No beauty problem is the subject of more misconception than acne, Unfortunately, no beauty problem is more wide spread. -Here are questions and answers designed to bring you up to date on the latest scientific views on an old problem. What causes acne? Acne is caused by improper functioning of the oil, or sebaceous, glands in the skin. Ordinary methods of cleansing are not enough. Soap and water alone do not dissolve the oil which clogs the pores. Sulphur does, which is one reason why soaps and lotions containing it so often are used in treating acne.




