Dear Gale,

Thanks for your okay on the project.

Your question was: "I don't really know what you would need out of SO#1 files. I would like to know that."

Data: The main thing I need out of SO#1 files is any data on Family members. These are Family (not Diana, Suzette and Arthur) who will be contacted for interviews.

These have a lot of anecdotal data which would be of great interest in a Biography.

Additionally there are various terminals who have been friends with LRH prior to Dianetics for whom SO#1 has files. Eg. Bob Heinlein; Isaac Asimov etc.

Pers Sec was extremely reluctant to give me any data from these files on Family members. She felt that it was better that I not see letters between (in this case) Katie and LRH. (Katie Gillespie, LRH's first daughter).

The fact is, the better I'm briefed on any of these terminals, the better I can handle them.

I am collecting names of early friends and Family and want to go through the SO#1 files to find whatever there is on these terminals which would be useful.

I know what I'm looking for for biographical data and to have someone else not as grooved in attempt to get it would result in a poor product,

And to have SO#1 guys do it would be very slow, as has been the case in the past.

LRH BIOGRAPHY

DOCUMENTATION FROM CW

INFORMATION: Documentation is being assembled for an LRH BIOGRAPHY which will be vital in bringing about international acceptance of LRH and his products. There is considerable documentation in CW which must be gotten now for this project.

PROJECT PERSONNEL: I/C Ens. G. Armstrong  
2nd Lise Taylor (P PRO CIC Int)

PRIMARY TARGETS:

1. Gather up all data known here on what we're looking for at CW, including names of people whose SO#1 files we want.
2. Info the P PRO Bu in advance of your arrival so the pjt 2nd<sup>A</sup> freed up and ready to help.
3. Info the I/C of each unit whose files you'll go through some days in advance so they're prepared for your arrival.
4. Get your travel arrangements all arranged.

VITAL TARGETS:

1. Work fast.
2. Get all the data on one trip.
3. Wear the hat of an LRH PRO at all times.

OPERATING TARGETS:

1. Go to Pers PRO Bu and info P PRO Int and P PRO Serv Int on what you'll be doing.
2. Get the Pjt 2nd set up to copy the docs as they are obtained. Ensure she fully understand what's wanted.

3. Visit Pers Sec Flag and brief her on the Biog, its importance and what's needed from her, R Comps and SO#1.

4. Give her the list of names whose SO#1 files we need. Assure her as to the confidentiality these files are given.

5. Get her to instruct her SO#1 juniors to also pull the files they know of for people not named but who fit these categories.

- A. Family
- B. Important contacts or friends
- C. Contacts or friends from before 1950

6. Go through each file and decide what is useful and to be copied.

7. Get a flow started to the project 2nd and get her copying.

8. As files are copied or finished with, get them returned safely to the unit they came from.

9. Get Pers Sec's files inventory, go over it and decide what files or particles we need.

10. Pull these and get them copied and returned.

11. Get together with R Comps I/C, brief her on the biog and its importance.

12. Go through any R Comps inventories and files which could apply to the biography and pull these files.

13. Get them copied and returned.

14. Get together with Pers Comm Flag, brief him on the project and its importance.

15. Get from him any inventories he has of materials he has (most files are off the property in CW).

16. Go through these, decide what is useful, pull these, get them copied and returned.

17. Check over the P PRO Bu files and see if there is anything there we don't have. If so, get it pulled, copied and returned.

18. Get together with whoever is responsible for the tape transcripts, brief them on the biog and its importance.

19. Work out with them lines and terminals so that biographical data from the tapes gets copied on a regular basis and sent to us for the Biog.

*19 a. Inform for photo of your flighted wingmen. Time - ETA.*

20. Visit the key terminals from Comps and SO#1 and ensure lines are set up for fast service from these units if anything is wanted in the future.

21. Review all targets and ensure everything complete and no further actions necessary.

22. Return from CW.

PRODUCTION TARGET: One week to complete the whole project.
