#### Total Bonuses Paid Out

This month AIL and NILICO paid a total of \$727,600.52 in bonuses. For more information on the monthly bonuses, turn to Pages 9 and 22.

#### Required Retention Rate

Effective Jan. 1, 2005, to be eligible for bonuses and featured in *Spotlight*, Producers must meet the required Retention rate or the minimum Net to Gross. The Net to Gross rate varies based on bonus guidelines. The rate listed below is for *Spotlight* recognition only. Net to Gross is used only during the Producer's first eight months.

Retention: 68% Net to Gross: 78%

The asterisks, shown throughout the magazine, indicate that place will be a year-to-date award winner. The Producers, who will be recognized at the 2006 Awards Presentation, are: the top SGA from each category, the top two PR Managers, the top two PR Representatives from each category, the top RGA, the top five MGAs, the top five GAs, the top SA, and the top ten Individual Producers. Check your production! If there is an asterisk by your position, you could be on your way to the AIL/NILICO 55th Annual Convention! The convention will be held July 27-30, 2006.

Applications defined as "controlled business" are applications written on an Agent, the Agent's immediate family, or where the Agent is the payor on the policy. We do not advance the Agent on controlled business sales and no production credit is given.

Here is a simple definition of who would be considered controlled business:

- Agent
- · Parents
- Siblings
- Spouse
- Children
   Grandparents
- Aunt
- Uncle
- · Cousin



You are responsible for marking controlled business so it is easily distinguished. At the top of every controlled business application, please mark "Controlled Business." In addition, the transmittal has a blank for the listing of controlled business. Please mark this blank as well.

Save yourself confusion down the road by keeping these definitions handy and marking your controlled business.





## Taking PR to the Summit

Our company has made so many strides over the past five years — incredible growth from \$50 million in annualized life premium sales to almost \$100 million in annualized life sales! But the amazing thing is that while the Agent count went from 1,000 in 1999 to 2,100 in 2005, the size of the PR Team actually decreased by ten PR Representatives.

We currently have about 115 Public Relations Representatives under contract. We have ambitious plans to contract with 150 P.R. Representatives by the end of this year, and 200 by the end of 2006. With this hiring drive, we estimate our ability to increase annual hard card lead flow from 950,000 to over 1,500,000 leads annually.

Along with this hiring emphasis comes an improved plan to train our new hires and assist many territories in Public Relations management. When a new Public Relations Representative is hired, they will have the opportunity to be trained by a PR Mentor. PR Mentors are veterans from the field who will be compensated to take a new hire under their wings to provide both initial and ongoing training.

We also have a Public Relations Directors Program that is just beginning. With this program, the best of the best from our current PR producers are actually becoming PR Managers. They are contracting with the company directly to manage Public Relations in territories where (especially new) SGAs don't have a whole lot of Public Relations experience. They work for the territory SGA in helping with hiring, training, group assignments, lists management, and contributions.


Certainly both the Mentors and the Directors Program are optional to all involved. They create a new method to help in growing a stronger and more productive PR Team. However, one very important aspect of making lead growth work will be experimenting with and creating successful marketing templates in the non-traditional leads field. Instead of just bringing in PR Representatives to focus on what's left in the labor market, the bulk of our new Public Relations hires will be trained in marketing methods for new and fresh lead sources!

Finally, your corporate office has assembled an unparalleled team to provide the leadership to make this growth program a success. Denise Bowyer will continue to be essentially responsible for field operations and Kathy Lockhart will handle all of the administrative aspects of American Income and National Income Public Relations. I am also pleased to announce that we have recently hired Jay Bentley to work from our Home Office to be responsible for all organizational aspects of Public Relations growth and management.

Jay is a former American Incomer, having served the Company in a variety of capacities in the 1980's. 
