Unfenced-in graves are open to cattle. Headstones laid flat
 Abram Duffield and his wife, Hannah (daughter of the well known pioneer, Moses Moore) are buried in the small enclosed plot (picture attached).
 Abram Duffield is believed to have come to this area during the Revolution, and at the time of his death was living on the farm where the Duffield Cemetery is located. Duffield children - John, Andrew, Rebecca Jane and Nancy Ellen and their spouses are buried in a second enclosed area of the Duffield Cemetery. Martha Gay, daughter of William Duffield, and her husband, William Gay, are buried outside the enclosures.
