## OFFICIAL RULES OF GOLF.

- 1) THE OBJECT OF THE GAME IS TO GET IN THE HOLE IN THE LEAST NUMBER OF STROKES. (FWOODN PAR)
- ② PLAYERS ARE ADVISED TO USE COVERS ON THEIR CLUBS AT ALL TIMES, ESPECIALLY WHEN PLAYING ON AN UNKNOWN COURSE WITH A PROFESSIONAL. FAILURE TO OBSERVE THIS RULE MAY HAVE SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES AND MAY RESULT IN SERIOUS DAMAGE TO A PLAYERS CLUB. (00-ER)
- 3 A RED FLAG IN ANY HOLE INDICATES THAT THE HOLE MUST NOT BE PLAYED FOR A FEW DAYS. (YAK-YAK!)
- ( A PLAYER SHOULD GREASE HIS CLUB OCCASIONALLY, ESPECIALLY WHEN PLAYING ON A NEW COURSE. (FNAR FNAR)
- S OLD BAGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE COURSE. (HO! HO!)
- 6 PRACTICE SWINGS WITH THE CLUB IN PRIVATE IS NOT ALLOWED. (EH?)
- D LOOSE IMPEDIMENTS AT THE FRONT OR REAR OF THE HOLE,
  MAY BE REMOVED IF INTERFERING WITH PLAY, EXCEPT WHEN A
  RED FLAG IS FLYING. (SEE RULE 3) (FWOODAR YURK YURK)
- A PLAYER'S CLUBHEAD MUST BE FIRMLY IN POSITION BEFORE CARRYING ON WITH THE FOLLOW THROUGH. (AMARF! AMARF!)
- 9 A PLAYER MAKING HIS APPROACH FROM THE REAR OF THE GREEN MUST TAKE CARE NOT TO END UP IN THE BUNKER BEHIND THE HOLE.
- OPLAYERS OBSERVING DISCOLOURATION OF THE BALLS SHOULD COCCEPECK RULE TWO. (HO! HO! EH? WUUUR)
- 1 IF A PLAYER'S BALLS BECOME CAUGHT IN THE ROUGH, HE MAY WITHDRAW AND TAKE THE STROKE AGAIN. (FNAK FNAK)
- O COURSE ETIQUETTE DEMANOS THAT NO PLAYER SHALL USE ANY PART OF HIS PARTNERS APPAREL FOR WIPING HIS CLUB AFTER PLAY. (AK! AK!) COLONIA
