7. WORLD NEWS SUMMARY

TOKYO: Premier Eisaku Sato of Japan said yesterday that the Political repercussions of President Nixon's new economic policy were "serious" but that the United States remained the "pivot" of Japan's foreign policy. The preimer has stated that the fundamentals of Japan's relations with the United States remain unchanged.

SAIGON: The South Vietnamese Gov't announced yesterday that Vice-President Nguyen Cao Ky's name would be kept off the ballot in October and that the Presidential election would go on with only one candidate, President Nguyen Van Thieu. The decision was made by Mr. Theiu himself who as it stands now has eliminated even the possibility of a protest vote. A defeated deputy attempted to burn himself yesterday at the National Assembly Building in protest against the Government of Nguyen Van Theiu. He was stopped by police and a passerby before he could strike a match to his gasoline soaked clothing. The deptuy, Nguyen Dac Dan, is a supporter of Vice President Ky.

WASHINGTON: Men selected last month for possible induction into the armed forces next year had to begin reporting earlier this week for their physical examinations even though no authority exists now to draft them. A selective service spokesman said that this was being ordered in anticipation of the resumption of the draft which expired on June 30th. Both houses of Congress have agreed to EXTEND the draft law for TWO YEARS, but the measure has been stalled by disagreement over an anti-war ammendment. The drafts opponents said they would begin a filibuster when Congress returns next week.
