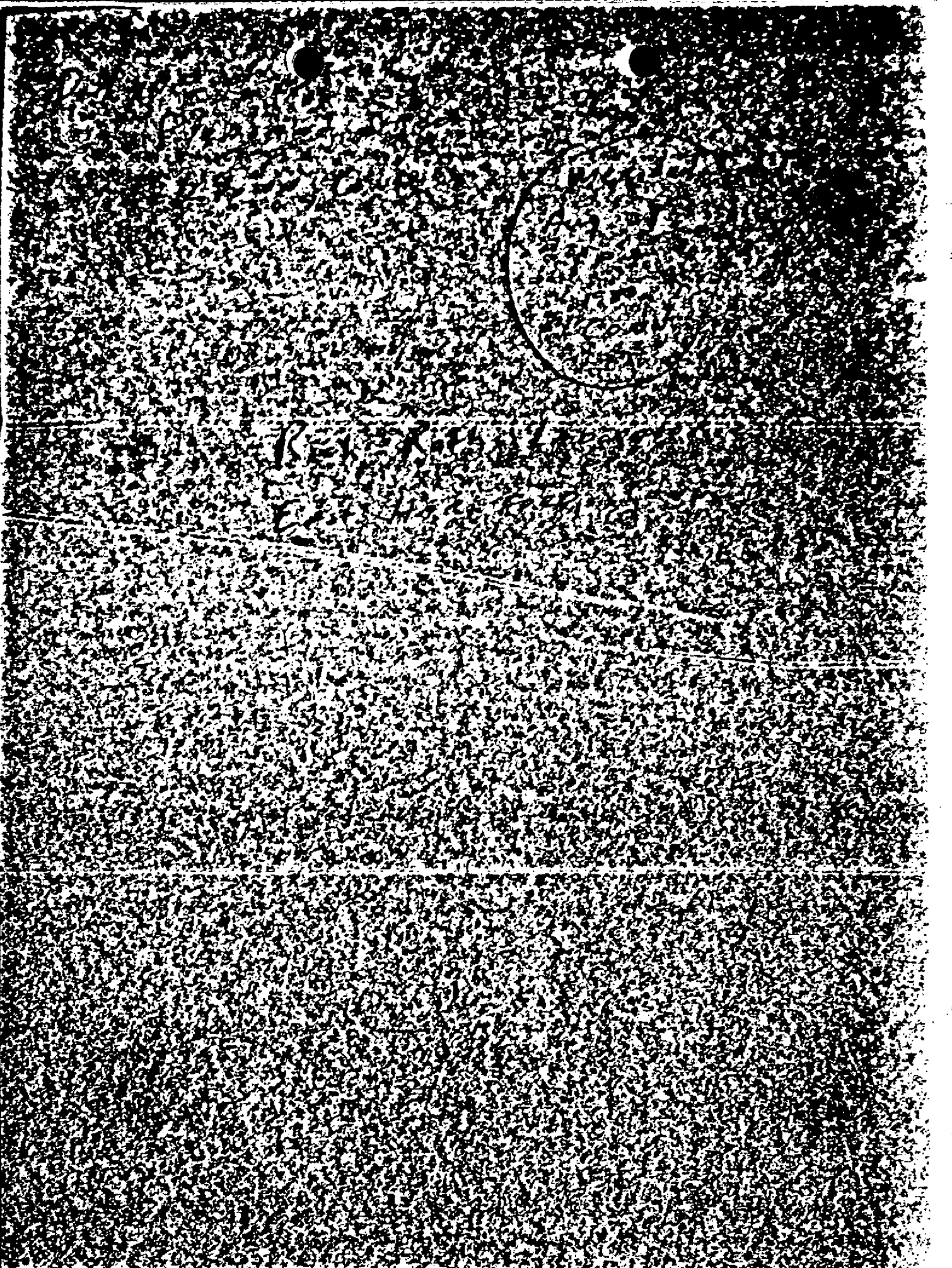

Dear Ed,

This will come as a surprise to you as it has to me, to say the least, - my latest request for security clearance has been held up until I provide additional information to show that clearance should be granted to me. There is no cause for alarm; I am not accused of any disloyalty, of being a communist or of being a member in any undesirable organization. The clearance people have stated that due to college associations in 1938 and some chance- and very brief- encounters since college, I must furnish further evidence to prove that I am a good security risk in order to receive clearance to do certain special work for which my services have been requested by the Navy.

I can assure you that I have done nothing to be ashamed or afraid of and that I fully expect to receive clearance as soon as the required information is provided. Of course, this is surprising to me, especially as I have been so keenly aware of the Russians as a threat- particularly a serious military problem- ever since the end of World War II. In fact, as you may remember, I argued almost to the point of boring everyone that we must build up our defenses, starting in 1945.

To come to the immediate point, I must now furnish proof that I am indeed a good security risk so that I can help defeat the very forces I have been warning people about for so long. To this end, I must ask the favor, not of making any sweeping statements about myself, nor of climbing out on any political limb on my account- but of stating for the record what you know of my work and attitude toward our country and against the Russians. If, in a statement, you will recall:-

- 1) That S.R. Rich was concerned over the problem of defense against the Russians from 1945 on (or as early as you do recall.)
- 2) That he argued against complacency and warned of the danger in overestimating our strength and underestimating Russian strength from 1945 on (or as early as you do recall.)

- 3) That he studied and was actively concerned with defense planning, both in his direct work and in general.
- 4) That his attitude was constructive and definitely pro-American.
- 5) Any specific conversations, comments, etc. that you feel will be indicative and helpful.
- 6) Whatever summary you care to give evaluating my work especially with regard to my role in creating, organizing and stimulating the activities of my colleagues in defense work, in sonar and guided missiles.
- 7) Any statements you may care to make about my personal ethics and outlook as a whole.

It is hard for me to have to ask this favor - but it would be still harder to be denied clearance when it is necessary for those who can to dig in and work. These statements for which I am asking are required by the Board in affidavit form. I have enclosed a form prepared by our attorney. If you will make your statements in the indicated form and return it to me by March 1st, it is understatement to say that it will be most gratefully received. The response of other colleagues, officials, friends and neighbors who have come forward has been most gratifying - perhaps a kind of reward in a sense. I can only repeat; your help will be most gratefully received.

Road, East Hartford, Connecticut.

LAWRENCE advised that Bureau instructions are to ascertain the residence and employment of Subject and to advise the Bureau, New York and Boston immediately by teletype. New York is office of origin.

Subject was born 10/21/17, New York City. He was graduated from the CCNY, electrical engineering, in 1938.

ACTION:

SA JOHN C. MANNING has been instructed to make a check of the Telephone Company to determine if Subject has telephone service which will furnish good leads as to residence and employment, and to advise me immediately so that SA EDWARD R. At 3:35 P.M. on August 17, 1950, Supervisor GRANVILLE of the New York office, telephonically communicated with the New Haven office to advise that he was in receipt of New Haven teletype to New York under date of August 16 in which New Haven inquired as to the advisability of placing RICH under surveillance. Mr. GRANVILLE stated that he thought that this was a good idea. It was pointed out to Mr. GRANVILLE that New Haven had received at 10:40 P.M. on August 16, 1950, a teletype from New York advising the New Haven office to institute such surveillance. Mr. GRANVILLE was unaware that such a teletype had been sent but concurred with it.

He explained that one of the other subjects in this espionage ring, MORTON SOBELL, had been arrested in Mexico City and was being returned to New York. He further stated that SOBELL was in receipt of a suspicious typewritten letter and expressed the opinion that there was some belief that RICH might have sent this communication to SOBELL. He, therefore, requested that an attempt should be made to secure typewritten specimens on machines to which RICH might have access. He further pointed out that with respect to teletypes in this matter that the New York office and the Bureau should receive all copies of teletypes and copies of such teletypes should be sent by letter to the Albany and Cleveland offices inasmuch as they have at the present time other subjects in the ring under investigation. He further pointed out that information concerning subjects covered by these offices should be sent directly by teletype.

At approximately 8 P.M. Supervisor GRANVILLE contacted the New Haven office and advised S. MIGNOSA, clerk, that the surveillance on RICH should be intensified and RICH should be covered continuously over a twenty-four hour period inasmuch as the Bureau contemplated the issuance of a news release concerning the arrest of SOBELL. He pointed out that with the issuance of such news release, RICH, if involved in espionage activities, might attempt to flee.

Arrangements were made whereby the following Agents were to cover RICH, who resides at the YMCA at Hartford, Connecticut, and who, according to SA WHALEN, parks his car bearing Massachusetts license plates, at the Armory near the YMCA in Hartford, Connecticut:

Agents KELLY and REUMIER to relieve WHALEN and NICHOLS at 11:30 PM

on 8/17/50

Agents WHALEN, NICHOLS, BOOTH and CONNER to take up surveillance at 7 AM on 8/18/50

Arrangements were made so that two-way radio cars would be available at Hartford, Connecticut at 7 A.M. on August 18, 1950.

At 1:45 on 8/18/50, SA EDWARD WHALEN telephonically communicated with the writer to advise that in the surveillance of RICH, he proved to be very "tail conscious". WHALEN went on to explain that he had left his place of employment with a brief case at about 12:30 P.M. and had proceeded to Front Street, Hartford, Connecticut. He drove very slowly and drew up to the side of a street which was deserted of other cars. One of the surveillance cars passed him at this point (WHALEN'S) and the other car (NICHOLS') took over the surveillance. However, RICH then drove down American Row in Hartford and proceeded ahead at a green light, and the surveillance car of NICHOLS had to stop when the light turned red. The surveillance was lost at this point. However, WHALEN, through his informant, learned that RICH *returned* was expected back at the plant on that afternoon.

*Entire pick-up shortly thereafter at subject's place of employment.*  
Supervisor GRANVILLE of the New York Office was telephonically contacted by the writer and he advised that the press release on the arrest of MORTON SOBELL had been given out at 11 A.M. this date. It was explained to GRANVILLE that RICH proved to be very "tail conscious" and that this demeanor on the part of RICH was a recent development. He wondered whether RICH might have heard concerning the arrest of SOBELL.

GRANVILLE then stated that instructions were to keep RICH under constant surveillance, as the description of RICH matched that of the individual who approached VIVIAN GLASSMAN to make a contact with another suspected Espionage agent in this ring, located in Cleveland, Ohio, to warn him to leave the United States. GRANVILLE further explained that SOBELL at Mexico City had received the following letter which was typewritten on note paper. This letter was addressed to SOBELL'S alias, as follows: Mr. M. WALTER CORDOBA, 153, Apt. 4, Mexico City, dated August 9, 1950.

"Dear Friend: Received your letter and glad to hear from you. As you know, I have not been feeling well and went to see a doctor. However, no one could help me until the last few days, when I was able to contact a top notch doctor who claims to know what is wrong with me. He assured me he will have me cured in the near future. I got your letter by coincidence, as I don't live there any more. I have been travelling these last few months and as soon as I settle down, I will let you know my whereabouts. Sincerely, [Signature]

GRANVILLE stated that this appeared to be a definitely open code and again reiterated that the surveillance on RICH should not be lost. He pointed out that often those Espionage agents who are about to flee or make a contact are "jumpy" and give the appearance of "making" a surveillance, which they have not.

On 2/25/52 EDWIN E. TURNER, Manager, Submarine Signal Section, Raytheon Manufacturing Company, Newton Plant, Newton, Mass., telephonically contacted this office to furnish information concerning STANLEY ROBERT RICH.

Mr. TURNER stated that he was one of the subject's former supervisors at the time RICH was employed for the Submarine Signal Section in Boston and Newton, Mass., from about 1945 to 1950. TURNER advised he was interviewed by the F.B.I., Boston, during the latter part of 1950 regarding RICH's loyalty.

TURNER stated he desired to advise the Boston Office that RICH visited the Submarine Signal Section of Raytheon Manufacturing Company at Newton, Mass., on 2/1/52. He said RICH contacted him and several of RICH's former supervisors of Submarine Signal for the purpose of receiving personal letters of recommendation from them concerning his, RICH's, loyalty to the United States.

RICH told TURNER that he was being investigated by the F.B.I., and that he wished letters from his former supervisors clearing him as to his loyalty. RICH stated he was co-owner of the Rich-Roth Laboratories at Hartford, Conn., and that he was presently seeking Government contracts for his company. He felt that the question of his loyalty was preventing his company from receiving these Government contracts.

RICH advised TURNER that the reason he was investigated by the F.B.I. was due to his being a former classmate of JULIUS ROSENBERG at the City College of New York.

AT HARTFORD, CONNECTICUT

STANLEY B. RICH, Technical Director, Teknika, Inc., 634 Asylum Avenue, was interviewed by Special Agents EDWARD B. WHALEN and JOHN B. KELLY on April 12, 1963, and advised that he was employed at the New York Naval Shipyard from 1949 to 1949. He related that his closest associates during this period of employment were one JOHN BODENBURG and (YNU) LAURENT. He stated

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with certainty that he knew no persons bearing the names: IRVING CHARLES NELSON; ROBINSON BOBROW; ARTHUR MOOSIN; MILTON SCHWARTZ; or GEORGE GORCHOFF. He also stated that he knew of no other individual employed at the above facility during the 1940-1943 period bearing the surname RICH.

The only person RICH claimed to be able to remember with a name bearing any similarity to the above names was one HERMAN SWARTZ, an inspector in the radio material office of the above installation. He described SWARTZ as a "blow-hard" who was then in his fifties, did not look healthy and is now probably deceased.

It is noted that on the above occasion, RICH was also interviewed concerning a letter which he had directed to the U. S. Department of Commerce on March 19, 1963, with a copy to the FBI, complaining of inquiries received from the Amtorg Trading Corporation, which inquiries did not identify Amtorg as an agency of the USSR. He also mentioned inquiries from men with Russian names at the New Orleans Chemical Engineering Exposition and who wore badges which merely stated "Trading Company." RICH pointed to the need for legislation compelling representatives or agents of foreign powers, particularly the USSR, to identify themselves in accordance with their affiliations at times that inquiry is made of American firms requesting information and literature. RICH stated in the above communication that he has a basic desire not to give any assistance to the entire Communist bloc.
