
We finally made it such as it is. Howard Payne picked-up his 500 books this morning and was well pleased with the reproduction.

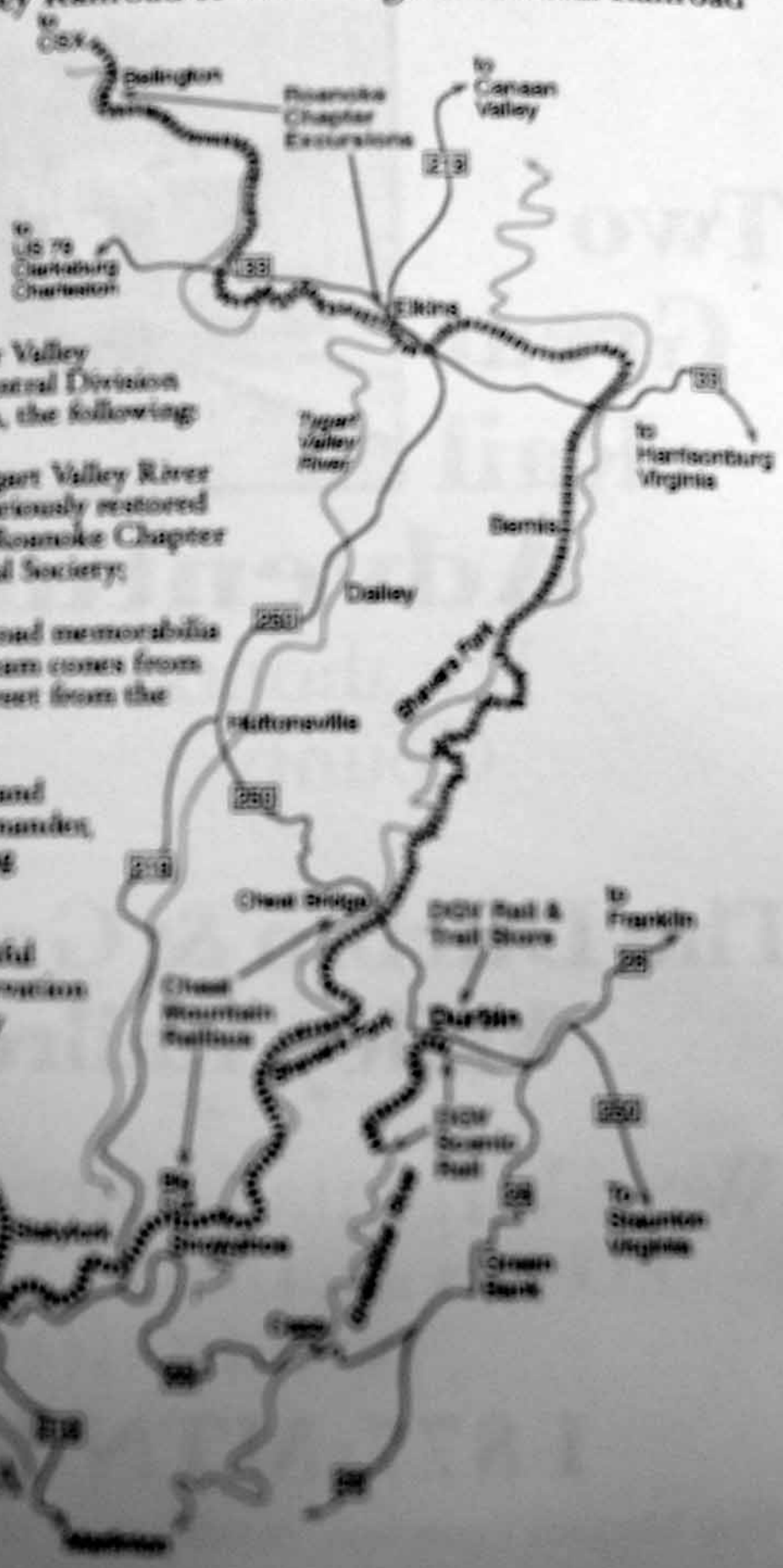
1999 Routes & Services

- Scenic tour along the beautiful Greenbrier River in an open observation car and restored saloons pulled by our faithful *Larry* engine.

Ride to the Top on the Cheat Mountain



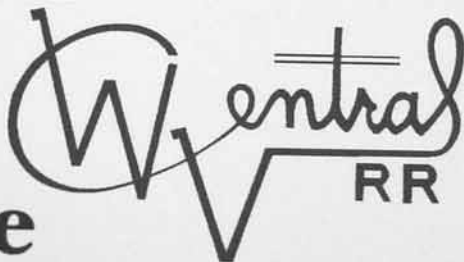
Salamander!

Our unique Leyland National R3 Railbus carries you on a stunning 35-mile mountain wilderness trek from Cheat Bridge to Big Cut. The *Salamander* crosses five bridges over a fisher's paradise – Shaver's Fork of the Cheat River. Scenery is dramatic, ever-



changing. The *Salamander* passes the abandoned logging town of Spruce on its way to the top of Big Cut. At 4,066 feet, it's the highest mainline rail in the east. Riders overlook an endless vista of West Virginia mountains. Even in August, you'll need a jacket at this altitude. Beat the heat on our new rail excursion!

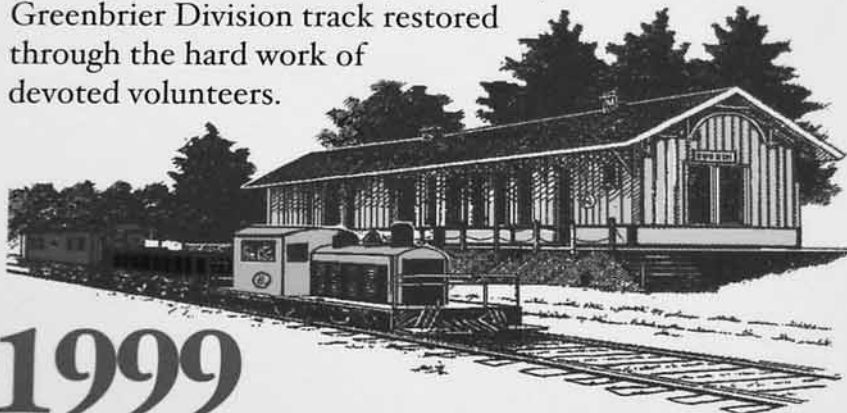

Friendly, Wilderness Scenic Railroad Adventures

Few places east of the Mississippi can compare with the remote and unspoiled Greenbrier River Valley in Pocahontas County, West Virginia. Guests ride an open observation car and restored 1920's cabooses pulled by Little LeRoi -- the type of antique engine featured in the children's classic *The Little Engine That Could*. The ninety minute ride meanders along this untamed river in the embrace of the Allegheny highlands. Keen-eyed travelers may spot wildlife including beaver, golden eagles and basking turtles. The tour operates on part of the C&O Greenbrier Division track restored through the hard work of devoted volunteers.
