Required Retention Rate

Effective Jan. 1, 2007, to be eligible for bonuses and featured in *Spotlight*, Producers must meet the required Retention or the minimum Net to Gross. Net to Gross varies based on bonus guidelines. The rates listed below are for *Spotlight* recognition only. Net to Gross is used only during the Producer’s first eight months.

Retention:	68%
Net to Gross:	78%

National Do Not Call Registry

We would like to remind everyone of the National Do Not Call Registry and regulations which became effective Oct. 1, 2003. Established through efforts by the Federal Trade Commission and State officials, the National Do Not Call Registry is a list of telephone numbers from consumers who have indicated their preference not to receive telephone solicitation calls. CAS should be utilized to purge individuals who have registered and requested not to be called. Please be sure your Agency is aware of the law and our Company guidelines for compliance. More information about the DNC registry can be found online at our Agency Resource Center.

Get Your Materials Approved

Our Company policy requires all material your Agency may be using, if not provided by AIL or NILICO, to be forwarded to our office for review. All lead letters must be approved prior to mailing.

In addition to lead letters, any forms used, presentation, phone scripts, or letters sent to a policyholder regarding AIL or NILICO should be sent to the Home Office first for review. Once we complete the review, we will send your approval confirmation.

Protecting Our Policyholders

The protection of our applicant's and policyholder's personal health and financial information is an important topic to make every person in your agency aware of. As a representative for American Income or National Income, you are in contact with this protected information, so it is very important to be familiar with the Company's Privacy Policy. Our privacy policy is posted at both www.aillife.com and www.nillife.com. A copy of our Privacy Policy is also included with Home Office correspondence and every policy issued in the U.S. and Canada.

Here are some examples of protected non-public personal information: names, addresses, telephone numbers, bank/financial information, occupation, etc. The privacy laws do not prohibit the normal exchange of information that is necessary in order for an insurer to conduct its normal course of business. In other words, you should supply the Company with the information necessary to issue new business, pay claims, etc. However, even a list of policyholder names and addresses from a CAS database is considered non-public personal information, and disclosure to any non-affiliated third party is prohibited.

Medical information is highly protected. For instance, if you have received medical information about an insured when you completed their application or helped them complete a claim form, you are prohibited from disclosing that information even to their spouse unless the insured has given specific consent that their spouse may receive the information. Never discuss medical/claim information with a fellow Agent or any Home Office employee unless they are involved with Underwriting or the payment of the claim. It is permissible to indicate to a union that we have paid 'so many' claims for 'so many dollars', but you must never disclose any personal information such as we paid 'John Doe' and 'Betty Smith.'

Please be aware that you come in contact daily with protected information. You must be vigilant not to disclose this information in a way which violates privacy laws and should ensure the privacy of the data by shredding all personal data that is discarded. Please be sure and include Privacy Awareness as a part of your training!

TRAINING CHAMPIONS

At the PR Summit and LDS in Waco



Nothing is more important than giving our field force the training and tools they need to succeed. Each year, various seminars and events give the attendees the opportunity to learn from the very best AIL/NILICO has to offer.

On Jan. 18-20, 2007, PR Reps from across AIL/NILICO fought atrocious weather and flight delays to attend the PR Summit in Waco, Texas. The first day was geared toward training for new PR Reps, including discussions on emerging markets, the Circle of Success, the marketing resources available to them, and PR Reports. The afternoon was dedicated to specialized credit union training, taught by guest speaker Kathy Robinson, Senior Vice President of Legacy Community FCU. The second day included a full day Strategic Account Sales workshop, something never before offered to the PR Reps. This workshop taught and refined various sales skills such as prospecting, getting past the gatekeeper, overcoming objections, getting to "yes" and maintaining an ongoing relationship with our customers. Nobody left without something new to add to their skill set or their knowledge base.

Our most recent Leadership Development Seminar occurred Feb. 6-8, 2007. 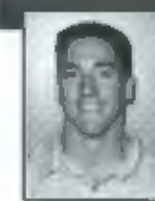

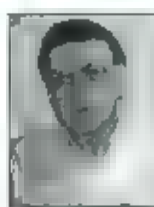

SO, YOU WANT A PROMOTION?

Almost everyone asks themselves how they can get ahead in their careers. If you are in the minority who do not want a promotion, then this is not the article for you

There are basically five ways to get promoted. The four listed below are standards for almost every situation.

- **Work hard.** Top producers are almost always the logical choice for the next promotion. As a top producer, you have established yourself as someone worthy of the job, and no one should be surprised when you're the boss' choice for the next promotion.
- **Make a single outstanding contribution** so great the company must reward you for it. At American Income and National Income, an innovative presentation or script developed and forwarded to the whole company would make a tremendous impact and would definitely put you on the radar for a promotion.
- **Grab the shirttails of a superstar** and have them pull you up the ladder behind them. Be their right-hand person. They will take you on their journey, and you will likely get their position after they leave as a promotion by default
- **Be in the right place at the right time.** This method requires a little more skill than it infers. Spot where the next opening will occur and make yourself available. However, acknowledge this method also needs luck!

In all four of the scenarios listed just now, one thing is key: be sure the decision-makers relative to the promotion know you want to be a candidate. In fact, it is a logical first step. Go to your supervisors and let them know what career track you want. Keep this analogy in mind — it is easier to get the train to the station if the conductor knows the route.

Now, let me give you the fifth and last path to promotion. This method has two options, both specific to AIL/NILICO.

- **Go to your SGA** and say you want to be an MGA and specialize in non-union leads, such as discount cards, Globe leads, etc. Express you are willing to build a team around this specific lead type. Your request will get real consideration if you are willing to commit
- **Go to your SGA** and request permission to open your own office. Vocalize your willingness to relocate if necessary. Take the management fast track and learn to recruit. Be the best leader!

I can make you a promise. If you focus on any of the first four tactics I illustrated, you will receive a promotion before the end of 2007. Give the fifth method a try, however, and I will bet you can achieve your dreams of promotion twice as fast.

Who said there's less room at *the top*?
