# THE BEEZER INDEX

## Introduction

On January 15th 1976 'Beano' comic star Dennis the Menace appeared in a TV advert shown during 'Children's Hour' to promote a brand new comic title. This new comic title was the brand new tabloid sized 'Bezer' and when published it became the last of the B.C. Thomson's 'Big Four' comic titles, joining the remarkably successful Dandy and Beano, and its tabloid sized companion title, the 'Topper'.

From the outset in strips such as Leo Baxendale's 'Banana Bunch' and later Tom Kammerer's 'Colossal Blunk' the Bezer capitalized on the early gonzoish humour which had already proved such a huge success in the pages of the 'Beano'. The brilliant comedy strips being complimented by the beautiful adventure strips of Ron Smith, Ken Hunter et. al. in their full colour, oversized magnificence. What more could our ask from a comic?

This index tells the Bezer's story from its glorious beginnings to its sad demise as part of the amalgamated 'Bezer and Topper', thirty seven years later, so if you wish to unearth the history of 'Nanger', 'Top Deck' and 'Harry', 'Baby C'rocket' or 'The Kings of Castaway Island', look no further.

- \* III Best of Bezer - 68 page black and white quarterly featuring reprints from the Bezer and other Thomson comics. First published in 1988, 24 issues have been published to date.
- \* DCL Dandy Comic Library - pocket sized comic published at the rate of two a month since April 1985. Each issue features a 68 page story devoted to a particular character.
- \* DCB Dandy Cartoon Book, similar to the pocket sized Dandy Comic Library except that many characters are featured in each 48 page issue, in single comic strips. First appeared in July 1987.
- \* BPH Beano Puzzle Book - companion title to the Dandy Cartoon Book also first appearing in July 1987. Comic characters present puzzles for the reader to solve.
- \* FF Special book 'Dandy - Beano - Famous Faces' published in September 1992 (in 1993). Features reprints not only from the Dandy and Beano but also the Topper and Bezer. 144 pages in full colour.
- \* SF Sunday Post Fun Section - weekly comic supplement in the Sunday Post newspaper since March 1956 and famous for characters 'Our Willie' and 'The Broom'. Reprinted a number of strips from the Thomson comics in 1976.
- 1000F Short lived Thomson comic No.1 (26.10.85)-No.53 (25.10.86) which features a five comic line page section consisting of one line strip featuring characters from other Thomson comics. This 'Fun Pub' feature continued in the Dandy when the two comics amalgamated.

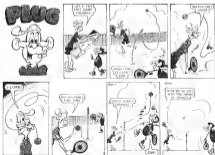

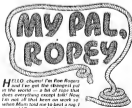

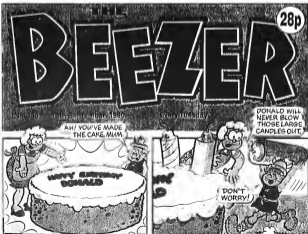
