

David,

The 550 PV site will be mobilizing in July (likely with demo starting in July) and then we are off to the races later in summer. This project is slated for construction end of 2019-start of 2020 when we will begin to occupy the building. Attached is a preliminary site plan showing the lanes/sidewalks we are trying to close, and below is a rough idea of the two tower cranes locations and their swing radiuses (bottom of the image is PV street, right of image is 6<sup>th</sup>, left of image is 5<sup>th</sup>). We will need to temporarily remove the street lights along our perimeters but the festoon lights currently strung up are attached to these streetlights. All of these items will be in conflict with our crane picking operations. How can we get these festoon lights removed so that we can proceed with temporarily taking down the street lights? Tower cranes likely won't begin erection until end of this year – but it would be great to get this process going as soon as possible.
