Required Retention Rate

Effective Jan. 1, 2007, to be eligible for bonuses and featured in *Spotlight*, Producers must meet the required Retention or the minimum Net to Gross. Net to Gross varies based on bonus guidelines. The rates listed below are for *Spotlight* recognition only. Net to Gross is used only during the Producer's first eight months.

Retention:	68%
Net to Gross:	78%

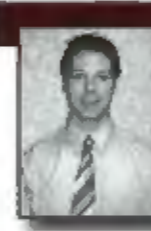

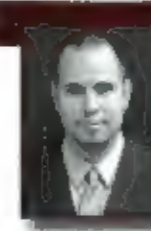

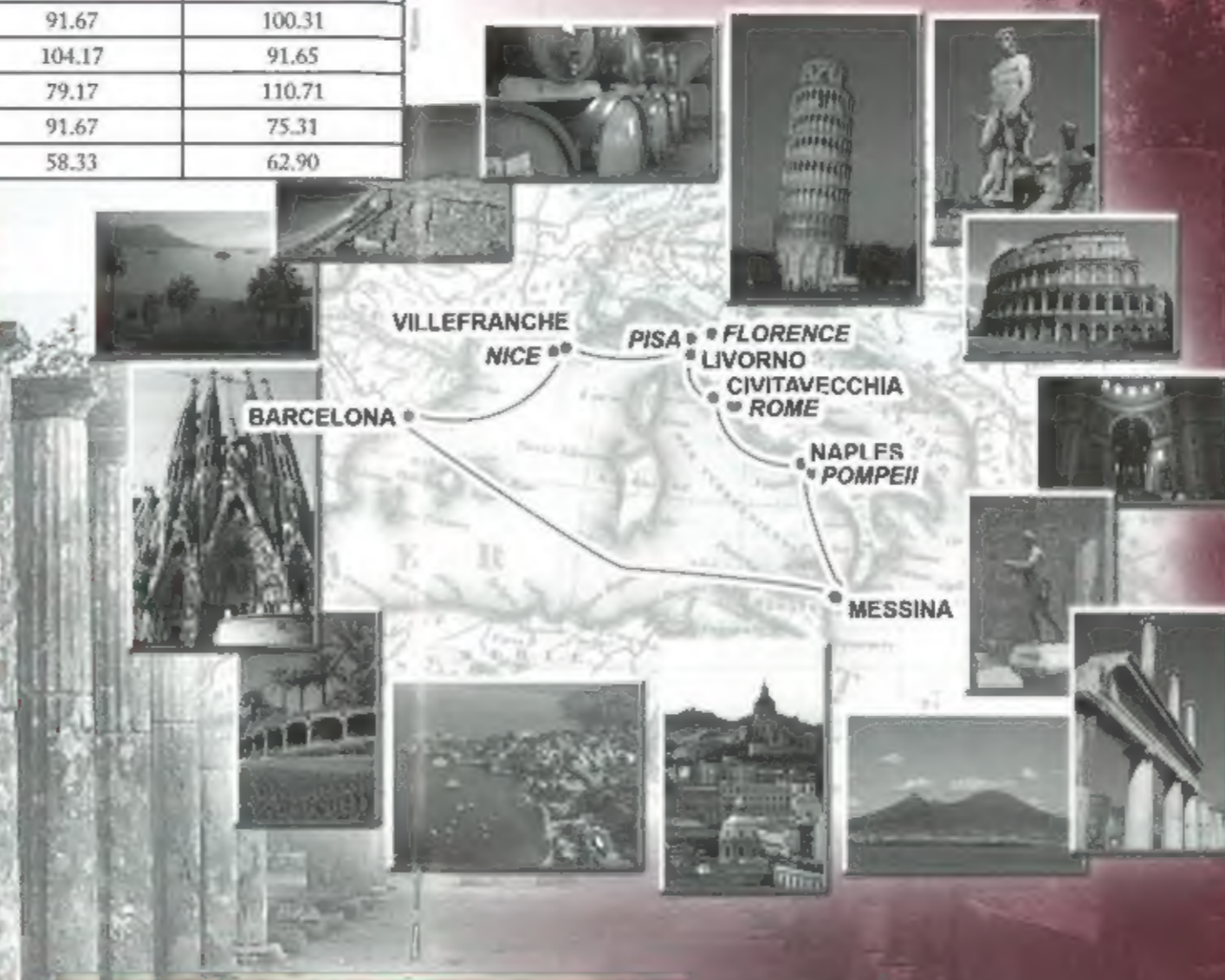

To be eligible, at least 30 percent of the cards must be from original groups, and the evaluation will be on cards processed by the Home Office within the contest duration. The top PR Rep from Category C will be eligible based on the number of groups submitted. Each group must have a minimum of 50 members and a 3 percent card return in order to count, and at least 30 percent of the groups must be originals.

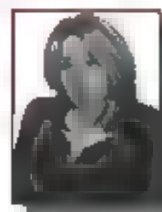

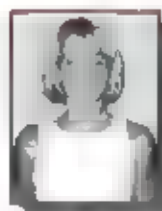

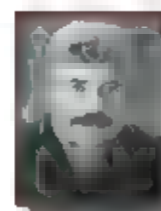
