#### Required Retention Rate

Effective Jan. 1, 2006, to be eligible for bonuses and featured in *Spotlight*, Producers must meet the required Retention or the minimum Net to Gross. Net to Gross varies based on bonus guidelines. The rates listed below are for *Spotlight* recognition only. Net to Gross is used only during the Producer's first eight months.

Retention: 68% Net to Gross: 78%

#### National Do Not Call Registry

We would like to remind everyone of the National No Call Registry and regulations which became effective October 1, 2003. Established through efforts by the Federal Trade Commission, the Federal Communications Commission, and State officials, the National Do Not Call Registry is a list of telephone numbers from consumers who have indicated their preference not to receive selephone solicitation calls. CAS should be utilized to purge individuals who have registered and requested not to be called. Please make sure your Agency is aware of the law and our Company guidelines for compliance.
