Taylor,

Since two Agencies (BOE and BSS) issue permits for lane closures, you would need to contact both to know about lane closures in advance.

CD-14 is leading a team to improve the function of the Public Ways Reservation System (PWRS) so that you can be informed of upcoming closures in your area automatically.

This is yet an unavailable feature.

LADOT does not issue permits for lane closures. We act as consultants to those other Agencies for technical issues, and compliance with National and State standards for lane closure plans or Traffic Control Plans (TCPs)
