My mother gave a similar story when she was interviewed on January 8, 1997 by Dr. Julie Kriegler, a psychologist working for my defense team.

I do not remember having seen the photograph at age 4. When I was perhaps about ten years old my regular pediatrician, Dr. Francis Wright (whom I remember with respect and affection), showed me the photograph (not in the presence of my mother) and remarked with a chuckle that I was quite a sight. And so I was. I clearly remember that in the picture I was puffy-looking and blotched with hives, but I felt no particular emotional response and I did not find the picture difficult to look at. I recall no indication that I was "pinned down," but I do not remember enough to assert that there was no such indication. The photograph apparently has not survived, so there is no way of resolving the question now.

⇒

As for the claim that my eyes were "crossed in fear," my mother told Dr. Kriegler that my eyes were crossed in the photograph and that they were never crossed at any other time. Characteristically,

my mother is remembering here only what it is convenient for her to remember. If my eyes were crossed in the photograph there is no particular reason to believe that fear had anything to do with it, since from earliest infancy I had a tendency to crossed eyes that I eventually outgrew, but not until I was at least six years old. Here are the relevant passages from the Baby Book and the medical records.

May, 1942: "... Slight strabismus [crossed eyes]..." (U Chi Med Records of TJK, p. 6.) This entry is undated, but its content makes clear that it refers to an examination made shortly after my birth.)

"THIRD WEEK. Dates, from June 5 [1942] to June [illegible]

"Eyes cross as he stares hard at lights or other bright objects." (Baby Book, p. 73.)

"FOURTH WEEK. Dates, from June [illegible] to June 19 [1942]

On March 13, 1997, in the Line-up room at the Sacramento County Main Jail, Dr. Julie Kriegler told me the following. My brother Dave told her (in late Feb., 1997) that he looked up to me, strove to emulate me, and as it were defined himself through his relationship to me. His self-image was the image of him that he saw "mirrored back" from me. But, he said, the image of him that I "mirrored back" was "impoverished" (his word). He also said that he felt he was "bullied" by me, even more in adulthood than when we were kids.

Information received from Gary Sowards and Scharlette Holdman, Feb 5, 1997. 3a

On September 6, 1996, in Gainesville, Florida, Scharlette Holdman and Scott Waller received the following information from Freda Tuominen (nee Dombek)

When I was hospitalized with an allergic reaction in March, 1943, Freda was away on vacation. When she returned, someone mentioned that I had been in the hospital. Then she heard nothing further about the hospital occurrence until it was publicized in the media following my arrest.

Later Freda said she wasn't sure she was on a vacation; she might have been out of touch with my family for a while because she was occupied with her college work. But she confirmed that she'd been told nothing about my "hospital experience" apart from the bare statement that I'd been in the hospital.

Dr. Kriegler told me this on March 29, 1997, in the line-up room.

There was no "permission" to talk with parents about internal struggles. If someone had attempted it, he says it would have been "objectified as an idea. Moved back into intellectual realm." 8

Response to emotion was "infantilization" — i.e. ~~em~~ emotion was seen as weak or feminine.

11/21/96 Interview in same place. In general, he characterized the family ~~of~~ as not talking about "~~what~~ what was really going on." ~~Example:~~ Not talking about personal issues. When Dave was living at home he had a "breakup" with Linda. He tried to talk to ma about it, and she gave "~~pat~~ ~~answers~~", answered with "pat stuff", no empathy.

12/10/96 Linda. Tempers flare between Mom and Benny. (Freda said doesn't recall that happening until Ben got acromegaly.) Family exp like Ben going to war were not talked about or through.

1/9/97 Wanda. Once got mad at me so that she threw 1 or 2 glasses at ~~me~~ the washing machine.

2/27/97 Dave. Says I called my ~~ma~~ names like "fat pig" and she would scream back at me.

I then read the words back to Gary, and he confirmed that I had them right.
