RECEIVER'S SALE VALUABLE SAMMILL PLANT

THE HOSTERMAN PROPERTY

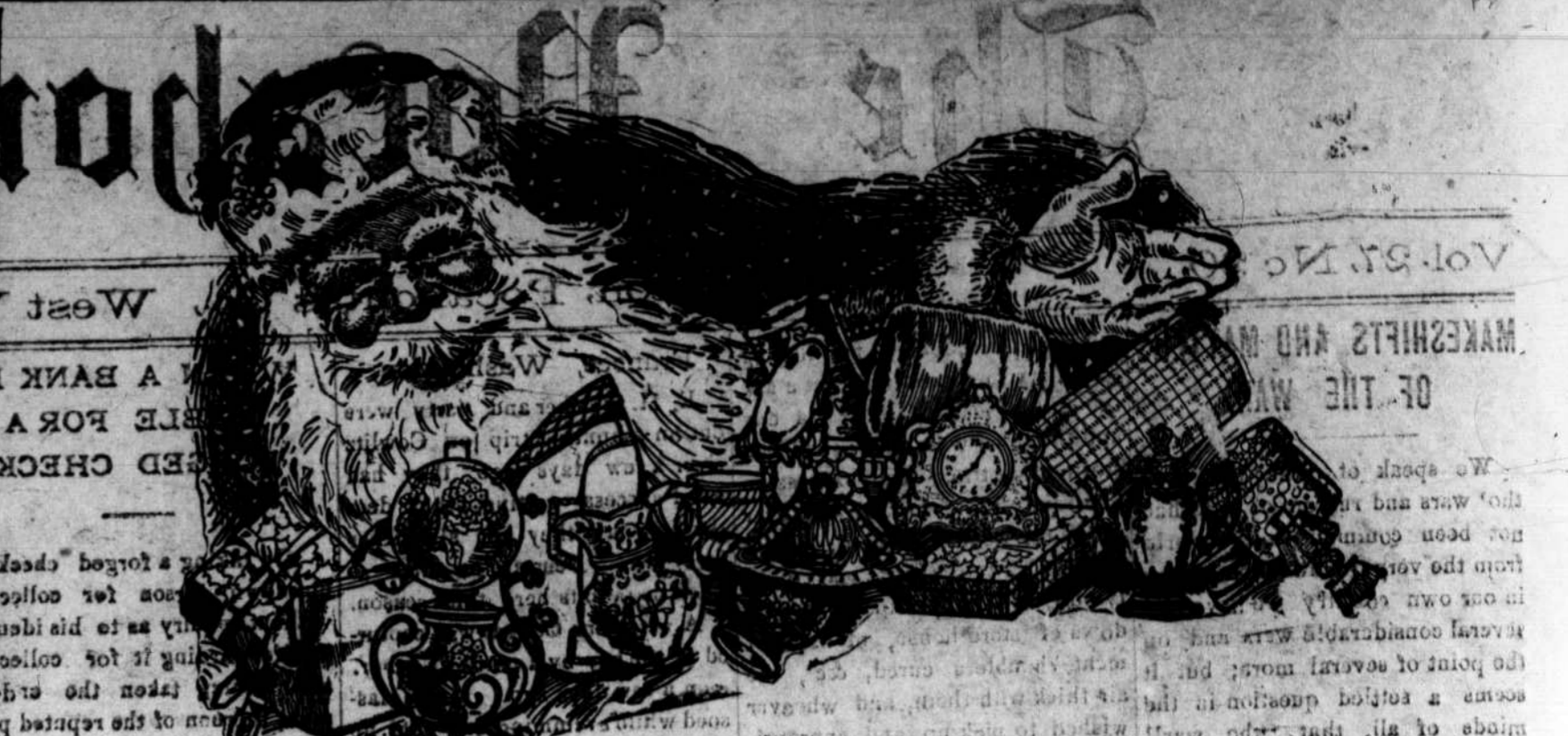
