Facts of complaint
Approx 12am 10/14/90 Complainant stated that CPD had received a complaint re: possible attempt to assassinate Sen. Simon.
At approx 10:55 pm 10/12 two employees (see attached) of "Bandos" Restaurant 2200 W. Lawrence were approached in said restaurant by Unsubs. Unsub 1 displayed a handgun and said that he was going to shoot Simon.
This info was not reported to the CPD until approx 10:10 pm 10/13.
During the day 10/13, Simon made a campaign stop at "Bandos". There was no assassination attempt.
[redacted] advised that the Simon campaign had been notified and the CPD was taking extra measures to ensure Simon's safety.
Simon is spending the night (10/13/90) at the Executive House, Chicago.
On 10/14 he is expected to attend services at 3rd Unitarian Church, then he will attend a debate at Channel 7 - Chicago.

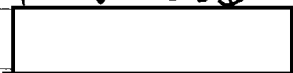

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HISTORY & INVESTIGATION:

In summary, the facts as stated in the original case report are basically correct except the offenders race is white not asian and theres only one offender. Offender number #1 was the only person to threatened to shoot the senator.

R/D's were assigned by Sgt. [redacted] of unit 611 to investigate an intimidation report in which Senator Paul Simon's life was threatened, at 0830 hrs on 14 Oct 90.

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Detectives [redacted] and [redacted] were detailed to accompany Senator Simon at the Executive House during his interim stay in Chicago, meanwhile the ongoing investigation by R/D's revealed the followings:

On the 12th of October 1990 at approximately 2255 hrs just before closing wit [redacted] a waitress at Bonlos Restaurant, 2200 W. Lawrence was cleaning the table occupied by aforementioned offender and a female companion (F/Asian, 5'03, 105 lbs, brn eyes and long black hair possibly a student at University of Illinois) when a conversation ensued. Wit [redacted] mentioned that Senator Simon would be having a fund raiser at their restaurant the following day. The offender then stated that his brother had killed someone five years ago and that he was going to shoot Paul Simon. He then unzipped his right front pocket to display a weapon to wit [redacted]. The type weapon is unknown but described by [redacted] having a brown grip. The wit [redacted] became frightened, left table and reported incident to manager/wit [redacted]. Wit [redacted] also stated she considered offender as having a mental problem and avoided further contact with him. In addition before leaving the restaurant the offender thanked wit [redacted] for the good information. Wit [redacted] interview was added by [redacted] who acted as interpreter because wit [redacted] speaks little English, she speaks Korean.

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R/D's then interviewed [redacted] who could not provide additional leads except to add that he is familiar with offender only because he chronically complains about either the food or service whenever he comes into the restaurant. Further on one occasion the female companion mentioned that she was a student at the Univ of Ill. and Malaysian.

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R/D's repeated attempts to interview wit [redacted] at 0900, 1000 and 1630 hrs on todays date were unsuccessful. R/D [redacted] spoke with him briefly at 1000 at which time he stated that it was Sunday and that he didn't have time, besides he thinks the guy was only kidding. Wit [redacted] refused to answer any more questions and refused to give R/D his address.

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R/D's attempt to contact Senator Simons campaign aid [redacted] [redacted] were also unsuccessful, phone message left for her response. In addition at the completion of interview with witnesses R/D provided them with her card and requested to be contacted if and when [redacted] returns.

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The unknown subject told the waitress that his brother had killed someone and had gone to prison. Now, he would shoot PAUL SIMON and [redacted]

The subject and his female, oriental companion left the restaurant.

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On 10/12/90, the night of the incident, waitress, [redacted] told him that a man had showed her the butt of a handgun and told her that he wanted to shoot Sen. PAUL SIMON and [redacted]. By the time he became aware of the incident, the subject had already paid and left the restaurant. The waitress told [redacted] where the man had been sitting, while in the restaurant, and he felt that he knew which subject the waitress was talking about.

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[redacted] described the subject as a rather odd person that frequently complains about the service and food quality. Yet, the subject always completely finishes the meal prior to complaining.

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The subject comes into the restaurant often, but not on any type of schedule.
