- 2. The new screen reveals a list of instruction topics, in yellow text, which you may scroll through using the directional pad.
- 3. Highlight the topic you wish to view with the selector bar and press the Play (A) button. You now see an expanded list of the main topics, along with more specific subtopics, in white text.

- **4.** To play a single item, highlight it with the selector bar, then press Play (A). When the item has finished playing, the program takes you back to the topics/subtopics list and you're ready to select another item.
- **5.** To expand the topic list, press Search (B). To collapse the topic/subtopic list to reveal only the topics, press Search (B) again.
- **6.** To return to the Main Menu at any time, press the Exit (C) button.

Index

The Index icon allows you to search for specific golf related terms and the sequences in which they can be found.

- **1.** Select Index from the Main Menu screen.
- 2. Using the up and down arrows on the directional pad, scroll through the list of terms in yellow text and highlight the term you wish to review. Press the Play (A) button. You now see an expanded list of sequences, in white text, related to that specific term.
- **3.** Highlight the related sequence you wish to view and press the Play (A) button.

4. To end the running sequence and return to the list of terms, press the Exit (C) button.

Remember, you can expand or collapse the term and sequence lists by pressing Search (B).

Preferences

The Preferences icon allows you to customize the look and feel of the program by letting you turn on and off the background music, sound effects, and screen saver.

- **1.** Select Preferences from the main menu screen. When you run a disc for the first time, you'll notice that all preferences are turned on.
- **2.** By using the up and down arrows on the directional pad, position the golf tee pointer next to the preference you wish to customize.
- **3.** Turn the selected preference on or off by pressing the left and right arrows on the directional pad.

4. When you've selected your preference settings, press the Exit (C) button to return to the Main Menu.

Note: Once you set your preferences, they remain set until you go back in and change them.

Help

When the Help icon is highlighted and selected, a graphic of the 3DO control pad displays. When you press each button, a brief description of the function is provided.

Directional Pad: Allows you to move up and down or left and right among topics and highlights them as you move.

Return to Menu (
):
Returns you to the Main Menu
from the Help mode only.

Pause/Resume (*/): When pressed once, allows you to pause the sequence you are currently viewing. Pressing it again allows the sequence to continue.

Play/Select (A): Plays the item that is highlighted.

(B): This button functions only when displayed on screen.

Exit (C): Returns you to the previous screen.

Replay (Left and Right Shift): Returns to the beginning of the currently playing sequence.

ADVANCE/ REWIND

If you want to view a particular instructional sequence in slow motion:

- press the right (**||) directional arrow to fast forward while a sequence is playing and the left (**|) directional arrow to rewind
- press the Play/Pause (►/∥) button
- when paused, press the right directional arrow (>>|) to "step" through the sequence frame by frame

press the Play/Pause (*/+)
 button to continue viewing at
 normal speed

(Remember, this is digitally read information, unlike actual video and may tend to look a bit jumpy when fast-forwarding and rewinding)

AutoPlay

AutoPlay allows you to explore the content without having to select items one at a time. When AutoPlay is activated, the word "AutoPlay" will appear at the bottom right corner of the screen.

To activate AutoPlay:

- 1. When you select AutoPlay from the Main Menu, all of the sequences play continually in the order in which they are listed.
- 2. When you are in a specific section, your topic selections are listed in yellow.

 Highlight a topic and press Play (A) to view all of it's corresponding subtopics from beginning to end. When all items have been played, you will return to the list of topics.
