## VIEWING INSTRUCTIONS

It's easy to enjoy these cartoons on your 3DO™ System! Here's how:

Place the 3DO™ disc in the 3DO™ System tray, press the OPEN/CLOSE button and wait for the distinctive program menu to appear on your television screen. This menu contains an icon for every cartoon in this collection and a special icon for viewing all of them in one sitting.

Select the icon of your choice by pressing the joystick pad on the left of the 3DO™ controller until the one you want is highlighted. Then, press button "A" on the right of the controller, sit back and enjoy!

You may pause at any time during a cartoon by pressing the PAUSE/PLAY button on your 3DO™ controller. Watching is resumed by pressing the PAUSE/PLAY button again.

You can also jog through each cartoon in either forward or reverse by pressing the joystick pad on the right (FORWARD) or left (REVERSE) side.

If you wish to rewind a cartoon back to its beginning, press either SHIFT BUTTON at the top of the controller and the STOP button at the same time. The cartoon will begin again.

When you want to stop watching, or select another cartoon, press the STOP button and the menu will reappear on your television screen. You may then select another icon or cease viewing by pressing the OPEN/CLOSE button to eject the disc.
