Activity, Achievers, and Kitchen Tables

Where are you right now?

I mean today in your life. Where do you stand in achieving your goals and life dreams? It is easy to find advice on achieving goals, but sometimes reflecting on where we are, and more importantly how we got to where we are, is the best place to start on the path to additional goal achievements. Doesn't it make sense that if all of who or what we are — and what talents we possess to take us to our dreams — are the very same qualities that have brought us to where we are today? It is not like you get a "do over" when it comes to your very being.

There is a saying that I really think evaluates the opportunity we have for success. It is "talent always loses to hard work when talent doesn't work hard." It's simple: the harder you're willing to work is the most significant attribute an achiever possesses.

I run into many types of people at AIL/NILICO, with all kinds of attitudes and approaches. It is easy to separate the winners from the losers and the complainers from the achievers:

Complainers whine about the lead.
Achievers run the lead.

Complainers monitor lead flow.
Achievers monitor referrals.

Complainers bemoan show ratios.
Achievers set an extra appointment.

Complainers discuss the equitableness of minimum standards.
Achievers view the minimums as the first level of failure.

Complainers moan about half as many prospects passing the licensing exams.
Achievers double the size of the pipeline.

Complainers feel the age of the prospect determines the viability of the appointment.
Achievers get the next generation's referral.

Complainers make excuses to satisfy themselves.
Achievers work until success cannot be denied.

Okay, let's take a look at that last one, since it is the most important. "Work until success" cannot be denied. Top agents with the best attitudes look at their prospects as owners of kitchen tables. That's right — owners of kitchen tables. If you can just get to your prospect's kitchen table fifteen times a week, then your success will not be denied. To get to the kitchen table fifteen times, it's understood that along the way there will be a no show, there will be those who are uninsurable, there might sometimes be a slammed door. But unless you get to the kitchen table, the ratios of success will work against you.

There needs to be an understanding about agent activity. There are tons of easy jobs as well as hard ones; there are jobs that pay a little and those which pay a lot. But there is no combination of jobs that are easy and pay a lot. The jobs that pay a lot are *hard jobs*.

Constant activity is not easy. It's hard, but it's required to achieve your goals. There is no trick here. It's all about effort and return on the effort you invest.

The average agent at AIL/NILICO is within just a couple of kitchen tables a week from meeting his or her true goals. But it isn't up to anyone but you, the agent, to achieve this. Sure, a bonus contest every once in a while provides a slight jump, but it takes an achiever to generate the level of activity to constantly enjoy success.

Activity is the answer. What's the question?

What makes an achiever?

CLUB QUALIFICATIONS

The President's Club and the Founder's Club were introduced to recognize and reward our hard-working Producers. Membership in either Club is an achievement to be proud of, and those who qualify for the 2008 President's Club or Founder's Club will receive a commemorative ring (or pendant) and a monetary prize.

PRESIDENT'S CLUB

FOR INDIVIDUAL PRODUCERS:

- Produce \$110,000 of Net ALP in the calendar year.
- Have an 80% four-month retention rate as of December 31, 2008.
- Eight full months tenure as an active Producer.

PUBLIC RELATIONS REPRESENTATIVES:

- Generate 28,800 lead cards in a calendar year OR
- Obtain 115 TGs (groups)* plus have 14,400 cards.

* For a group to count towards qualification, the group must have a 50 member minimum and have a three percent return with a minimum of 10 cards.

First Time Qualifiers receive a President's Club ring (or pendant) and \$1,000.

Each subsequent qualification earns a diamond added to ring (or pendant) of qualifier OR a ring (or pendant) for spouse, AND the \$1,000 bonus will be increased 10% for each successive qualification.

Qualifiers will be eligible to come in one day early to Convention.



FOUNDER'S CLUB

FOR INDIVIDUAL PRODUCERS:

- Produce \$11,000 of Net ALP for 4 consecutive months.
- Maintain a 77% or above four-month retention rate.
- 8 full months tenure as active agent.

PUBLIC RELATIONS REPRESENTATIVES:

- 2,300 lead cards per month for four consecutive months OR
- 9 TGs (groups*) per month for four consecutive months with combined minimum 5,750 members per month.

* Group must have a minimum of 50 members and have a 3% response rate before it will count as a group toward qualification.

First Time Qualifiers receive a Founder's Club ring and \$500.

Each subsequent qualification earns a diamond added to ring of qualifier OR a ring for spouse, AND \$500.

HOME OFFICE HELPFUL HINTS

We asked the different departments at the Home Office to supply hints and tips for the agents and PR representatives in the field. These suggestions are designed to help alleviate potential issues that may arise when working with the Home Office or a policyowner, and we hope you find them to be beneficial additions to your established routine of submitting business.



1) The agent should always supply a voided check with the application, if the mode of payment is bank draft.
2) The NB application should be signed by the Payor, if it is different from the insured.

- 3) NB checks are deposited the day after the case is submitted. They are not held until the policy is approved and issued.
- 4) Only write "ADD TO" on a NB application if you are adding coverage. If the intent is to have the NB paid at the same time as existing coverage, then write "BILL WITH" on the top of the app. "Add to" implies "add on" which is something entirely different than combining the billing in the household.
- 5) At NB, if the agent collects excess premium that is more than \$1.99, he/she will run the risk of not being advanced on the total CWA collected, especially with younger age applicants.
- 6) Please place the oral specimen sticker in the "Remarks" section of the app, if possible.



1) Mail Oral kits more efficiently. Every SGA office has the ability to send their oral kits via overnight mail directly to the lab. The account information to do this free of charge has been provided. Why would you want to do this? Fast turnaround and guaranteed delivery. The quicker the kit gets to the lab, the quicker we can offer a policy! Guaranteed delivery means that when you mark your list for an oral completed and put in the overnight package, it is going to get to the lab. Save yourself the worry of a lost or delayed kit. E-mail Alan Palmer today to get this great process started if you haven't already done so.

- 2) Underwriting will accept a three-way call from the agent when he/she has the applicant on the other line. This is useful when the Home Office is having difficulty contacting the client; many times, an agent will be able to locate the customer and place a call to the Home Office with the customer already on the phone. Call in to the Customer Relations toll-free at 800-

411-8808. Once we connect with the applicant, you can exit the conversation and we will complete the call. This is a great tool to reduce your Underwriting Bulletin.

- 3) We sometimes receive calls or e-mail inquiring why we declined. As you know, disclosure is tightly regulated by state privacy acts, and the penalties for improper disclosure are severe. The language in our decline letter advises the applicant we can't furnish this information over the phone. Our decline letter explains to the applicant the procedure by which they can obtain the reason for the decline. Due to the privacy regulations, we cannot disclose to the agent the reason for the decline, so there is no reason to call or e-mail for this information. Just explain to the applicant the reason you cannot get this information for them and ask them to write or e-mail us. The exception would be an application that has been postponed. We will be happy to review new information on postponed applications once the 3 month, 6 month, or 1 year time frame has elapsed.
- 4) Please provide complete correct doctor information on every application and complete all appropriate questionnaires. A local phone book is a great tool to have. If you don't have one, ask your applicant if you can borrow theirs. See if you can locate the doctor they give you and list all of the information you can find — name, address, and phone number.
- 5) Please advise the applicant at the time of sale that he/she may be asked to take a physical exam that may include a blood draw.
- 6) Be sure to only record medical history for a person who is only applying for A71000 or Cancer coverage in the appropriate places on the application.
- 7) Do not collect money if the face amount is \$500,000 or more for an adult or \$100,000 or more for a minor.
- 8) When applying for large amounts on children, please provide the amount of coverage the parents have in force. If someone has guardianship of a child other than the parent and we can't obtain parent consent, the maximum issue amount is \$5,000. Grandparents can now purchase up to \$25,000 in coverage on their grandchildren without parent signature.



1) Did you know there is a chart on the Agency Resource Center under POS that will give you the correct draft date for any issue date? You'll never have to count 14 days on your fingers, remember the 14-day rule, or make a mistake again.

- 2) Make sure that the insured knows that an A71 policy covers treatment in an emergency room within 72 hours of an accident. It does not cover emergency room treatment for illness.
- 3) When you make a POS call and increase coverage, make sure the policyholder understands that the existing policy will not change, and they will be receiving an additional policy for the additional coverage.
- 4) Avoid calling the Home Office during the lunch periods when at all possible or using the 1-800 number without a policyowner on the line with you. We have limited phone coverage during our lunch hours — 11:45am - 12:45pm CST and 1:00pm - 2:00pm CST — and need to be available to service our policyholders that call in. We also have the 1-800 number for the benefit of our policyholders.
- 5) Do not accept post-dated checks, as we are not able to hold them.
- 6) It is very important that the POLICIES TO BE CHANGED section of the Policy Service Request Form is filled out, listing all policies that are to be changed.
- 7) Accurately complete the bank information on the application and include a voided check from the account that we will be drafting.
- 8) On an application for conversion of a portion of a term rider, tell us what needs to happen with the balance — is it being cancelled, do you want to leave it as term coverage, etc.
- 9) Actually speak to the policyholder and get their okay before asking the Home Office to redraft for premium due. Make sure the policyholder knows the total amount of the redraft. Depending on the circumstances, it can be far more than one month's premium.
- 10) If you complete a Summary Sheet and the applicant decides on different coverage, start over with a new sheet and don't leave the old one. Also, please don't make side notes on the Summary Sheet that only you can interpret. This will help eliminate confusion at a later date.

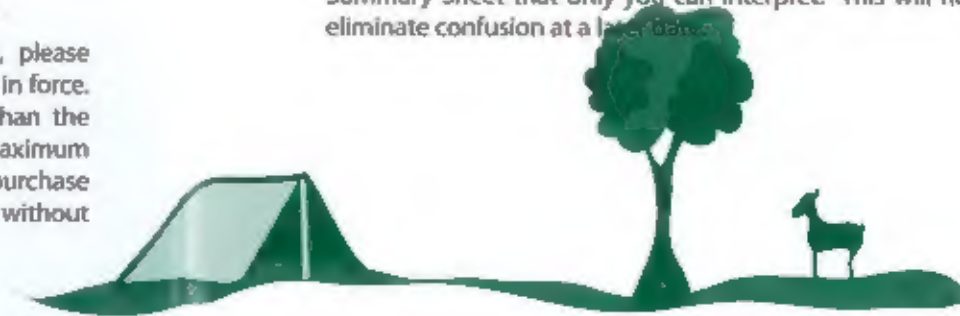

Agents at all levels must have a current license (or continuing education verification, if required) and must make us aware any time something is done that could change the status of the current license (like changing resident states). We cannot put business on unless we have verification that everyone in the hierarchy has a current license. We send out reminders asking for updated information on anyone who has a license expiring in the next 90 days.

For anyone who has a management level of contract, remember that managers have a special responsibility — not only to communicate the importance of keeping the license up to date — but to lead by example. Please send in your renewals as early as possible and instruct everyone in your agency to do the same. Consider that things could occur that are beyond your control that could delay the renewal and/or cause a lapse in your license. If you send the renewal early, there should be plenty of time to work out any unanticipated bumps in the renewal process and ensure you are able to continue to submit business and receive advances.

Remember: License = Livelihood



Edward J. McElroy



McElroy began his career as a social studies and English teacher in Warwick, Rhode Island and was elected president of the Warwick Teachers Union, Local 915, in 1967. At age 30, he became president of the Rhode Island Federation of Teachers, a position he held until he was elected AFT secretary-treasurer. As president of the RIFT, McElroy personally handled numerous negotiations and arbitrations. McElroy served as president of the Rhode Island AFL-CIO from 1977 until 1992 and earned a reputation as a unifier and effective representative of public and private sector unions.

McElroy has led efforts to strengthen and uphold financial and accountability requirements at every level of the union. He has been at the forefront of the AFT's initiatives to harness technology to support, inform, and mobilize union members.

While serving on the AFT executive council, McElroy was instrumental in launching the Futures Committee, a panel of AFT vice presidents who spent two years consulting with AFT leaders and members to shape a new direction for the union in its governance and structure. The resulting constitutional amendments enhanced the role of constituencies outside the AFT's K-12 teacher division and made other recommendations on strategic planning, financial practices for affiliates, and establishing priorities for the AFT. That process is ongoing.

McElroy is a leader in a wide range of community, civic, and labor organizations. He is chairman of the board of the Department for Professional Employees of the AFL-CIO — a coalition of 25 national unions representing 4 million professional, technical, and administrative professionals. He serves on numerous AFL-CIO committees, including the Executive Committee, and is chair of the Committee on State and Local Strategies. McElroy also serves on the board of directors of ULLICO.

Edward J. McElroy currently serves as President of the American Federation of Teachers. Prior to his election as AFT president in 2004, McElroy served 12 years as AFT secretary-treasurer. He joined the AFT Executive Council in 1974 and was re-elected as a vice president every two years until his election as secretary-treasurer. A longtime educator and labor leader, McElroy also serves on the executive council of the AFL-CIO, to which he was elected in December 2001.

The AFT is one of the fastest-growing labor unions in the United States, representing workers in education, healthcare and government services. During McElroy's tenure as a national officer, the AFT has added more than 500,000 new members. The union's commitment to professionalism and to advancing the well-being of its members as well as the people they serve is reflected in McElroy's background and priorities.

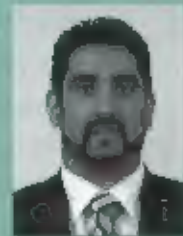
