

Arlene Holt Baker's experience as a union and grassroots organizer spans more than 30 years. On Sept. 21, 2007, she was approved unanimously as executive vice president by the AFL-CIO Executive Council, becoming the first African-American to be elected to one of the federation's three highest offices and the highest-ranking African-American woman in the union movement. In this position, Holt Baker builds on her legacy of inspiring activism and reaching out to diverse communities to support the needs and aspirations of working people.

One of seven children of a domestic worker and a laborer in Fort Worth, Texas, Holt Baker got her first job in high school through President Lyndon Johnson's poverty initiative. Working after school at the \$1.40-an-hour minimum wage, she earned higher hourly pay than her mother did working full time.

Holt Baker began her work in the labor movement with AFSCME. She moved through the ranks of AFSCME and, as an organizer and international union representative, was successful in helping to organize public-sector workers in California and helping them win contracts that provided better wages and pay equity for women.

As AFSCME's international union area director in California from the late 1980s to 1995, Holt Baker worked with AFSCME councils, locals, labor councils, and allies advocating for working families. Also in California, she helped run AFSCME's political activities, working with AFSCME councils and local leaders to mobilize union voters in numerous national, statewide, county, and municipal elections. Holt Baker was an active member of the Los Angeles County Federation of Labor.

During that time, she was appointed by then-California Speaker of Assembly Willie L. Brown Jr. to serve on the Comparable Worth Task Force Committee and also sat on the board of directors of the Southern California Industrial Relations Research Association. Holt Baker has received numerous civic awards for her work as a labor and community advocate.

She was an active member of the California Democratic Party, serving as a state delegate to the Democratic National Convention for the elections held between 1980 and 1996 and as first vice chair of the state Democratic Party from 1993 to 1996.

In 1995, Holt Baker came to the AFL-CIO as executive assistant to Executive Vice President Linda Chavez-Thompson. Her work included the successful campaign to defeat the anti-worker Prop. 226 in California, which was designed to weaken the voices of union members in the political process. She also was instrumental in organizing a massive labor-movement-wide show of support for the more than 20,000 migrant workers who pick and process strawberries in California, as the workers struggled to join a union through the Farm Workers.

As the first director of the AFL-CIO Voice@Work campaign in 1999, Holt Baker launched a dynamic movement to engage elected officials, clergy members, community leaders, and others in support of workers' freedom to form unions. In 2000, she ran the federation's member education and get-out-the-vote effort in the key swing state of Pennsylvania and later coordinated the AFL-CIO's Count Every Vote activity in the Florida recount.

Beginning in 2004, Holt Baker served as president of the nonpartisan voter education and mobilization effort Voices for Working Families, which registered and mobilized thousands of women and people of color to vote in underregistered communities.

She returned to the federation in 2006 to lead the AFL-CIO's Gulf Coast Recovery effort. That work has included partnering with the AFL-CIO Housing Investment Trust's Gulf Coast Revitalization Program and the Building Trades Gulf Coast Pilot Project to bring affordable housing and good jobs to people in the region. This also includes working closely with national and local advocates in fighting for the just rebuilding of the Gulf region.



Winning Universal Health Care State By State

A note from Mark Blum, Executive Director of America's Agenda: Health Care for All

America's struggles to win real health care reform legislation are always tough battles against the odds-citizen activists facing off against powerful. well-heeled and entrenched opponents of change. America's Agenda: Health Care for All has won some remarkable victories, nonetheless, in its state-by-state advance toward winning affordable, quality health care for all Americans.

America's Agenda is comprised of seasoned leaders from labor, politics, and business who share a vision of affordable cost and quality health care for all. Their commitment is absolute. The organization's mission is unique and vitally important for winning health care for all Americans.

We're building state-by-state momentum to win the health care reform America needs. The legislation we win in the states is providing the templates for health care reform Congress will ultimately enact.

The leaders of America's Agenda recognize the personal and political courage it takes to stand up and lead the fight for American health care reform. As union, labor, and elected government leaders, they have each stood at the front line of the fight. Some have paid a price for it themselves. So when America's Agenda selects an honoree like American Income Life CEO Roger Smith for recognition as a "Hero of Health Care," it is not a token gesture. This is a tribute for uncommon courage and exemplary leadership in the struggle to resolve the most urgent domestic concern facing the American people.

The Leadership of Roger Smith

In the summer of 2007, Illinois was in the final stage of a three-year process for enacting health care for all state residents prescribed in the Health Care Justice Act of 2003 sponsored by then-State Senator Barack Obama. Earlier in the session, a bill entitled Illinois Covered was introduced. If enacted, Illinois Covered and the tax reform to finance it would have achieved Senator Obama's objectives. The business community. led by the Illinois Chamber of Commerce, mounted a campaign of opposition.

America's Agenda President Doug Dority described the situation and commended Roger Smith's response to it in a letter to Roger:

It has proven to be a very tough battle. The Illinois Chamber of Commerce raised tens of millions of dollars and led an unprecedented business mobilization against the reform. Until you stepped up to the fight on behalf of AIL, Roger, not a single leader of a significant Illinois business had been willing to speak out against the Chamber's position. AIL's voice in Springfield, through your strong public letter and AIL's articulate spokesperson Rona Pileggi Spano prevented the Chamber from controlling their message on their largest lobby day this year. AIL's voice helped shatter the illusion that the Illinois Chamber of Commerce was the unchallenged voice of the Illinois business community. Even more important, your leadership showed the possibility of forging the kind of broad Labor-Business alliance that we need to win this struggle. Thank you for having the courage to stand up for principle, Roger, even against the tide of the state's organized business community.

In their public announcement of the award, America's Agenda wrote, "Roger Smith [...] stood up to defend health care reform in Illinois when no other corporate leader would. He challenged his fellow employers to join him in sharing responsibility for paying for universal health coverage. Roger Smith's leadership has begun to build bridges between labor and management that are needed to resolve the health care crisis."

Roger Smith's leadership in the battle for the health care reform America needs has elevated AIL's contribution to a new level- and to new expectations. America's Agenda President Doug Dority said it well: "I believe this struggle is the most important domestic issue facing our nation. It is the great moral and economic challenge of our time, and it is good to count you on our side, Roger. We're counting on your continuing leadership."

Notes of Importance

SEP IRA/PR Matching Bonus

To encourage each self-employed PR Rep and PR Manager to save for their retirement, AIL/NILICO offers each of you an opportunity to receive matching bonus contribution funds into a qualified retirement account as a self-employed PR person based on your years of service. The rules are slightly different for U.S. and Canadian contributions. It is important to review the appropriate regulations for specific details regarding contribution funds in the COPE 15, OPEIU 277, and CEP 247 union agreements. For more information, contact Amy Dechant via e-mail at adechant@ailife.com.

Advertising Materials and Scripts-Review and Approvals Required

Virtually all State and Provincial Insurance Departments have regulations concerning advertising. Most require any advertisement be reviewed and approved by the Home Office.

Our Company policy requires all materials the individual agencies may be using when dealing with prospects or policyholders, if not provided by American Income or National Income, to be forwarded to the Home Office for review. All lead letters must be approved prior to mailing. Be sure lead letters clearly state the AD&D coverage is provided through "American Income Life Insurance Company" or "National Income Life Insurance Company." The full company name should be used, not just American Income Life or National Income. Also, the lead letter should state "an American Income (or National Income) representative will be calling to set up an appointment to deliver the benefits and explain other insurance coverage available to them."

In addition to lead letters, any forms used, presentations, phone scripts, or letters sent to a policyholder regarding American Income or National Income, should be sent to the Home Office for review. We are not mandating that you use specific forms or scripts, but we do want to review what is being used when representing the Company prior to use. Once we complete the review, we will send confirmation that we have done so.

Did you know the states require that if any benefit is mentioned in a brochure or flyer, all limitations must also be detailed? And did you know if you refer to a recommendation by any commercial rating system (example A.M. Best) that you must clearly indicate the purpose of the recommendation and the limitations of the scope and extent of the recommendation?

Please make sure any ads you place when recruiting agents are not misleading in regards to the independent contractor position or compensation ranges anticipated, as they need to clearly understand their commissions are based on sales results.
