

Argentine troops alerted U.S. prepared Peron mobbed in Rome, to meet Cubans flies home today over hijacking

Argentinian ex-President Peron was mobbed amid scenes of wild confusion last night as he was taken to a reception he gave for the 130 Peronist supporters who were due to fly home with him a few hours later.

Peron would "repress with all necessary energy any intent to violate the public tranquility." Radio and television stations and newspapers have marine guards posted around them.

WASHINGTON (Reuter). — The United States declared yesterday that it would take all steps, including face-to-face meetings with the Cubans, to end the hijacking of U.S. airliners to Havana.

Peron supporters in Buenos Aires were reported not to expect Peron to fly direct to Argentina because of displeasure at a government ruling only 300 Peronists may enter the airport to greet him.

They said Peron might fly to a third country such as Paraguay to wait for the government of President Alejandro Lanusse to bow to his demands the airport be open to his supporters.

State Department spokesman Charles Bray said the U.S. would not exclude any procedure, including face-to-face meetings with Cubans, to curtail the rash of hijackings.

Egypt seeks £100m. in British arms

By DAVID LENNON Jerusalem Post Correspondent LONDON. — Egypt has presented Britain with a shopping list of arms which she wishes to purchase, and it is believed that the government has given provisional approval for most of the items on the list.

The Egyptians are reportedly interested in goods worth in the region of £100m., including Scorpion light tanks, Saracen armoured cars, patrol boats, planes and sophisticated electronic equipment.

Britain has already indicated that she is not prepared to supply Jaguar strike aircraft or the Rapier missile which has also been struck off the list.

Schumann: Europeans follow France on M.E. Jerusalem Post Correspondent PARIS. — French Foreign Minister Maurice Schumann yesterday said that other European countries are coming closer to France's position on the Middle East.

Presenting his budget to the National Assembly, Schumann said this European solidarity could in due time lead to action in the Middle East conflict like that which France was able to undertake in the Vietnam conflict.

Unless there is European support, U.N. Secretary-General Kurt Waldheim and his representative Gunnar Jarring "would be condemned to disastrous and undeserved impotence," Schumann added.

Meanwhile, yesterday the French government was accused of being more preoccupied by its "economic and political interests" in Arab countries than by the security of the passengers on airliners.

Port might be shared Eban: Gaza won't be separated from Israel KIRYAT GAT. — Foreign Minister Abba Eban said last night the Gaza Strip would not be separated from Israel although under a peace settlement its port might be shared with Jordan.

Addressing the Economic Club here, Mr. Eban denied there was any deal between Israel and Jordan's King Hussein on the future of the Strip. He said this would be determined only in the overall settlement of the Arab-Israeli dispute.

The Foreign Minister noted that the Strip had never formed part of the Valley of the Nile and described the Egyptian presence there between 1949 and 1957 as "artificial."

On a possible peace border, Mr. Eban said changes would have to be made in the Rafah area. The north (Sina) highway, the classic invasion route into Israel, could not be returned to the Egyptians.

He said there was no truth in reports that the massacre of Israeli sportsmen at the Munich Olympics had prevented a planned meeting between Israeli and Egyptian representatives on possible peace negotiations.

Mr. Eban was commenting on a "New York Times" report from Paris which had said the killing of the 11 sportsmen may have been aimed at stopping direct, secret contacts between Israel and Egypt towards opening peace negotiations.

The newspaper said no firm date had been set for such talks, but the killings created an atmosphere which in any case prevented them taking place.

Mr. Eban denied that there was any truth in reports of contacts between Israel and Egypt. If Egypt had been interested in such a meeting, it would not have praised the Arab terrorists who carried out the murders, he said.

Mr. Eban said he favoured party discussion of the future of the territories, but added that he would prefer that less publicity be given to the differences of opinion involved.

He said that, regrettably, the State information media were actually expressing the views of the people who operate them rather than those of the public, and called for closer supervision.

East Germany included Nato invites Soviet bloc to troop talks

BRUSSELS. — The United States and all of its North Atlantic allies except France announced yesterday that they are inviting the Soviet Union, Czechoslovakia, Poland, Hungary and East Germany to talks beginning January 31 on mutual and balanced reduction of military forces.

It was the first time that the Western allies have taken official notice of the East German government, which none of them recognize.

The announcement said the place of the meeting was still to be agreed on, but Foreign Minister Walter Scheel, of West Germany, said Switzerland was suggested, Bern, Lausanne and Geneva have been mentioned as possible sites.

Acceptance by the Soviet Union and its allies should pose no problems, sources said. The 13 nations having troops in the integrated Nato command "agree to propose that exploratory talks on this matter should be held beginning on the 31st of January 1973, in a place still to be agreed through diplomatic channels," a Nato communique said.

"The governments of Belgium, Canada, the Federal Republic of Germany, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, the United Kingdom and the United States are communicating this proposal to the governments of Czechoslovakia, Poland, Hungary and the U.S.S.R.," the communique said.

West Germany is sending an invitation to the East German government, it said. The countries involved are those situated in central Europe or having troops there.

The invitations went out a week after the Western allies agreed to start preliminary talks on the Soviet-proposed European Security Conference in Helsinki November 22. The East bloc nations should now readily agree to the Western invitation, the sources said.

Originally the West wanted the troop talks to start at the same time as the preparations for the security conference. The East Bloc was wary to agree. U.S. presidential adviser Henry Kissinger swung the November-January deal when he visited Moscow last September. The West agreed with this on the understanding there would be parallel progress between the two sets of talks.

Denmark, Greece, Italy, Norway and Turkey "will confirm their intention to be represented at the exploratory talks," the Nato communique said. These Nato "flank countries" at first were not to take part as they are not directly involved in the military situation in

Rabin home for brief visit soon Laird quitting as Defence Sec'y KANSAS CITY, Missouri (UPI). — U.S. Secretary of Defence Melvin Laird said yesterday he intended to resign after four years in office because of discussions he had with former Secretary of Defence Robert McNamara.

"Because of my convictions and my discussions over the years with Secretary McNamara, he agreed with me that four years is long enough," Laird said.

Woman jailed as accomplice in Syrian's death PARIS (UPI). — Police yesterday jailed a 45-year-old woman on charges of being an accomplice in the shooting death on Monday of high-living self-styled Syrian journalist Khodr Kannon.

They said she lent her Peugeot car to the killers. Therese Lefevre, a medical technician, was charged with complicity in the slaying. She was taken to Roquette prison in East Paris.

She had told police the car was stolen from her. Witnesses to the killers' getaway gave the licence number to police.

Kannon, who lived in a \$500-a-month flat in the exclusive 16th arrondissement, was professionally gunned down by two men who came to his apartment, police said.

Detectives have found little evidence of how the 36-year-old Arab supported himself. Arab journalists said they did not know him, and the Syrian embassy said it found no record of him on files on the 600 Syrians living in Paris.

A pretty blonde model named Veronique who was with Kannon at the time of the shooting said she never spoke with him of his professional activities. "To me, he was a foreign correspondent," she said.

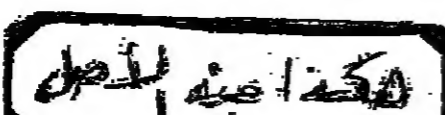

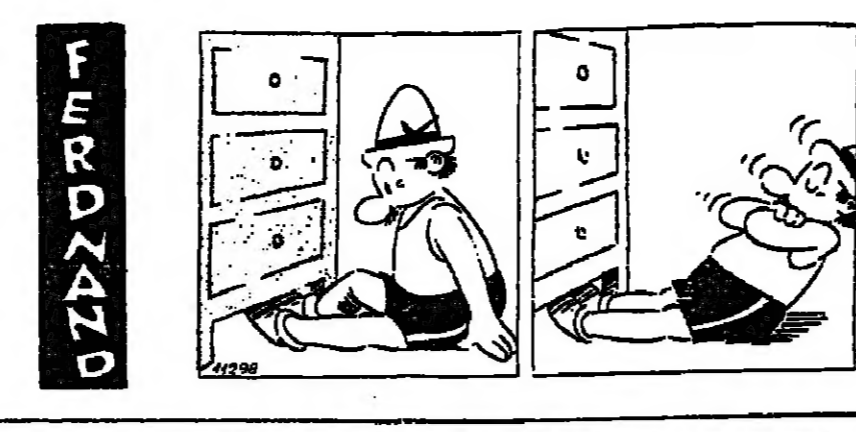

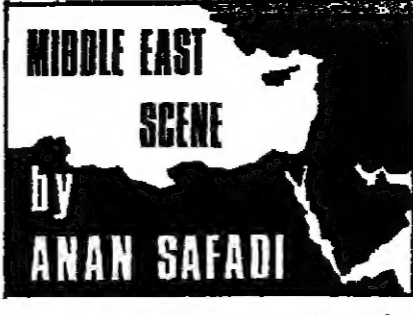

After Vietnam: China v. Russia

AS the Indochina war appears to be drawing to an uneasy close, tension between China and the Soviet Union is increasing again. The Soviet Union owes much of its influence in the East Asian region to its strong material and moral support of North Vietnam while remaining apparently eager for peace in Indochina. It is, therefore, anxious that its influence should not recede once the guns are stilled.

Chinese and Soviet troops clashed on their common border. The cudgels were taken up again when Chinese Vice-Foreign Minister Chiao Kuan-Hua, addressing the United Nations General Assembly in New York, fiercely criticized Moscow on a whole gamut of issues. This week, once more, and again at the U.N., he accused the Soviet Union of working with the U.S. to try to keep the world under their control.

ONE of the main developments which seem to be emerging from the current conference of the Arab Foreign and Defence Ministers in Kuwait appears to be Egypt's success in persuading the Arab states to back Cairo's acceptance of Security Council resolution 242, at a time when the U.N. is preparing to debate the Middle East crisis later this month.
