1. DEPARTMENT WISHES TO COMMEND EMBASSY FOR ITS CON-

TINUING THOROUGH COVERAGE OF BOTH INTRA-CEMA AND EC-CEMA DEVELOPMENTS. INSIGHTS GAINED THROUGH EMBASSY'S SOVIET AND EAST EUROPEAN SOURCES HAVE BEEN MOST USEFUL TO WASHINGTON END-USERS IN GAUGING SOVIET INTENTIONS DURING NEXT FIVE YEAR PLANNING PERIOD UNDER RUBRIC OF "SOCIALIST ECONOMIC INTEGRATION," AS WELL AS EE (ESPECIALLY ROMANIAN) REACTION TO SOVIET GOALS. LIKEWISE, REGARDING EC-CEMA EMBASSY REPORTING HAS ADDED A SIGNIFICANT DIMENSION TO OUR ASSESSMENT OF SOVIET PERCEPTIONS IN PURSUING THE INSTITU-TIONAL DIALOG.

2.MORE SPECIFICALLY, REFTEL REPORT ON EXPANSION OF SOVIET--EE TRANSPORT FACILITIES IS TYPICAL OF IMPORTANT, HARD-CORE INFORMATION WHICH IS VIRTUALLY IMPOSSIBLE TO OBTAIN OUTSIDE THE USSR/EE AREA. THE DEPARTMENT APPRECIATES EMBASSY'S DILIGENCE IN DEVELOPING AND REPORTING CEMA-RELATED INFORMATION.
