- (-) **RADIO PALOMA.** Can be heard from their MW fq. on a 2nd. harmonic on Sunday mornings on 4710 SW.
- (77) **P.F.B.S.** Upgrading tx to 25 to 30w &

he hopes it too be ready in about 2 weeks, will be on either 6293.33, or 6315.55khz. They are shortly using the (77) posting address which also will be used by Radio Pamela, PFBS, Europe Radio Int. (Which is a project involving PFBS, Pamela and Canzoni). The (77) posting address is: P.O.Box 1225, 4354 Datteln, FRG. R EPSILON the relay outlet of PFBS will continue to use (12) posting address. Epsilon will again be relayed possibly via Tonair soon on 6240 variable (!). Also PFBS is at present conducting a contest which you can win a Caroline British Top 500 poster by answering 1 question which is ?!

(77) **R PAMELA INT.** Steve Most the op. has built a lower power tx of 5w and high pwr transmitter of 10w which he intends to test shortly on 6298.89 on Sundays and possibly on 6.200.4 SW on a Saturday too.

(71) **RADIO PELSTAGAR.** A new station from NL hopes to come on 1508MW in March, they have been logged before on this fq. Their posting address is: P.O.Box 454, Doetinchem, HOLLAND. Which will be AL No. (71).

(2) **PODNEY'S FREE BROADCASTING SERVICE.** A joint venture between the famous free radio listener Podney R. Sixe and Pirate Andy of PFBS+ others. They went on 6015 because it was a long time since a FR st. was actually heard on the 49mb. It's future uncertain, probaly irregular.

(60) **R NEMESIS INT.** Actually dates back quite a while, op. is called Chris Patrick, if anyone is interested!

(40) **RIVERSIDE R INT.** The op. Joe Coshin who is presently running on 5w on 6210, is having built a new 50w by his friend Micheal Caine (Wasn't he in the films!) of Skywaves, and hopes it to be operational, in sometime in March this year. All reports are guaranteed with a QSL.

(2) **SOPHISTICATED RADIO SYSTEM.** Are presently testing on Sunday mornings on the 60mb (Which is becoming popular in FRG FR sts.) on either 5300 or 5310khz. Though when heard, it seems they come on for a very short while, power unknown, and come on, on the hour. They have only been heard once so far on 6235 on 20/11/85!

(58) **TAFR (TRANS ATLANTIC FR).** Who were the one's mentioned in TFRR 5 have popped up with their own pxs on 5300 and 6275 playing "I Spy F- or the DTI" by the Moronic Surveyors. They were only testing, with 30 watts from FRG. Though their address is in US, and they offer a range of US tape recordings.

(38) **R TORENVAL INT.** They'll be transmitting (tx) every 1st. Sunday of the month on 1094 MW at 0030 GMT. Occasionally via Tonair on either 6240 or 6299 SW, though I expect the tx will drift about 5khz.

(??) **WABC INTERNATIONAL.** Are hoping to come on SW every Sunday from about 13th. March on 6245 SW and 1152 MW transmitting from Ireland.

RADIO "C", Heard in Great Britain with excellent reception. Now on a daily 24 hour basis so won't report them anymore after this issue. Tx from Bolzano, Italy though they have posting address in FRG!

RECC, Anx by op. himself that they're are going to start testing on 11584 SW around the end of March, and if successful be on regular.
