ETHICS PENALTIES

The following HCO FLs are cancelled:

HCO FL 26 Sept '67 Conditions for Sen Orgs Addition to Applying Formulas.

HCO FL 18 Oct '67 Issue IV Penalties for Lower Conditions.

HCO FL 20 Oct '67 Issue II Conditions Penalties New Employees and Persons Newly on Post.

HCO FL 6 Oct '67 Condition of Liability.

These penalty HCO FLs included loss of pay, grey rag etc as additional to the Conditions Formulas which still apply.

This cancellation is contemporary with the justice discovery that crime is the direct result of a lack of a hat and training on the hat and that a hat consists of a write up, checksheet and pack fully trained in on the person. (See Personnel Series.)

The target of Ethics is any neglect of org boarding or hatting and activity.

The motto is "Hat don't hit".

It is also part of this that I have concluded man cannot be trusted with justice.

The cancellation of Ethics penalties does not cancel a failure to provide an org board or to hat and train juniors or personnel as a Comm Ev offense nor does this cancellation cancel Conditions Formulas. It does cancel the penalties formerly assigned and as outlined in the cancelled Penalty Policy Letters listed above.
