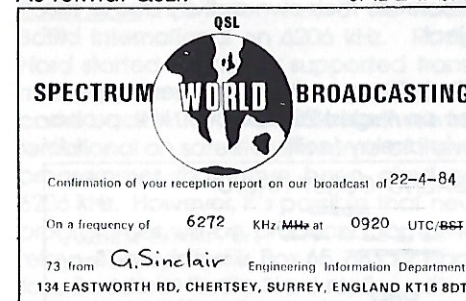

EURO PIRATE SCENE

Radio 101 International, the famous pirate from Ireland, is back on the airwaves! Old tapes from 1987 and 1988 have been noted on 7361 kHz AM, 15015 kHz AM and 27035 kHz FM in July and August. Anyone knows more about this? EA FRS

Radio Amazonia is a new German pirate who has been heard during the summer on both 48 and 76 metres. The station was noted the last time on 6206 kHz August 21st via **Radio Baltic International**. The programme format consisted solely of music from the 60's. DJ is Mr. Tequila! Address is SRS, Östra Porten 29, 442 54 Ytterby, Sweden. The station replies with an A3 format QSL!! JAL LAY SPZ



In a letter to Bruno from Tony the "Weird Beard", operator of **Angel International**, he tells that the DTI raided the station once again on July 31st at 16 UTC, but "only" the 6400 kHz transmitter was taken. So Angel is back again with a new tx. BP

A Swedish amendment to 48 metres is **Radio Baltic International** on 6206 kHz. See the separate story in this issue. SPZ

Radio Blackbeard is a new British station that was noted August 28th on 6232 kHz with techno music. Another broadcast was carried out September 18th on 6299 kHz with a listeners' letter programme. According to SRS News 35, the address is Box 1218, Chelmsford, Essex in England. However, I thought that this address was

The correct address of **Radio Black Eagle** is Box 11, 7954 ZG Rouveen in Holland. The reason for the confusion was that **Pirate Chat** published an incorrect address (Box 10). In a QSL-sheet to me, operator Gerard says he is 27 year old and has been transmitting on medium wave since 1982. 10 years later, in 1992, he made himself a 60 W short wave transmitter. The station is often heard around 6206 kHz. AB LAY SPZ

Britain's Better Music Station returned to the airwaves on July 17th with a test transmission on 6266 kHz. From now on, BBMS will make regular broadcasts once a month. Their new address is 40 Dalehead, Camden Town, London NW1, England. SWN

Radio Daiwa is a Dutch station that is heard occasionally on 76 metres. The transmitter is home-built and has a power of 8 W. The antenna is a half-wave dipole. Despite the poor power, the station is often received well. Daiwa is also active on 1400 kHz medium wave. LAY

Radio Delta from Holland was raided by the Dutch PTT and police on August 27th. The exciter, modulator and power amplifier were taken. However, operator Gertie is already back on the airwaves! SPZ SRS

Radio Dr. Tim celebrated 1-year anniversary on July 23rd via **Scandinavian Broadcasting Corporation** on 3905 kHz. Special QSL-card were promised to reporters. Next broadcasts from Radio Dr. Tim will be carried out by the **North American Pirate Relay Service** in USA. LAY SPZ

Radio East Coast Holland is back on the airwaves. Heard on September 11th with nonstop music on 6240 kHz. SRS

Free Radio Service Holland will celebrate their 14th birthday on October 14th with a 4 hour transmission full of nostalgia. It will be hosted by Joop ter Zee, Stefan Kramer, Tony Mitchell and Peter Verbruggen. The transmission will start at 9 UTC and hopefully two frequencies will be in use (41 and 48 metres). A special QSL will be offered. FRS

Radio Fusion International is back after a long summer break on 76 metres. Unfortunately, the signals from the station have been rather weak lately and this worries operator Joly Jake. He says that he will look for an amplifier and hopefully be back soon with a few hundred watts. SPZ

Halloween is a very special weekend for the pirate across the Atlantic. Do not forget to listen tune in to the 41 metre band on the night between October 31st and November 1st! Many US pirates will be active and if the conditions are good, it will be a great opportunity for us Euro DX-ers to get one or two nice US DX-catches! So do not sleep on Halloween! RB

Heavy Dude Radio recently bought a transmitter for 76 metres and a few tests have been carried out. Unfortunately, the transformer has been damaged and need to be replaced. HDR will be back in the not too distant future, be sure! JAL SPZ

Radio Hoch-Weisel was founded by German DX-er Jens Wantschar in July this year and his aim is to entertain and inform the listeners about Hoch-Weisel and its neighbourhood. The station was noted on July 23rd, August 6th and August 13th via NEXUS/IBA on 7125 kHz. Next broadcast will take place on November 26th. Address: Jens Wantschar, Butzbacherstrasse 25, 35510 Butzbach/Hoch-Weisel, Germany. FRS

International Music Radio from Basel in Switzerland is now active on 76 metres. Good signals from the station were noted here during a QSO between **Radio Pacman International**, **Lookout Radio**, **Radio Jimmy International** and **Radio Fusion In-**


ternational on September 17th/18th. SPZ

Jolly Roger Radio recently sent an interesting letter regarding a dispute with an FM pirate in Waterford, see their letter elsewhere in PC. JRR are now using their Waterford address again and are heard regularly Saturday nights from 22.00 and Sundays from 8.00 on 6230 kHz. Their signal strength is sometimes rather good in Scandinavia. SPZ

Kiwi Radio from New Zealand is reported to have a new mailing address: Box 3104, Napier, New Zealand. SPZ

The joint venture between 9 German pirate stations, **Level 48**, have cancelled all their planned broadcasts. The reason for this is that the stations find it difficult to co-ordinate the programmes and some of the stations say they have been forced to decrease their own activity due to the project. LAY

Radio Lollipop made another appearance on August 20th on 3900 kHz, probably via a relay facility. LAY

In a recent press release from **Radio Marabu**, it says that Marabu will start with programmes via the transmitter of the **Nexus International Broadcasting Association** in Milano. The programmes will be aired once a month every second Saturday between 12-14 UTC on 7125 kHz. Future dates are October 8th, November 12th and December 10th. Radio Marabu was also noted via **Radio Baltic International** on 6206 kHz with a top chart of industrial music.

The station manager of **Radio Merlin International**, Paul Watt, appeared in court on June 12th. Three weeks earlier, Paul had received 18 summons for illegal broadcasts on short wave. However, 17 of the 18 charges were declared invalid and Paul was only charged for the fact that a station had been operation in his premises. The fine was £500. Paul Watt intends to return to short wave later this autumn. FRS

Radio Mirage celebrated their 10th birthday September 18th on 7415 kHz! Several loop tapes telling about the anniversary on 41 metres were also aired on several frequencies in the 48 metre band. The programme was hosted by Marc Jones who played selections of good rock music. SRS

Swedish legendary, ex-offshore station **Radio Nord** has been heard via **Radio Baltic International** on 6206 kHz. Radio Nord started financially supported transmissions from the Baltic Sea in 1961 and came back in 1991 via **Radio Northsea International** on satellite. It's some of those programmes that have been aired on 6206 kHz. However, it's possible that new programmes will be produced for these relays. The address is Box 65, 683 22 Hagfors, Sweden. Radio Nord replies with a special QSL-card. CES SPZ

Radio Perfect is soon to be relayed via **Swedish Shortwave Relay Service**. SRS

Jorge R. Garcia, the operator of **Radio Piraña International**, has been rather inactive of late. This is partly due to a change in transmitter location. He is also about to build and test a new anode modulated transmitter of 120-150 W. Jorge will make another trip to South America in the beginning of December. He will try to come across a transmitter over there and broadcast on 13950, 15050 kHz and 48 metres, but nothing is for sure yet. EA SPZ SU

Lars reports that **Radio Ridiculous**, who also identify "RID", is back to the airwaves

on 76 metres. The station used to be rather active on 41 metres in 1985. Since then, the station's appearances have been very rare. The address is still Box 1019, 2200 BA Noordwijk, Holland. By the way, did you now that Ridiculous is an abbreviation for "Radio In Diversion Intending Communications Under Limited Options Unclassified Status"!!? LAY SPZ

Radio Royal is a new German based station project between **Radio Wahnsinn** and **Star Club Radio**. The station was heard September 4th on 6282 kHz. The station will use the maildrop in Wuppertal. SRS

Peter Laurett, the operator of **Scandinavian Broadcasting Corporation**, collapsed into unconsciousness the Monday after having relayed **Radio Dr. Tim** (July 25th). After a week in coma, he recovered but will not ever return. Peter used to relay different pirate stations on 76 metres Saturday nights. We wish you all the best success Peter and thank you for what you have done to keep Free Radio alive. EA

Radio Sockenschuss, with Mr. Ringelsocke and Mr. Hohlsocke, is a new 48 metre station which made its debut appearance August 28th on 6252 kHz. The station seems to originate from the USA and the programme included many jokes. Address is the Wuppertal maildrop. SRS

Radio Sparks is a newcomer via Nexus/IBA on 7125 kHz. Station operator Steve was born in the UK but moved to Switzerland in 1970 and is now a Swiss citizen. The first broadcast was very successful and reports were received from all over Europe, North America and Africa. QSLs, info sheets and stickers are available at Radio Sparks, Postlagernd, 4010 Basel, Switzerland. FRS

SRS News is a weekly bulletin with logs and information, similar to **The 48 Report** I published before. The bulletin is available via Internet (e-mail and newsgroup alt.radio.pirate), Fidonet, fax or ordinary mail. A must for the serious pirate DX-er.

SWR Switzerland continue their service to help hobby pirates to be relayed on 7125 kHz. The transmission schedule is now Fridays at 20-23 UTC and Saturdays 11-13 UTC. SPZ

Radio Titanic International celebrated 19 years of broadcasting on August 27th via **RWBI** on 3905 kHz. The programme included a guest appearance by Dave Scott and a faked greeting from Michael Jackson (I really liked that one!!). SPZ



Radio Viking is another new 76 metre operator who has been noted with tests and QSOs lately. The station should not be confused with the Danish station with the same name, active during the 70's. This is a Dutch station and it uses 40 W of power. You Scandinavian readers should notice that operator AI has a good command of both Swedish and Danish after his studies!! So you can write in Swedish in Danish to the station, the operator would surely be happy! Lars' reception report was the first one ever to the station. The address is Box 71, 7720 AB Dalfsen, Holland. LAY

Welle Wahnsinn/Crazy Wave Radio announced a new mailing address in their latest broadcast on September 18th on 6260 kHz. The new address is Box 411131, 55068 Mainz, Germany. The reason for changing the maildrop address is that a lot of letters were lost at the previous mail-

drop in Venlo. Station manager Chris Ise would like to apologize to all listeners who has not received a reply. If this is the case, your letter was lost and Chris urge you to send in a follow-up to their new address. The format of this station is rave/techno and the programmes are very well presented. A pity though most of it is in German. Keep up the good work Chris! SPZ

WNKR returned on 6400 kHz this summer. Dave Martin of WNKR relayed **Angel International** every week for two hours and felt that he would like to put WNKR back on the air. The return has been very successful and strenghts have been good over Europe. Even a report from New York has been received!! Another nice thing is that Andy Walker is making programmes for the station, a DJ who is appreciated by many listeners. Recently the station was robbed! During a relay somebody stole all the equipment except the antenna. Left was a small note saying "You have been raided"! The operators of WNKR will place themselves in ambush next time. Does anyone know whether this story has anything to do with the DTI raid on **Angel International**? EA FRS SPZ

DPRS MEMBERSHIP

The non-continuation of the DPRS membership seems to have disappointed quite a few of you.

The original idea worked fine for some people, but not for others. The DX-ers who sent most reports got the best value for money, while some DX-ers sent very few reports and one or two sent none at all!

It also worked the other way round for DPRS. There were far more regular reporters than occasional one, resulting in some losses at the DPRS headquarters. The membership fee was also set far too low for this ever to be a viable and sustainable idea.

To satisfy the regular reporters, who seem to hate buying IRCs (hi), I've decided to continue the DPRS membership and report forwarding scheme. However, some changes in the working procedure are necessary.

Firstly, the fee will be £15, but this is based on the number of reports sent. Therefore, if you send very few, you could finish up being a lifetime member!! So, your membership will expire after a set number of reports have been sent and not after 12 months.

You can sit back and relax. Just send the reports to DPRS and we'll take care of everything. The reports will be forwarded with return postage in the form of mint stamps. The usual letter in Dutch and a PPC will also be included.

For the £15 fee 25 reports can be sent over any time period. By any other method, taking into account the inclusion of IRCs etc, this could cost you around £25. You are therefore saving around £10 of your hard earned cash. Surely a bargain not to be missed!

You will receive the usual DPRS membership card with the addition of special tick off boxes to keep track of the number of reports you have sent before your fee expires. Taped reports will count double because of the additional postage costs.

Any current DPRS member who sends £10 will automatically be transferred to the new scheme.

Beneath the mask: Radio Baltic International

Welcome to this new column which will give you interviews and inside stories of different European Free Radio stations. The first station I will portray is Radio Baltic International, which was one of the most surprising appearances of new stations this summer. Not only because it originates from Sweden, it runs up to 400 W of power which should address the station as the most powerful Swedish short wave station ever. And it's no doubt one of the strongest short wave pirates at present! It comes as no surprise that the operator of Radio Baltic International is no beginner. He is a middle aged man, in his mid forties, nice and rather talkative. And he has been a dedicated radio enthusiast and radio pirate for many years.

- I started transmitting on the 25th of June 1963 on the FM-band. I broadcasted on an occasional basis during the 60's and 70's, but nothing during the 80's. Then I began again a few years ago. I've been on FM, medium wave and short wave, he says.

Radio Baltic International started his broadcasts on short wave this summer, on the 10th of June to be exact. He has relayed Sweden's ex-offshore station Radio Nord and several European pirates, e.g. Radio Amazonia, Radio City and Radio Marabu. He has tested several frequencies within the 48 metre band, 6225, 6230, 6240, 6268 and 6301 kHz, but so far he has preferred to stay on 6206 kHz.

- I have some troubles with interference from a Russian station. That's why I test other frequencies, but for the time being I will continue on 6206 kHz. Another problem is the modulation. I use narrowband AM which gives a slight undermodulated signal. With broadband AM, I would need a more powerful amplifier. My hope is to increase power to 500 W.

The operator of Radio Baltic International uses a ship transmitter with the well-known 4CX350 tube, which gives a maximum output of 350-400 W. Many pirates have noticed the good signals on 6206 kHz and made inquiries about relays.

- I'm very open to relay other stations. So far I've only been testing my transmitter. In a short while, there will be self-produced programmes, not made by myself though. However, I will continue to relay other stations too. I will offer a special rate list of my relays. Sundays are the most interesting day and will cost 10 DM per hour. Other days will be cheaper.

Worth mentioning is that Radio Baltic International is not only the most powerful Swedish short wave pirate. He is no doubt also the strongest Swedish FM-pirate. Using a professional FM-transmitter, he serves a large local area somewhere at the south-east of Sweden with several kilowatts!!

- I have also plans on starting with TV-broadcasts. I might have the opportunity to buy a 5 kW TV-transmitter, but I think we could leave that till another time...!

Thanks a lot to the operator of Radio Baltic International for this interview and I would like to wish you the best luck with your new radio station!

For those of you fed up with having to trail to the post office for IRCs, there is news in this issue of PC about the new DPRS membership scheme.

Alpenjager is a new station from the Oldenzaal area of Holland. Noted a couple of times on and around the 1593 kHz area with quite lengthy music programmes.

Quite a surprise new MW operator from the UK is **Angel**. 1593 kHz was the chosen frequency and reports can be sent to Box 130, 92504 Rueil Cedex, France. Recent raids and equipment confiscations do not seem to have put this station off at all.

The promised regular programmes from **Atlantis** (UK) do not seem to have materialised, although the frequency of thefts on 1591 kHz have increased. Many hours of blank open carrier has also been noted. They are putting out a fairly strong signal and have been heard in the Channel Islands.

Listen out for a relay of **Radio Camouflage** which is a mysterious continental pirate. No date or time is known yet, but a programme is planned for the future. There will be some interesting studio guests made of DX-ers and well-known pirate jocks, including disco with Peter McClench and Jolly Jake. Address: DPRS.

The famous pirate **Radio Delta** paid a visit to the DPRS headquarters in August along with the editor of Pirate Chat magazine. We spent a great day in Blackpool, a local seaside resort, and of course tried one or two samples of the local beer.

Greek pirates are still heard on the band most nights. They can be quite strong at times. The only person who knows anything about these stations is Daniel Daniellidis. Last known address: Al. Svolou 18 St., 54622 Thessaloniki, Greece. Unfortunately Daniel does not seem to answer letters, so his promised information about these stations does not seem to be forthcoming. The only station I can receive here and identify with any regularity is **Radio Kallos**. I have only ever managed to identify one other and that was **Radio Metalosika**, in English "the metal bucket". Are there any Greek DX-ers in your DX-club? If so, please send their addresses to me.

Kleine Man (B) operates out of Coevorden in Drentheland. Not to be confused with **Kleine Man** from Nieuwe Amsterdam. He promised some music programmes for the future. Unfortunately his first venture into this area was destroyed by **Radio Barones** who wiped him off the dial! When Baro is on the air, no one else is there (hi)! Address: Box 81, 7740 AD Coevorden, The Netherlands or DPRS.

A new station from the Nymegen area of Holland is **Laser**. A very active pirate indeed, can be heard most nights complete with old Laser jingles and old tape extracts. Was on 1640 kHz, but now using 1645 kHz. Hans, the operator of Laser, is not new to the band at all and has been the voice behind the mike of station such as **Atlantic** and **Europa**. The address for this one is Box 40185, 6504 AD Nymegen, Holland or DPRS.

Monitor is a 214 metre pirate who tried out on 1594 kHz. The result was quite a success as he got involved in a long multi station QSO. He too has been on 182 and 183 metres.

Non verifiers. Some pirates must have huge collections of IRC's, \$US and mint stamps, as they rarely, if ever, reply to DX reports. Three of the most notorious in this category are: **Noolgedacht**, **Pelikaan** and **Tydbreker**. DPRS has done everything to try and get these guys to change their QSL policy, but alas, no luck. I guess they have very large waste paper bins too! So if you really don't want to

waste your money or add to their collection, I suggest you give these three a miss. There may be a very slight chance of a QSL if you are a regular reporter, but be prepared for a hell of a long wait. Other pirates in this category are: **Korak**, **Zoef de Haas**, **Hamburg**, **Waldolala**, **Trobadoer**, **813** and **Aristona**.

A real surprise is **Oscar**, not Dutch but Slovenian!! Does speak a little English, but mainly gives his reports in phonetic code. Heard on a variety of frequencies. Best bet to hear this one is late Saturday night/Sunday morning. Unfortunately no address is known, but he said he will write to a couple of Dutch pirates with reception reports.

The box for **Pelsjager** is closed and mail is returned. DPRS can contact this station, although not direct.

Pepper/Merkurius are a brace of 214 metre pirates who unexpectedly popped up on 182 metres in July. Nice to hear these guys in this part of the band, as many DX-ers never get the chance to hear them on 214 metres.

A big surprise of the month was the return of **Pirana** from Oldenzaal. Unfortunately no programmes are planned, but he has been heard several times with QSO contacts on 1610 and 1596 kHz. At least he is back, so let's hope it prompts him doing a programme with those great sounds of the 60's and 70's.

Radio Scotland International had some nice international programmes during the summer. Tests have also been carried out on 1590 kHz with good results.

Valencia was recently raided by the Dutch RCD. They went away empty handed! Willem has a special trip mechanism that switches off all the power to the studio. After grouping in the dark for about 10 minutes they left with some very long faces. Nice one! Hi.

A true sea pirate is **Victoria (A)**. I recently heard him from the Atlantic Ocean on his way to Baltimore. Most often heard on the band when sailing through the English Channel. Normally uses 1540 and 1645 kHz in SSB. Can sometimes be heard from his home QTH of Alkmaar. Mich the operator can be contacted via Box 54, Hippolytushoef or direct via DPRS. His English is excellent, so no prob-

lem with your reports. Often heard in the early hours after the end of one of Baro's lengthy transmissions.

Above I told about the **Victoria** from international waters. **Victoria (B)** is a new station with the same name and coincidentally a similar sounding voice, which has caused a fair bit of confusion. They both use the 1645 kHz area too, which adds to the chaos. **Victoria (B)** operates out of Drentheland and uses AM, while **Victoria (A)** always uses SSB.

Zeetijger made yet another appearance before the Hoofd Directie Telecommunicatie en Post after being caught for the umpteenth time. The transmitter and amplifier were taken yet again. I hear he's already back on the air!!

September should see lots of pirates back on the band after the long summer break. In the meantime let's take a look at what was happening in July and August.

Hi folks and welcome to another report on pirate activity from across the Atlantic! You will notice that we have a new title. Since most of the pirate stations have deserted 7415 kHz for greener pastures, it was thought a new one was needed. I hope you like it.

During the past few months pirate activity has been at an all time high with more than 60 stations in operation since the start of June. From the middle of June to the middle of July there were 31 straight days of pirate activity which has been come to be known as "Shortwave Liberation". The good news is that no busts or close downs by the FCC or DOT have been noted. Well, enough rambling, on to the logs:

AC Radio. Noted on June 5th at 0155 with IDs and some text on 7465 in the CW mode. No address was given.

Captain Eddy and **The Radio Airplane** were in the skies over North America on the 29th of June and July 3rd at 0258 on 7385 USB. He said he had just laid 400 pounds of fireworks at the FCC monitoring station's front door, what a blast! Address: Wellsville.

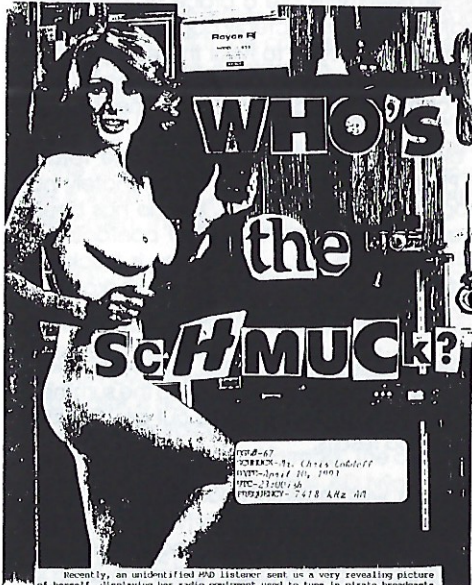
Programming by a computer? Yes, that is what **Amiga Computer Generated Radio** does! Noted on 7385 USB at 0133 on June 18th. Programming was all computer synthesized music and IDs. They use the new Faribault, MN maildrop.

The Asylum is a pirate station whose operator, John, is locked up in a mental institution! Noted at 0225 on June 24th and 0105 on July 3rd, both on 7385 USB. John is still trying to make the pain go away! No address.

What would our report be without good

old **Radio Azteca!** Well, they were back with show number 10 which was as good as always! Heard on July 12th on 7385 USB at 0200 and July 30th on 7413 in the AM mode at 2300. Bram Stoker's station will be two years old in September. Address: Wellsville.

Big Brother Radio. This outlet was noted at 0430 on June 24th on 7384 USB with mx by the Wallers and punkish mx. Although they use the Wellsville drop, the station operator has not contacted the maildrop operator as to where the mail should be forwarded to.



Black Liberation Radio/WRTA is an FM pirate operated from a Black housing project in inner city Chicago. Pirate listeners were treated to some of their programming when **Solid Rock Radio** relayed some tapes of theirs. WRTA was relayed on 7385 USB on June 27th at 0200 and on June 28th at 0000 on 7385 USB. Address: Wellsville for relays only.

Radio Cambodia made a brief appearance on June 12th at 1812 UTC on 7420 kHz USB. Brief talk, ID and the Merlin, Ontario maildrop was announced.

A pirate station aboard a cruise ship sailing through the West Indies? Yes, it's true! **The Caribbean Sound System** was noted with an audio proof of performance test on July 25th at 0100 on 7385 USB. The announcer, Count Whip, gets the ship's radio operator drunk, takes over the controls and plays ska and reggae mx! He announces the Stoneham, MA drop.

CRSM/Radio Scottish Montreal was heard on May 22nd at 2200 on 7425 in AM. The usual fare of Scottish mx and Canadian politics was noted. They use the Merlin, Ontario drop.

CRSN/Radio Star Of The North. This Canadian station was noted a couple of times on June 19th on the 7385 kHz channel. First at 0030 and again later 2230 UTC. Programming featured mx by Canadian artists and computer generated IDs. Address: Wellsville.

We have some sad news to report concerning **Radio Doomsday**. On his latest show which aired on September 4th at 0155 UTC on 7470 USB, the station operator, Nemesis, committed suicide on the air at 0230 UTC by blowing his brains out! Before he killed himself, he read a letter from the parents of little Timmy who recently died of cancer. It seems Doomsday was Timmy's first pirate heard. Nemesis found a slight error in Timmy's report and refused to verify it. This depressed Timmy and led to his early death! Nemesis couldn't stand the guilt I guess! RIP. Address: Wellsville.

Radio Fluffnut, the Canadian pirate, was noted on May 28th at 0208 on 7385 USB. Programming consisted of rock mx by groups like Depeche Mode. The announcer QSLs reports via the Merlin, Ontario drop.

Radio Free Euphoria. This pro pot station was noted on July 3rd at 0021 on 7385 kHz.

Captain Ganja and the Maharishi were smoking marijuana and having a good time! Address: Wellsville.

Radio Free Jesus is a new station operated by Max Gain that was noted on July 3rd at 0140 on 7385 USB. He was complaining about the FCC for fining a teenager who operated a Chicago pirate station. Address: Huntsville. **Radio Free OJ** was a one shot deal dedicated to finding O.J. Simpson when he was trying to flee from arrest! It was noted on June 18th at 0031 on 7385 USB. Also from around 0230 UTC. The operator said he will only QSL reports if O.J. Simpson is found guilty and executed in the California electric chair. No address.

Freedom 40 can best be described as a special event station formed to commemorate the 31 days of "shortwave liberation" which took place from mid-June to mid-July. The station was noted at 0400 on July 17th on 7385 kHz USB on the last day of "shortwave liberation". The operator said that in order to get QSLs from this station you must log and send in copies of QSLs from five stations heard during the "shortwave liberation" period. Address: Stoneham.

Hit Parade Radio was noted during shortwave liberation on June 19th at 0203 on 7385 USB. DJ Dale Dorman presented a Beach Boys special to kick off the summer of '94. Address: Wellsville.

The Joint is the name of joint broadcasts between two pro-marijuana stations, **KNBS** and **Radio Free Euphoria**. The broadcast of July 30th at 0000 UTC on 7471 AM was heard by Rainer Brandt in Germany! Two other versions of the show were transmitted, one on August 13th on 13900 AM and on the 14th of August on 7415 LSB. Programming consists of Phil Muzik, Pot Seedy and Captain Ganja smoking dope in the forest waiting for beer that never arrives. Address: Wellsville.

KICK is the name of a new classic rock

station that recently hit the airwaves. First heard on July 16th at 0200 on 7385 USB. Station operator Pete Moss conducted his first test broadcast. The station sends out a really neat looking QSL card. Address: Huntsville, AL.

KMOM. What was billed as a station operated by a sexy young female named Samantha Jones hit the airwaves for the first time on July 10th. Noted at 0100 on 7385 USB, the programming was not as "hot" as advertised. Mx by Hendrix, REM along with a few moans and groans were heard, but certainly nothing X rated! Address: Wellsville.

KTVI was another new station that cropped up during "shortwave liberation". Operator Emmanuel "Manny" Goldstein first hit the airwaves at 0000 on June 6th operating on 7385 USB. He played mx from Pink Floyd's latest CD and greeted various operators. Address: Faribault, MN.

K2000 has some of the most innovative and creative programming but they have a low powered transmitter that is hard to hear. They were noted on June 27th at 0126 on 7385 USB with a Continent Of Media parody of Glenn Hauser. There has been some complaints regarding their QSL policy with DXers saying they have been insulted by the station. The station plans to be more active in the future. Address: Stoneham.

Laser Hot Hits, the British pirate was relayed by **WREC** a couple of times this summer. Noted on 7415 AM at 0136 on July 17th with soft rock mx and a British accented announcer. They are a very good QSLer via the Merlin, Ontario maildrop.

Radio Magic is a pirate station run by Stan in Perm, Russia. The **NAPRS** relayed them again on June 25th at 0100 on 7385 USB. The programming consisted mostly of rock mx and IDs by Stan. Rainer Brandt of Germany was lucky enough to hear this too! (Address: Perm)

Perhaps the most reported station dur-

ing "shortwave liberation" was **Radio Out-house**. Heard on July 3rd at 0216 on 7385 USB, announcers Bob and Billy Joe claimed to be broadcasting from a "two hole" outhouse somewhere in the state of Arkansas. Besides talking about excrement, they did play some music by U2 and XTC. The show really stunk! Address: none.

Pan Global Wireless presented their sloppy sex program for 1994 at 0000 on August 21st on 7377 USB. Announcer Mike Oxlone was promoting his douche which is available in 55 gallon drums. This was a relay from Xray Yankee Zulu. Address: Wellsville.

The Patriotic Front For The Liberation Of America was also quite active during the summer season. Noted on June 27th on 7385 USB at 0227 with the usual "Drag-net" TV theme. Programming centered around how our government is slowly taking away our liberties. They also heard again on July 25th at 0013 on 7385 USB with a repeat of the earlier show. Address: none.

Quantum State Laboratories was another new station to show up during the summer period. They were first heard on June 11th at 2245 on 7385 USB and noted again on June 12th at 0106 UTC on the same frequency. The format consisted of rock music with male announcer with a heavy echo effect. They also conducted a test on 14400 on 11th of June with little success. Address: Stoneham.

RBCN (Radio Bob's Communication Network) was quite active this summer. They

were heard on June 4th on 15050 kHz at 1950 and again on June 5th on 9989.9 kHz USB at 1900 and also in the AM mode on 7465 kHz at 0115 also on June 5th. Lots of good ole boy southern comedy and a mailbag show was aired. They were also noted on 7447 USB on July 14th with a repeat of the x rated Star Trek show. Address: Atlanta.

RKNA (Rock Of North America). This pirate was logged on July 9th at the unusual time of 1103 UTC on 7415 USB. IDs, mentions of President Clinton and a commentary by the Old Western Fella were heard. Address: Wellsville.

Solid Rock Radio was probably the most active pirate of the past four months! They were noted on 7465 at 2350 on the 30th of May with a Mr. Magoo tape. They were also heard on 7385 kHz at 0000 on June 19th with an oldies program. The June 12th broadcast on 7465 at 0634 was full of theme music from old TV cartoon shows. Solid Rock Radio was also noted on June 26th, 27th, July 5th, 11th and on August 7th. Address: Wellsville.

Southern Music Radio is a studio pirate located on the South Island of New Zealand. They were recently heard in North America via relays. First heard on August 20th on 7470 USB at 0200 and then on August 21st at 2329 on 7377 USB. Programming featured New Zealand rock music with information on different sources of alternative music. Address: Wellsville.

SPAM Radio is certainly the most controversial US pirate station operating today. Not because of their programming but due to the fact they send out a truly disgusting QSL sheet. King Spam was heard June 26th on 7385 USB at 0237 with Monty Python's SPAM song and a YL singing the Stairway To Spam. Address: Faribault.

6YVOS/The Voice Of Smoke. No this is not another pro-marijuana show, but a pro-barbeque station! BBQ as in ribs, hot dogs and hamburgers! They claim to be oper-

ating from the Island of Jamaica, but nobody can confirm this. They were heard on July 3rd at 0139 on 7386 USB and more recently on August 20th at 0239 on 7470 USB. Pigpen Marley is the operator and he enjoys playing mx by the Grateful Dead. Address: Wellsville.

Radio Thirteen. Another new station heard this summer. Noted on July 7th at 0255 on 7385 USB and also on July 10th at 0155 on 7385 USB. An interesting program on the assassination of John K. Kennedy was aired. Station IDs were in both German and English. Address: none.

Up Against The Wall Radio is yet another new station heard this summer. Noted on June 27th at 0120 on 7384.6 USB with a loop tape ID. Then heard at 0125 into programming with an ooogah horn IS. Rock mx by AC/DC. The program ended with more oooga horn and machine gun fire. Also heard on August 13th at 0310 on 7465 USB with a test of a new transmitter playing Pink Floyd mx. This station's operator, Owlsey, sends out a very attractive full color QSL card. Address: Wellsville.

Radio USA. Yes, Mr. Blue Sky and Joe King were active as well this summer. They were heard on July 9th at 2309 on 7387 AM broadcasting Thrash mx. Also heard on July 11th on 7387 AM at 0012. Address: Wellsville.

Voice Of The Real World. This was first noted at 0300 on June 19th on the frequency of 7385 USB. A chipmunk voiced announcer was attacking civil rights organizations and environmentalists. Address: none.

Voice Of The Runaway Maharishi. The sister station of **Radio Free Euphoria** was heard a couple of times in late June. Heard at 0130 on June 19th on the frequency of 7384.8 USB and also from 2338-0009 on the same day and freq. The Maharishi was talking about drugs and the song "Lucy In The Sky With Diamonds" and the history of Ganja in the White House. YLs must send photo in order to get QSLs.

Address: Wellsville.

Our friends at **WEED** were active during the summer. First heard on June 12th at 0406 on 7385U with a well produced program on marijuana advocacy. Heard again on June 19th at 0430 on 7385 USB. This was either a live or recently taped show with mentions of the O.J. Simpson chase. WEED was also heard on July 4th at 0505 on 7385 USB and again on July 10th at 0500. This was 1993's most active station. Address: Huntsville.

Radio Animal and **WKND** (We're K-9 Dog) were heard on June 20th at 0048 on 7415.2 in AM. Music by the Mass Production and K-9 Dog IDs were noted. They were also on on July 4th at 2324 with mx by Metallica and a phone interview with another pirate operator. Address: Blue Ridge Summit.



WLIS (We Love Interval Signals) has been popping up all over with their mini shows. They were heard recently on June 26th at 0220 on 7385 USB. Salutes to Glenn Hauser and Joe Filipkowski were heard. Address: Blue Ridge Summit.

WRDM. Another new station which popped up on July 17th at 0455 on 7385 USB with programming of a male announcer who calls up unsuspecting persons with goofy complaints. Rolling Stones mx was also heard. The announcer said

anybody who tries to QSL this station will get an 'ass whippin'! Address: none.

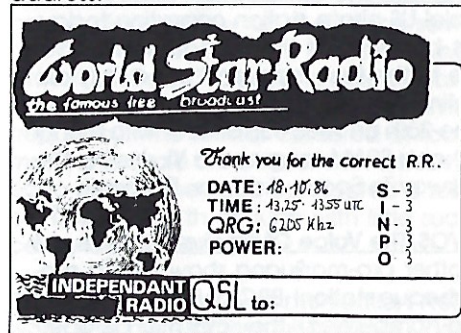

WRFW/Radio Free Wiggy. Not to be confused with **WRFW/Radio Free Wisconsin** this station was heard on July 17th in the AM mode at 0444 running as late as 0700 on 7380 kHz. He talked about some of his friends who were run over by a train and about a cat who ran off with his sandwich! No address.

WVOL/Voice Of The Loon. Captain Willy and his crew were noted at 2244 on June 19th on 7385.7 USB. Mx by Van Morrison and other rock tunes were played. Address: Wellsville.

WYDX was heard with a very well produced program on June 11th and 12th on 7385 USB at 2356 to 0043 UTC. It was the Alan Weiner birthday show. Phone interviews with Weiner and author Anita McCormack were heard along with a preacher parody by The Fox. This was another show that Rainer Brandt logged in Germany.

X-Ray Yankee Zulu. This is a bit of an unusual station. It probably is the first RTTY pirate, noted in RTTY at 0104 on 7384.5 on June 12th. They also relay other pirates such Southern Music Radio. Also noted on 7375 in RTTY on 21st of August at 2355 after the **Southern Music Radio** relay. No address.

For example, if you write a letter to Radio East Coast Commercial, write "RECC" on your envelope followed by the listed address. Most stations require return postage, usually 2 IRCs, 2 USD or 2 mint stamps. IRCs (International Reply Coupons) are available at the post office.

Many of the Dutch pirates can be contacted through an address forwarding service run by Derek Taylor. If you use this service, you must include an extra IRC or USD note to cover the forwarding fee.

Europes Most Westerly Free Radio Station on Short Wave

Much more than a pirate station: RADIO JACKIE

Most pirates are mayflies who don't deserve much attention. But sometimes there pop up a station who becomes something much different...

When the British authorities carried through the Marine Offences Act (MOA) in 1967, Britain suddenly lost much radio entertainment. It's true BBC started their Radio 1 which was a mere copy of the best from the offshore pirates. Not much more happened. The statesmen promised both local BBC-stations and commercial stations as a plaster to the wound. The expansion of BBC came rather quickly, but it took five years before the first commercial private station arose. After another five years, about twenty ILR-stations were running and the expansion of radio stations was finished. However, the people were not satisfied with the compensation they had got.

A short while after the offshore era, lots of irritated young people started pirate transmissions all over the country. Most stations were active in London. Step by step, a network of stations was organized. They broadcast half an hour from each transmitter site. In this way they, Radio Helen Network hoped to avoid being tracked down. Radio Helen 1, Radio Helen 2, even up to Radio Helen 6, were active on 197 metres medium wave on weekends. In the same network were also stations such as Telstar, Revenge, Freedom, Rose, Apollo and Free Caroline.

Gradually, it became more difficult to coordinate the broadcasts and the collaboration collapsed in 1969. Exactly at that time, a new station was born on 197 metres. Named after Jackie Kennedy, this stations was seemingly like the other stations in the network. But it would be seen that Radio Jackie went into the history books of pirate radio.

There has been more or less pirate activity in several British cities since 1968. But I venture to assert that nobody has had such an influence in Britain as Radio Jackie.

Radio Jackie had its first broadcast on the 19th of March 1969. They broadcast for half an hour every Sunday. The frequency was soon changed to 255 metres and another while later to 227 metres (1332 kHz). This frequency was kept all the time, apart from a change to 1323 kHz near the closure because of interference from Hereward Radio.

In 1980, a breakaway group from Radio Jackie formed Jackie FM, JFM, which offered the Londoners jazz-funk and soul music on 94 MHz. This was a very popular music format at London's pirate radio stations at that time.

From having been an ordinary pirate station, Radio Jackie became a serious radio station, although on the wrong side of the law. In March 1972, the station caused a great deal of trouble to the British Parliament. MP Philip Whitehead from Derby insisted that the committee who was in-

vestigating about local radio should listen to a recording of Radio Jackie, as a good example of how good a local radio station could be!

This was the first time ever a sound-recording was played in the parliament and it followed by a lengthy discussion whether it could be allowable to play a recording of an illegal station! But the recording got an influence on parliament members and politicians.

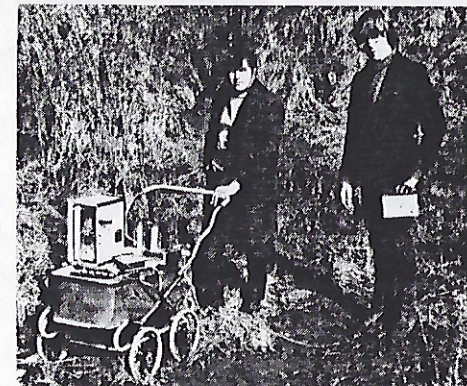
The station attained an enormous support from the local people in Morden in south-west London. Many local politicians and top people in different organization supported Radio Jackie. Parliament member Angela Rumbold from Merton and Morden constituency had an active role in a signature campaign which resulted in 55 000 signatures who called for a legalization. The local support came from members of both Tory and Labour in Kingston Council who also declared their support to Radio Jackie. The politicians who actively had supported Radio Jackie, were fully aware of the legal side of the case, but said, in all seriousness, that the denial of a license was foolish and the people and Radio Jackie were right!

The station were run more and more professionally as the years went by. At Christmas 1992, Radio Jackie broadcast 24 hours a day all week. The programmes contained everything a good local radio should have. Contacts with the listeners, service and local news. Naturally there were also commercials, but they were limited to five minutes per hour.

It is important for a local radio station to commit itself to e.g. social issues. Radio Jackie often organized fund-raising drives. The money went to local hospitals, a man suffering from atrophy, an 11-year-old child who got the opportunity of watching the launch of a space-shuttle in California. And DJ Jerry James had a bath in mayonnaise for 32 hours after a fund-raising campaign for Linden Lodge Scholl for blind children, just to mention a

few of many supporting actions by Jackie.

Radio Jackie claimed they had 250 000 listeners. They tried to run the station as if they were a legal station. Much assets were spent on documentation and proposals on how a local radio station should be run. It is sure painful for the fiery spirits behind Radio Jackie, that much of their efforts are the ground-work for many radio stations throughout the country, and many ex-pirates have got license but not Radio Jackie...

The beginning of the end for Radio Jackie came when the commercial station Radio Mercury complained to the authorities. They accused Jackie of stealing listeners from them and thus lost receipts. The complaints were most probably the direct motive for the intensification of the hunting for Radio Jackie in February 1985. Withing three days, the Deptment of Trade and Industry (DTI) payed the station a visit two times. The past four to five years had otherwise been a very peaceful period. Now, the authorities were fully determined to close Jackie. Therefore, the people behind Jackie closed voluntarily. The final transmission was in February 1985 and contained much tear-jerking and nostalgia. The programme ended with Dusty Springfield's song "Catch me if you can", while DTI were on their way to the transmitter site for the third time...
