USS Coral Sea (FHTNC)

The nine-week recruit training period covers physical fitness, basic military drill, customs and etiquette of the naval service, swimming and survival, first aid and a basic knowledge of shipboard routine.

During the training, recruits receive tests and interviews which will determine their future training in the Navy.

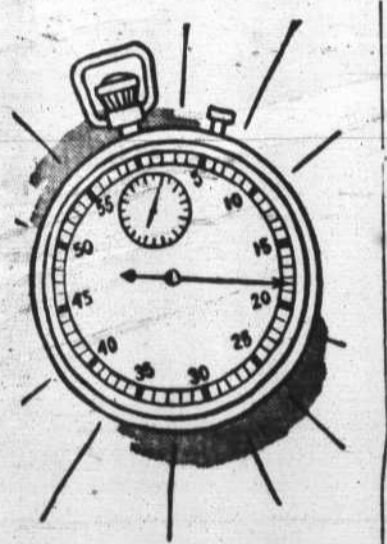
