t's a tradition for the July Spotlight magazine to feature a section dedicated

to reaffirming Why We Do What We Do in preparation for Life Insurance Awareness month in September. We all know that what we do can sometimes feel a little crazy even in the best of times, and we all periodically need to be reminded of the real reasons we do what we do — see **pages 16–17.**

Put those two scenarios together and it's easy to see the financial uncertainty that can occur when a family income provider is no longer here.

By far, my favorite part of the WWDWWD issue each year is reading the stories we get from the field about a claim that really brought home to them how vital what we do truly is. The first time you have the privilege of helping a family navigate the claims process is very special. If you haven't gone through the process from the other side, as a grieving loved one, that first time can be a real learning experience. That family may be leaning hard on you for support. You learn compassion, patience, and humility, that's for sure. Once you've been at it awhile like Max Quasem, you'll have so many outstanding stories, it will be hard to choose just one. As different as these stories may seem, the

takeaway from all of them is essentially the same: a sense of urgency should accompany us to every home, whether virtually or face-toface. It's vital that your clients understand how important protecting their families is - NOW. TODAY. Help them understand that waiting, procrastinating, thinking it over are options not everyone gets. Read Josh West's story.

That sense of urgency goes both ways. No matter how tired or hungry you may be towards the end of the day, you owe it to that last family not only to show up but to give them the best presentation you can deliver.

They deserve your best no less than anyone else you have ever seen or will ever see. Every opportunity to help a family is important. All it could take is one forgotten phone call to change the course of a family's life. Check out Ashley Rust's story.

Most of the time, when we're making initial contact with a potential client, we only get one shot at it. Treat it like it's a matter of life or death. Financially speaking, it very well could be. Make it count. 🛛

- Hundreds of Baskets of Hope delivered by Team PR to families in need

I've been with AIL for 35 years now, and I will always remember the individuals and families personally impacted by the delivery of a claim check. Providing this assistance in the greatest time of need is a very humbling experience.

The financial relief that a claim check provides and the extreme gratitude in a family's emotional and uncertain time is exactly why we do what we do. 🛛





Before Steve joined as coach, the team was just over .500 through the preceding 3 seasons. The first year with Steve, the Warriors set a franchise record with a 67-15 season.





was servicing a policyholder, updating her beneficiary I information, and one of the beneficiaries was there at the house. I rolled the referral into a presentation and through rapport building, found out that he had a total of 10 children. Her oldest son called his wife over, because they had just been speaking about getting insurance the week before. Since his mother had been happy with us for the past 16 years, he wanted to go with her company. As we started going through the app, I found out that his oldest daughter was 18 and already a mother. Two months later, the wife called me and told me that the 18-year-old daughter had died coming home from her graduation party; she couldn't find her folder and needed the certificate for the funeral home. I was with a trainee and in a presentation, and excused myself to take the call. As soon as I finished, I headed to meet the client at the funeral home, with the death claim and extra Freedom of Choice certificates. The family sent a handwritten thank you note, for cooperation and patience, and we sent flowers to the funeral. Taking care of the whole family became my number one priority from that day forward.

T have been doing this for 17 years, and I have many stories to tell!

- I wrote a policy for nurse Lupe within my first six months with AIL. She referred her sister to me, and I was able to provide coverage for her family as well. Six months later, the brother-inlaw Lupe referred died of a sudden heart attack. Needless to say, he did not have a heart issue nor was he taking any meds when we did the app. Because the policy was within the first two years, the family was not sure we would pay the claim. Medical records showed he had no medical issues, and the claim was paid.

- I had an appointment one evening for Rosa and her husband, who did not really like insurance and did not want to talk about it. Rosa wanted \$100,000 on him because she also had \$100,000. He was difficult but did sign the app. A year later, he died on his way home in his truck. I got the call on a Saturday afternoon from his heartbroken wife, who was in desperate need. Funeral arrangements were handled the following Thursday with help from Home Office.

- I just updated a policy in August of 2019 for 39-year-old nurse Jennifer, a single mom with two kids. Her mom called me July 12, 2020 to report that Jennifer had died that morning of upper respiratory failure. She could not find her daughter's folder but had my card. I sat on the phone with her and provided her with all that she needed to do.

I got a call from the dad asking if all the kids were covered on the policy, and I let him know all the kids under 18 were covered under the term rider. He informed me that his 22-year-old son had died suddenly, and he was down in Florida. I remember him asking if I could set coverage up for him, but because he was out of state and over 18, I wasn't able to get him a policy. His parents were supposed to contact me when he came home at Christmas and they forgot. This is a prime example of how short life is and why waiting until next time shouldn't be an option. I felt so terrible that I couldn't have helped them more by writing a policy for their son. But he made sure all of his older kids and their families were covered because they didn't have the \$16,000 for the son's funeral.

My most memorable claim story isn't actually mine; it's from an agent of mine who has been one of my best friends since kindergarten. He moved to Indiana from Ohio last year, after leaving his job hanging gutters. Shortly into his career, he wrote up a referral that he collected from a union member. The parents were both uninsurable so he wrote up a Head Start on their child for \$25,000. Less than 24 hours later, all three of them were killed in a highway accident that made the news here in Indiana, and the grandparents called our office because they found the AIL folder on their kitchen table. Extremely sad, but that claim was able to pay for all three funerals and AIL paid it out immediately.
