



HOW TO COMPETE -

So, how do you get to attend this incredible dream come true? The top people in the following categories will be eligible to win, based on their business submitted (processed by the Home Office) between January 1, 2007 and June 30, 2007. Please note: all winners must meet Company 4-month retention and net to gross requirements in order to become eligible.

SGAs: The top SGA in each category (one winner from Categories 1-6 plus the top new SGA from either Category 7 or 8) based on the average of their percent of Net ALP production growth, their percent of 1st 6-month agent production standard, and their percent of code standard. Each qualifying SGA must have been an SGA for the full 6-month contest period.

RGAs, MGAs, GAs, and SAs: The winners for each rank (top RGA, top three MGAs, top three GAs, and top SA) will be the ones with the most Net ALP produced by new Agents coded under them during the 6-month contest period. Personal Producers: The winners will be the Top 10 personal producers based on Net ALP produced and processed within the 6-month contest duration.

PR Reps: The contest time frame will be one month longer to allow time for printing and mailing. The contest period will be January 1, 2007 through July 31, 2007. The top person in Category A and the top from Category B will be those with the most cards. To be eligible, at least 30 percent of the cards must be from original groups, and the evaluation will be on cards processed by the Home Office within the contest duration. The top PR Rep from Category C will be eligible based on the number of groups submitted. Each group must have a minimum of 50 memory and a 3 peneral card rown in order to count, and at least 30 percent of the groups must be originals.


