

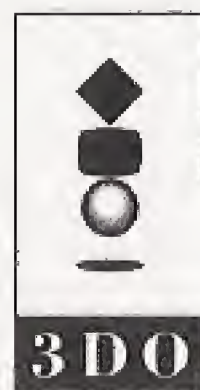

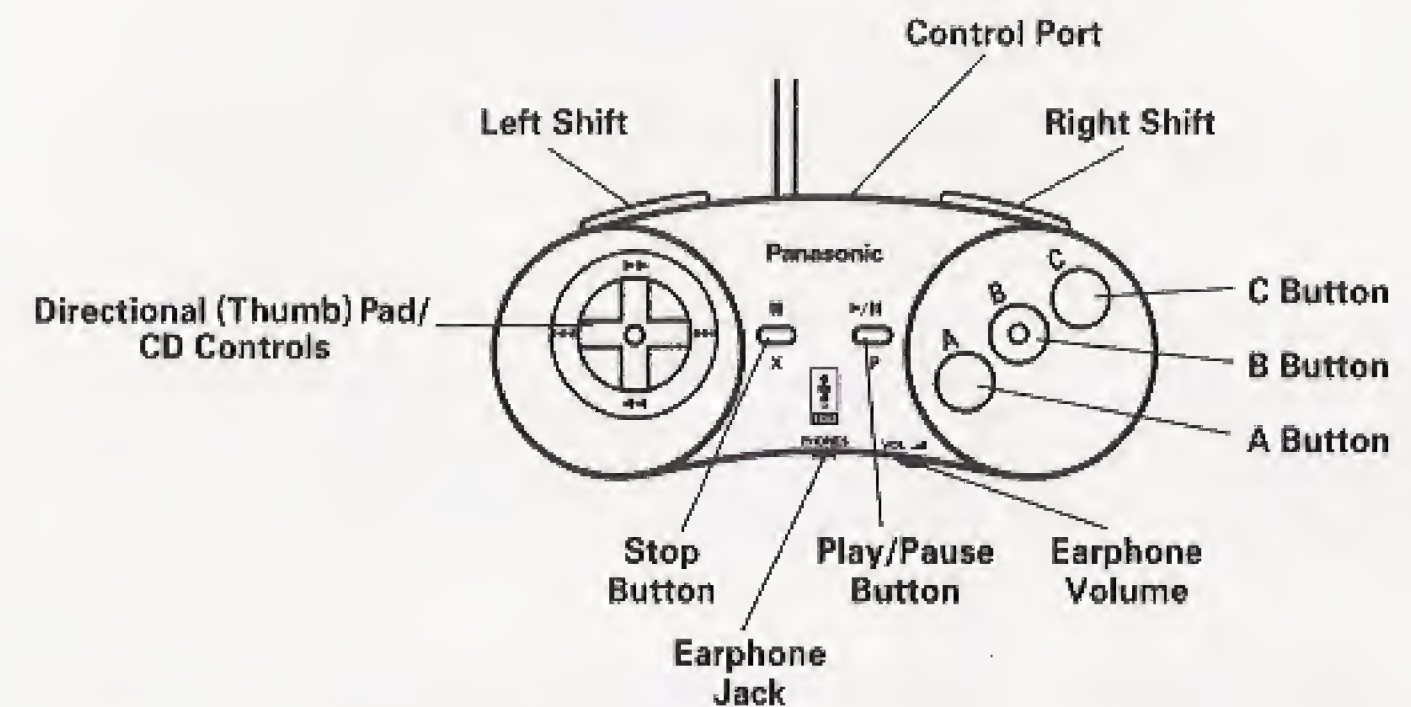
Launching the Program

To launch Space Shuttle, follow these steps:

1. Press **Power** to turn on your 3DO Interactive Multiplayer™.
2. Press **Open/Close** to open the Access drawer.
3. Put the **Space Shuttle** disc in the drawer, label side up.
4. Press **Open/Close** to close the Access drawer.
5. Wait for the program to load, then use your Controller to operate the controls.

Mission Controls

Use the 3DO Controller to explore the program.



Thumb Pad - Move the onscreen pointer to select an option.
Press **A** to choose a selected option.

A - Choose selected option. Cancel audio or video and skip ahead.
Shoot laser in the Space Game.

B - Open the Personal Digital Assistant (PDA).

Shift - In the Space Game, press either **Shift** button and use the **Thumb Pad** to move up and down in your orbit.

Program Options

You control the success of your mission through the Personal Digital Assistant or PDA.



PDA

Use the **Thumb Pad** to select a PDA command, then press **A**.
You can choose the following commands:

Orientation	Get an overview of the Space Shuttle Program.
Training	Visit the simulator facilities to learn space procedures.
Mission Launch	Go to the Control Room.
Space Game	Clean up space debris before your shield strength runs out.
Terms	Study definitions.
Help	Get Help on using the PDA.
Exit	Quit the program.
Done	Close the PDA and return to previous screen.

You can also use the **Thumb Pad** and **A** to choose any other onscreen command or pop-up, including:

Characteristics	See a general description of a Space Shuttle.
Mission Control	Visit the Mission Control center.
The Vehicles	Choose from six vehicles on a pop-up menu.

Flight Profile	See a general description of a Space Shuttle mission.
Gear	Inspect gear, such as clothing, from a pop-up menu.
Living in Space	Where and how astronauts live pop-up menu.
Working in Space	See how astronauts work from a pop-up menu.
Mission Launch	
Mission Number	Point to an arrow and press A to set a mission number, then choose another command below.
Meet the Crew	Find out who staffed the selected mission.
Launch Mission	Blast off on the selected missions.
Mission Highlights	See highlights of the selected mission from a pop-up menu.

Space Game

Clean up space debris.

Press the **Thumb Pad** to aim, then press **A** to fire your laser.

Press the **Thumb Pad** and **Shift** to move up and down in your orbit.

Press **B** to open the PDA.
