IN AN ADDRESS IN MADRAS SEPTEMBER 9 PRIME MINISTER GANDHI CITED AN UNCTAD REPORT "THE REVERSE TRANSFER FOR TECHNOLOGY: ECONOMIC EFFECTS OF THE OUTFLOW OF TRAINED PERSONNEL FROM DEVEL-OPING COUNTRIES (BRAIN DRAIN)" WHICH, SHE SAID, STATES THAT IN 1970 ALONE INDIA GAVE THE EQUIVALENT OF RS. 6,563 MILLION. (\$52.5 MILLION). THIS IS GETTING TO BE A FAIRLY STEADY THEME HERE AND, WITH RESPECT AT LEAST TO MEDICAL DOCTORS, IN CERTAINLY JUSTIFIED. THE WHOLE SUBJECT IS, OF COURSE, COMPLEX. WE GET PERSONS TRAINED IN INDIA. CORRESPONDINGLY, WE SUBSIDIZE INDIAN STUDENTS TRAINED IN THE UNITED STATES. BUT WHEN ALMOST THE WHOLE GRADUATING CLASS OF ONE OF THE BEST MEDICAL SCHOOLS IN INDIA CHARTERS A BUS TO DRIVE TO THE BOMBAY CONSULATE ON THE DAY OF GRADUATION... WELL THE TIME HAS COME TO DO SOMETHING. IT IS A SCANDAL FOR BOTH GOVERNMENTS. COULD WE ENTER A GENTLEMAN'S AGREEMENT WITH INDIA NOT TO ISSUE VISAS TO INDIAN DOCTORS? POSSIBLY ALSO SOME SIMILAR HIGH SKILLED OCCUPATIONS? THE IMMIGRATION LAWS ARE SO CONFIDENTIAL

IN ANY EVENT, TWO QUESTIONS. DO YOU THINK IT WOULD BE A GOOD IDEA TO PROPOSE SUCH AN AGREEMENT. COULD WE DO SO? OBVIOUSLY I THINK IT WOULD BE A GOOD IDEA TO PRESENT TO THE INDIANS.
