This congregation was organized soon after the Civil War and was called the "Little Confederacy".

Before the church was built the congregation used an old log school house a little further up the creek.

Among the first members were:

W. A. Jeck, Susan Jeck, Isaac Hill, Sarah Hill, W. A. Bruffey, Lucy Bruffey.

The first preacher in this church was W. W. Wheeler. The present membership is about 100 persons with Rev. L. S. Shires of Millboro as pastor.
