- 1. In response to your request for periodic reports concerning Sergei Schebalin as referenced, the following information is a current report of his resettlement status.
- 2. Schebalin advised that he had no problems, he is very happy and making excellent progress. He recently acquired a 1956 Chevrolet and a driver's license on his own and is very proud of this accomplishment. Sergei continues his enrollment in the evening class at LaSalle College. He is taking courses in electro-physics and differential equations and attends classes three evenings a week. Since he is using these subjects in his work at Brown Instrument Company, he is very pleased.
- 3. At the present time his salary is \$86 per week. This, together with the salary of his wife from the Keystone Transformer Company, provides the family with a comfortable income. In about six months, Schebalin informed, he will be given the status of an engineer at the plant, which will mean a promotion and a small increase in salary. He said that his supervisor told him that this would be done without waiting for him to complete his college studies and obtain an engineering degree. Mr. Dever, President of Brown Instrument Company, has advised that the lack of alien security clearance would not hinder his progress with the company.
