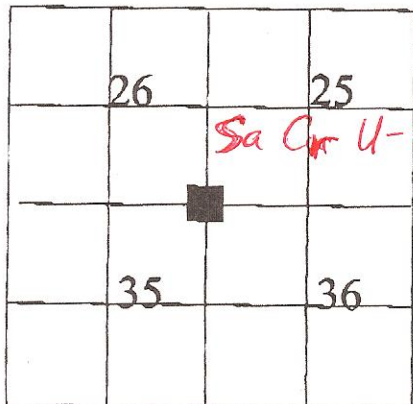
Sketch of Monument


