3.75 (a) HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Structure: construction. Housing facilities for nonhuman primates must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound for the species of nonhuman primates housed in them. They must be kept in good repair.

Chimp Hill - Moose's group. Concrete floor of enclosure is cracked, and sanitation as required would not be possible. Cracking is extensive, several feet long and up to 1/2 inch in width. A system must be in place to ensure maintenance as necessary is completed.

3.127 (d) REPEAT FACILITIES, OUTDOOR.

The Perimeter fence must be constructed so that it protects the animals in the facility by restricting animals and unauthorized persons from going through it or under it and having contact with the animals in the facility, and so that it can function as a secondary containment system for the animals in the facility. It must be of sufficient distance from the outside of the primary enclosure to prevent physical contact between animals inside the enclosure and animals or persons outside the perimeter fence.

- Perimeter fence gate by the parrot cages was unlocked at time of inspection. There was no padlock in the area to indicate this gate was routinely locked, and no one was in the immediate area. The perimeter must be maintained in a secure fashion, and unlocked, unattended gates fail to do this.
 ORIGINAL CORRECTION DATE FOR PERIMETER FENCE: 2-15-06

- Perimeter gate by Cat Canyon had a large gap present, due to erosion under the gate. While an attempt had been made to block the gap with a large log, it was ineffective. The gap is large enough to allow access to animals the size of coyotes. The perimeter must be maintained in a secure fashion, including restricting animals from passing under it.
