D. YES, THE UPGRADING OF SELECTED MILITARY UNITS IS JUSTIFIED TO COUNTER THREATS POSED BY TERRORIST GROUPS BASED IN ARGENTINA. THIS SUBJECT DISCUSSED IN DETAIL IN PARAGUAY FY-78-82 MASP INPUT DATED 6 FEB. 76.
