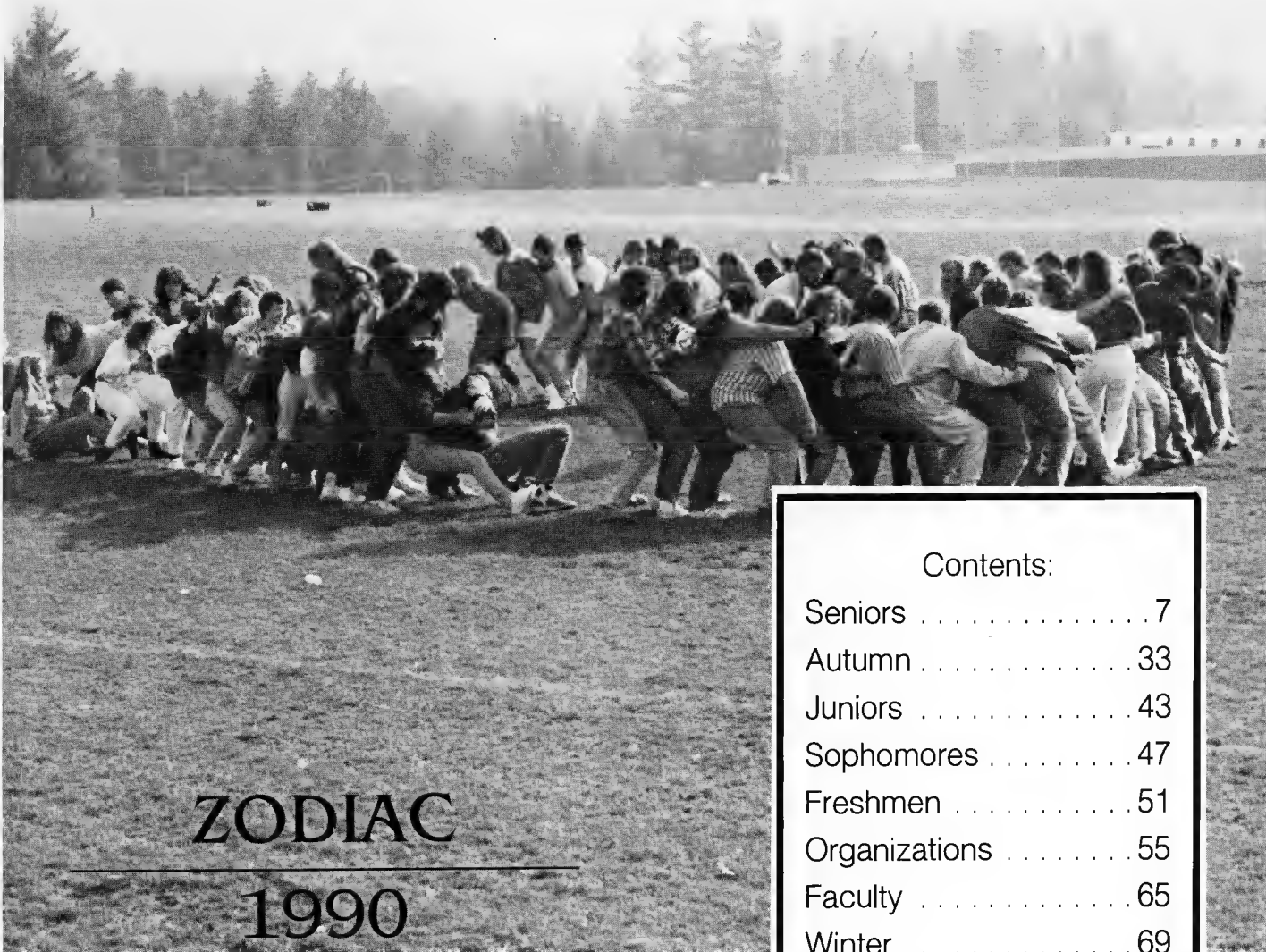

**Congratulations to the Class of 1990. You have completed the first, most important step of self-development by graduating from Telstar Regional High School.**

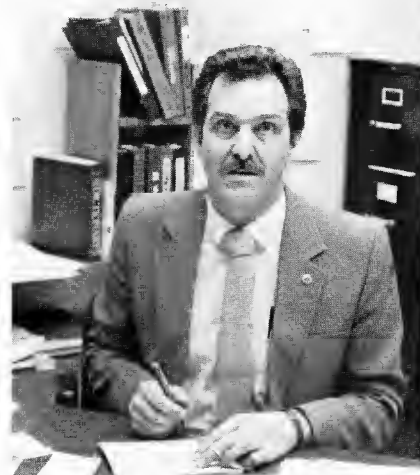

Kristen Powell, Michelle Conkright, Mary Newall, Angela Applin, and Esther Finch provided the much needed depth that gave us a successful season.



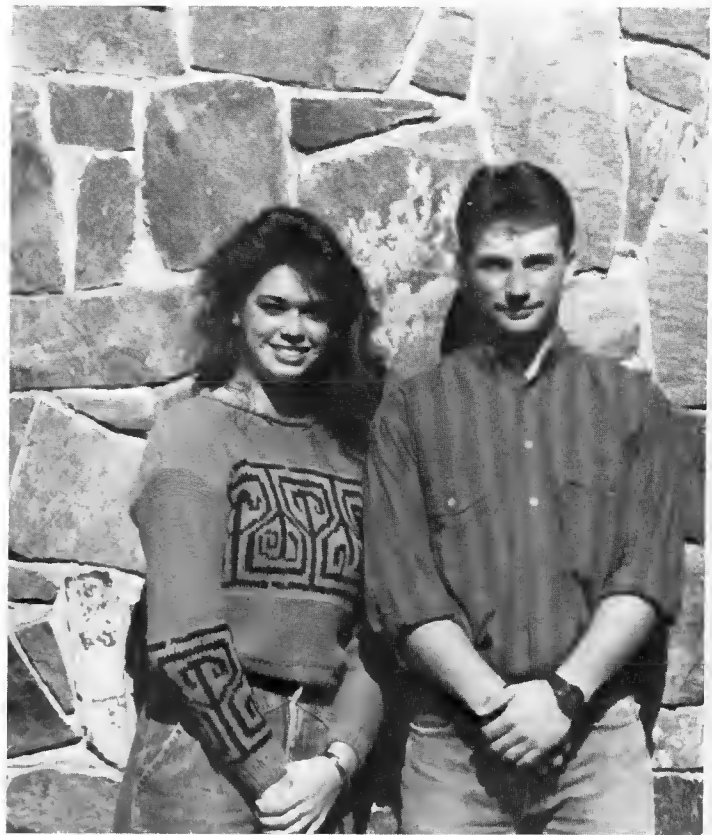

## 'We Mourn Seven Heroes'

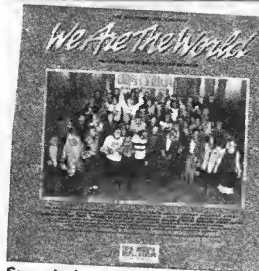
Barely a minute into its 10th orbital mission, the shuttle Challenger exploded killing six astronauts and teacher Christa McAuliffe, the first "ordinary" American to venture into space. "We mourn seven heroes," Ronald Reagan said later in the day, as a stunned nation watched replays of the fireball on television and grieved with the astronauts' families.

What went wrong with America's 56th manned mission in space? At the end of the week, NASA officials still combed through their computer tapes at the space center in Houston and fished shuttle debris out of the ocean off Cape Canaveral, closing in on the cause of the accident. Meantime, the shuttle program faced an indefinite delay, and the Challenger disaster, contrasted to the triumphs of the unmanned Voyager 2 probe,

raised questions about the space agency's priorities. It seemed certain that Americans would return to space, however, and a Newsweek Poll showed strong support for flights by civilians such as McAuliffe. But in a special article, Tom Wolfe, author of "The Right Stuff," tells of the continuing tensions within NASA between the Everyman lobby and traditional "Astronaut power"
