






A Large assembly of believers prostrating themselves to Allah, the Exalted in a unique array, which clearly demonstrates their hum-bleness and submissiveness to Allah
















A picture depicting the large number of Muslims performing prayer around the Kaabah in perfect lines. No distinction is made between black and white, rich and poor, or elder and young












The entrance of the Kaabah, the door and the area of Multazam (i.e. area between the Black Stone and the door) are visible








A Picture of the inside area of the Prophet's Mosque


