



Some persons, although agreeing with this, maintain that better teachers could demand better wages. The other side contends that they have to have the better wages first, in order to attract the better teachers.

What is mostly overlooked in this matter, however, is the fact that most of the rest of the salaried people in Idaho are equally as underpaid as the teachers, compared to corresponding jobs in surrounding states. And, it is these other underpaid people who make up the bulk of the tax-payers in Idaho, and who will have to foot the bill-for-the-increased teachers' salaries.

It's all very well to advocate that the additional funds for education could be obtained by cutting down on some other state governmental appropriations, or by eliminating waste or nonessential programs in other areas, but that's not the way it works.

If the educational appropriations are increased, it usually turns out that other appropriations also get somewhat of an increase to soften the blow, or at least stay at the same level. And the taxpayer has to ante up a little bit more to foot the bill.

A report by the Associated Taxpayers of Idaho points out that a recent release by the U.S. Department of Commerce shows that Idaho, with 6.77 per tent of its personal income being used for public aducation, ranks second from the bottom of the old 11 Western States. On the other hand, compared to states east of the Western States boundaries, Idaho ranks 10th from the top, outranking such states as New York, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Massachusetts, Ohio, Illinois and Connecticut.

The problem, it is pointed out, is that Idaho is located on "High Street" and is trying to keep up with the Joneses (the other Western States) by increasing public expenditures rather than by increasing the cconomic base.
