NCE OUR COMPANY GOALS HAVE been set for the following year, members of your Home Office management team put our heads together to discuss theme ideas that fit the goals. The theme is not a goal itself; rather, it's an attitude, a mindset to guide us toward achieving our goals. #OwnIt is our "marching order" to accomplish the objectives laid out for 2019.

I can compress this year's goals into one word: GROWTH. To paraphrase P.T. Barnum, without *growth*, something terrible happens ... nothing. 'Nothing' is not enough for AIL/NIL-ICO; not enough for YOU, the World's Greatest Sales Force. Growth is a privilege. Many people work in professions where it is very hard to measure growth. Many professions are subjective, while we have the privilege of working in 30%. This is a great framework for you to plan an industry where it is entirely objective.

Our goal this year is to encourage growth in every sense of the word both personally and professionally. When we grow personally, it translates into growth professionally, and that means growing the number of working families we help and growing the number of folks we bring in to Opportunity Unlimited. It starts with each of us as individuals. After all, this Company is nothing more than driven, dedicated, passionate individuals united in purpose. All greatness starts with the power of ONE multiplied.

The best way to encourage more of the activities that will bring about growth for the Company is to help YOU grow your income by enhancing the structure of our main bonuses to focus squarely on — what else? — GROWTH.

One of the most exciting changes we've made to the bonus payouts is the increase in the WGB bonus percentages available, once again proving that it really is the World's Greatest Bonus! The new bonus is a monthly bonus paid weekly. Each month, all net ALP over \$1,000 will be bonused at 10%-20% according to month-to-date ALP levels or 'tiers' achieved. The 20% bonus rate is for MTD net ALP greater than \$12,000 in a month, so it makes sense to get to \$12,000 Net ALP each month as quickly as you can. If you are a veteran agent with top quality, ALP greater than \$12,000 is bonused at 20% plus a retention boost up to

your productivity for the month.

The SA/GA Field Training Bonus has also been beefed up. The payout has been increased from 150% to 175% for associates in their first 8 weeks. Wow!

MGAs and RGAs with a growth mindset will be rewarded with a Quarterly Growth Bonus of 10% or 20% on growth dollars written that quarter. Percentages are set based on tenure as an MGA and production levels. There is also a 'code kicker' that adds an additional 5%-35% increase on bonus earned based on the number of new associates over the previous year or quarter.

RGAs doing an exceptional job of coaching their MGAs to grow are eligible for the RGA Quarterly Growth Bonus. The bonus is a percentage of the MGAs' bonuses with the RGAs having the opportunity to earn between 35%-55% of what their MGAs earn in their bonuses for the quarter.

These enhancements to the bonus structures provide powerful incentive to grow whether you're an agent or in a leadership position! Be sure to thank your Executive Council, specifically the Bonus Committee, for their input and guidance on the enhancements.

eApp business and paper applications subject to the 7 day hold should be uploaded or sent to Home Office by **Thursday** 2/21 before 3:30 p.m. CST. Paper apps excluded from the 7 day hold and PR credits should be sent to Home Office by Tuesday 2/26. eApp business excluded from the 7 day hold should be uploaded by Thursday 2/28 before 3:30 p.m. CST to count for **February** production.

eApp cutoff has been extended to 3:30 p.m. CST every Wednesday, Thursday, and last day of the calendar month to allow more business to load before the weekly advance and end-of-month AP&P cutoff. All other days of the week remain the standard 2:00 p.m. CST cutoff time.

AIL Extends Lay-Off Waiver to Government Employees during Government Shutdown

Members of AIL's Public Relations Team showed up in Washington, DC in support of federal government workers impacted by the shutdown.

AlL extended its lay-off waiver of premium to federal employees who had been working with no pay or furloughed due to the 35-day government shutdown, the longest in U.S. history. Although not a qualified lay-off, the Company made the exception as a show of support to the more than 800,000 hard-working men and women affected by the shutdown.

The spending bill President Trump signed on Friday, January 25 to temporarily end the partial government shutdown only funds affected agencies until February 15. Trump said the odds congressional negotiators will craft a deal to end his border wall standoff with Congress are "less than 50-50." There is a 90-day maximum for the waiver of premium feature; we are hopeful the issues will be resolved prior to the

In addition to the premium waiver, Underwriting and Policy Issue will allow extensions for outstanding items and Customer Service will work with our federal employee policyholders to avoid any lapse of their insurance coverage.

who wrote more than 30 books that have been translated into more than 30 languages and sold millions of copies. His highest selling books, *The Chronicles of Narnia*, have been popularized on stage, TV, radio and cinema. One of the main themes throughout these books and the movies is *courage*.

C.S. Lewis says "There are far better things ahead than any we leave behind." This is the definition of courage. No one can go back in time to change what has happened and it's critically important to continue improving ourselves so we are able to progress as a company in 2019 and beyond.

Courage is a habit and the more we practice it, the stronger it gets. Being courageous

isn't about pretending bad things don't happen but about choosing to lay our vulnerability on the line for something greater than our pride. Risking failure and rejection in order to pursue our greatest aspirations creates the most truthful and meaningful lives. It begins by being clear about what we want most and identifying the fear(s) that hold us back. Unless we own our fears they will own us.

We need to break our big vision – \$1 billion sales and 2 million leads – into smaller steps. Where we are now isn't where we ultimately want to be. That first step forward is knowing the direction we want to go and knowing exactly where the finish line is. No one can ascend a staircase with one step. Define what your goal for 2019 is and break it down into smaller, more attainable goals by quarter, month, week and day ... step-by-step, day-by-day.

Being courageous isn't just about the initial action in advancing toward our vision. It's the daily activities and the mindset to hold ourselves accountable to do what needs to be done. For the PR team, we know that we must be intentional in every field activity. For ex-

ample, showing up to a union picket line and blending with the others doesn't provide us the visibility with the group the action should create. We hold ourselves accountable to make sure the group leaders know we are there to support their members and lead the picket from the front.

Leading from the front also means that all eyes are on us whether we win or learn. Obviously, the goal of any team is to win every game they play but even the best teams stumble. The first season of the NFL began in 1920 – almost 100 years ago! Since 1920, there has only been one team – the 1972 Miami Dolphins – to not lose a game in the regular season or playoffs. There's not been a team in the other professional sports to even come close to having a perfect season.

My hope is that 2019 is *your* "perfect season" and you only win. If you find yourself with 'learning opportunities' this year, I encourage you to reap the lessons from the situation and have the courage to move forward as a better version of yourself than you are today. ②







MONG THE LESSONS WE learned last year is the importance of placing pressure on the process to #OWN our results. Conceptually, we have 52 opportunities to influence results in 2019; how our mindset and actions approach challenges that lie ahead of us will be the difference maker in terms of results. Let's take a look at several key call-to-action thought processes and methods to ensure a strong start to 2019.

Will we maximize the exciting 2019 bonus opportunities and, most importantly, *how* can we maximize bonus potential every week?

Regardless of where we are in our career with American Income or National Income Life we all have opportunities to become more effective and efficient in maximizing bonus levels. We must first understand and know *why* maximizing our bonus results is important, which means we start with the end in mind as a business owner.

Start with personalizing and writing down highly specific goal(s). One study conducted by the *Statistics Brain Research Institute*, which researches New Year's Resolutions, suggests that only 8% of people

achieve their New Year's goals; essentially a 92% fail rate. Of the 8% who did succeed, the majority wrote down specific goals along with dates to encourage strong accountability. What has always separated results is becoming emotional with goals that we have chosen to pursue.

A great piece of advice given to me in my almost two decades in the business is: set goals big enough that they scare you but small enough to implement every day. In other words, if goals do not move or excite an individual, they are destined to fail. Nobody — and I mean nobody — can get more excited, prepare for, approach tasks stronger, get excited, or have a positive mindset more than you, the individual who drafted the goals. It is at this level that we become passionate and own every result that is by our name.

General Stanley A. McChrystal, retired leader of American & NATO Forces is famously know for citing "death by the PowerPoint" when referencing missions for our military. That is because the concept of a PowerPoint gives us the illusion that we understand the mission. Because we have PowerPoints and documents that explain missions, generally speaking we assume that people understand the mission. Good to reference, bad to explain... Do not rely on a document to carry the mission of explaining the power of a wellthought out mission that positions the client, agent, manager, agency, and company to win in 2019. The key is to develop a plan; this becomes how the process is carried out.

When referencing a plan of attack there is a higher probability to gain traction if we talk in examples. We can better understand examples that illustrate common themes we associate with on a day-to-day basis, and we are able to decompress action items needed to accomplish our goal. We are leaders in some capacity whether we are in a position of management or an agent. The making of a strong leader is having the ability to simplify a well thought out plan to influence results. In other words, paint a verbal picture that portrays the mission you are trying to accomplish.

Finally, we all need scoreboards to guide and hold us accountable to what we agreed upon. Tracking our activity to manage unmet expectations is a critical part to any plan so we can **adjust when needed**. For example, if our current plan of action is yielding the desired results, continue to revisit those specific goals and stay upbeat and energetic, keep on keeping on! In some cases, we can adjust our goals to a higher benchmark if we are progressing within our process.

On the other hand, if we do not succeed in our activity to achieve our desired results we must take immediate action and adjust our approach and process to get back on track. The great news about adjustments in our business is that we have complete control over our mindset and activity; thus positively influencing desired results.

As we aspire to be the very best version of ourselves in 2019, let's start with #Owning the very best of our process as leaders. ②

JIM "DIAMOND JIM" GENTILE

The BUSINESS ATTEMPT





SOMETIMES IT TAKES YEARS FOR A *Diamond* **To shine.**

That is exactly the case in the career of **JIM GENTILE**. The Brooklyn Dodgers signed Gentile to a contract right out of high school in 1952. "In August when I showed up with my team in Fort Worth, they asked if I wanted to play first base or pitch. I chose first," he says simply. Thus, the big lefty embarked on a successful, yet at times, wildly frustrating career as a power hitter in professional baseball.

Gentile stood 6'3," weighing more than 210 pounds with such a **FEROCIOUS SWING** that team management asked him to wear a sponge on his hip so he wouldn't bruise his bone when the bat whipped around his body. During the next 7 years while in the Dodger organization, Gentile would find himself ranked behind one of the greatest first basemen ever to play the game, Gil Hodges, which displaced Gentile to the Minors.

Roy Campanella was one of the leaders in the clubhouse for the Dodgers. "Roy was one of

my friends," Gentile remembers. "We'd go out to dinner and I'd say, 'Campy, I understand Gil is the best first baseman in the National League, but I want to play.' He just said, 'When the time comes, you have to take advantage of it."

It was during this time Campanella coined the nickname 'DIAMOND JIM' for Gentile, saying he was a diamond in the rough. Those words could not be any more fitting; the following year, the Dodgers traded Gentile to the Baltimore Orioles, and it was time for the Diamond to shine.

And now that he had earned his first full season in the Big Leagues, he was not going to waste his **OPPORTUNITY OF A LIFETIME!**

As you step up to the plate in 2019, do you have the same desire to **#OWNIT** as it took Gentile to make his way to the Majors? Are

you as **COMMITTED TO YOUR CAREER** as he was? If you are, it will pay off as it did for Diamond Jim in the following years as he made a name for himself with his **RESULTS.**

In his Rookie year in the Big Leagues (think: first year in management or as a SGA), Gentile was voted to the All-Star team and finished 2nd for **ROOKIE OF THE YEAR** with 21 HR and 98 RBI. That set the table for his second season, which firmly etched his name in baseball history with the likes of Mickey Mantle, Roger Marris, Ted Williams, and Willie Mays.

Gentile's best season ever was in 1961. He led the American League with 141 RBI and hit 46 home runs, including a new American League season record for FIVE GRAND SLAMS. The most unforgettable moment of the '61 season came on May 9 when he hit grand slams in two consecutive innings in a single game, setting a record that stood for 26 years. His season-long effort landed him in the MVP balloting, where he placed third behind Roger Marris and Mickey Mantle. If you've been with AIL/NILICO for a while, you may remember that back in 2016, the difference between the #1 SGA and the #2 SGA in Category I was .4%. It's not failure when you're rubbing shoulders with the best of the best!


Gentile went on to play in the majors for another 7 years before ending his career in baseball. Any time he is asked about the key to his success in the Big Leagues, he answers the same every time and it is the same answer he would give me growing up: "Son, your name is all you have in the world, no one was ever going to say, 'Gentile didn't make it' to me. I don't care how much effort and time it takes.

MAKE SURE ANY TIME YOUR HAME IS MENTIONED, IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU **NEVER GAVE**UP ON ANYTHING."

To be eligible for the bonus, SA/GA must have the required number of direct new associates. The bonus will be calculated as a percentage of the total weekly World's Greatest Bonus earned by new associates in their first 180 days under an SA or GA. The SA/GA must have the required quality factor to be eligible for the bonus. SA/GA must have \$6,000 of personal Gross ALP in the prior two months to be eligible for bonus in current month.

MGA GROWTH BONUS

The quarterly **MGA Growth Bonus** offers incentives for both veteran and rookie MGAs. For MGA Veterans (promoted prior to 2018), the MGA Growth Bonus is calculated on 2019 calendar guarter Net ALP growth over same guarter 2018. Bonus eligibility requires a minimum benchmark of \$60,000 Net ALP production same quarter 2018 with a higher bonus percentage starting at a benchmark of \$150,000 Net ALP production same quarter 2018. For MGA Rookies (promoted 2018 or after), the bonus is calculated on growth over the previous calendar quarter Net ALP with a minimum benchmark of \$60,000 Net ALP production previous calendar quarter. Eligibility requires completing two full calendar quarters as an MGA, with calendar quarters starting Jan 1, Apr 1, Jul 1 and Oct 1.

There is also a **New Associate Boost** where MGAs can earn up to an additional 35% of the MGA Growth Bonus, For MGA Veterans, the New Associate Boost is based on the number of new associates over the same quarter 2018 with a minimum benchmark of 6 new associates each quarter until the rookie's 5th quarter. For MGA Rookies, the New Associate Boost is based on the number of new associates over the prior calendar quarter with a minimum benchmark of 6 new associates the prior calendar quarter until the rookie's 5th quarter.

MGA Veteran Example:

Otr 1 2018 Net ALP — \$172,351

Qtr 1 2019 Net ALP — \$205,753

Qtr 1 2018 benchmark = \$172,351.

Growth is calculated by subtracting: \$205,753 - \$172,351 = \$33,402 growth \$33,402 growth x 20% (because benchmark was over \$150,000) = **\$6,680.40**

Otr 1 2018 New Associates — 15

Qtr 1 2019 New Associates — 18

Otr 1 2018 benchmark = 15.

Growth is calculated by subtracting 18-15 = 3

3 new associates growth is eligible for a 15% boost.

\$6,680.40 growth bonus x 15% = \$1,002.06 associate boost

Total payout for Qtr1 2019: \$6,680.40 + 1002.06 = \$7,682.46

MGA Rookie Example:

Promotion Date: 6/15/2018

Qtr 2 2018 is a partial guarter, Qtr 3 2018 is full guarter 1, Qtr 4 2018 is full guarter 2

Qtr 4 2018 Net ALP — \$58,235

Qtr 1 2019 Net ALP — \$72,577

Qtr 4 2018 benchmark = \$60,000 minimum.

Growth is calculated by subtracting \$72,577-\$60,000 = \$12,577 growth

\$12,577 growth x 10% = **\$1,257.70**

Qtr 4 2018 New Associates — 5

Qtr 1 2019 New Associates — 7

Qtr 4 2018 benchmark = 6 minimum.

Growth is calculated by subtracting 7-6=1

1 new associate growth is eligible for a 5% boost.

\$1257.70 growth bonus x 5% = \$62.89 associate boost

Total payout for Qtr1 2019: \$1257.70 + 62.89 = \$1,320.59

PGA GROWTH BONUS

The quarterly **RGA Growth Bonus** is calculated as a percent of the total MGA Growth Bonus received by MGAs within the RGA's hierarchy. The percentage paid is based on the number of hierarchy MGAs who receive an MGA growth bonus that quarter. Net-to-gross/retention standards apply to eligibility and bonus payout based on RGA tenure.

Example:

RGA has 5 MGAs under their hierarchy

MGA1 does not qualify for growth bonus

MGA2 does qualify for growth bonus: MGA2 Total Payout for Qtr1 2019 = \$1,142.18

MGA3 does qualify for growth bonus: MGA3 Total Payout for Qtr1 2019 = \$1,383.47

MGA4 does qualify for growth bonus: MGA4 Total Payout for Qtr1 2019 = \$967.83

MGA5 does qualify for growth bonus: MGA5 Total Payout for Qtr1 2019 = \$1,755.66

Because RGA had 4 MGAs qualify for growth bonus, RGA receives 50% of MGA's growth bonus

RGA Total Payout for Qtr1 2019: $$5,249.14 \times 50\% = $2,624.57$


