Per your request, here are the trolley ridership numbers.

2016 - First year where we had four trolleys over the summer (5 months May to Sept) with the extended summer route to Cabrillo Beach. Ridership = 27,258 We estimate that the ridership was over 20% more than 2015 due to the increased capacity over the summer months.

2017 - Second year with summer trolley (6 months from May to October) with extended summer route to Cabrillo Beach. Ridership for 2017 is expected to be around 36,453, a 34% increase from 2016.
