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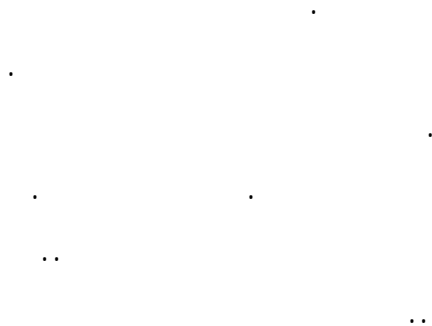

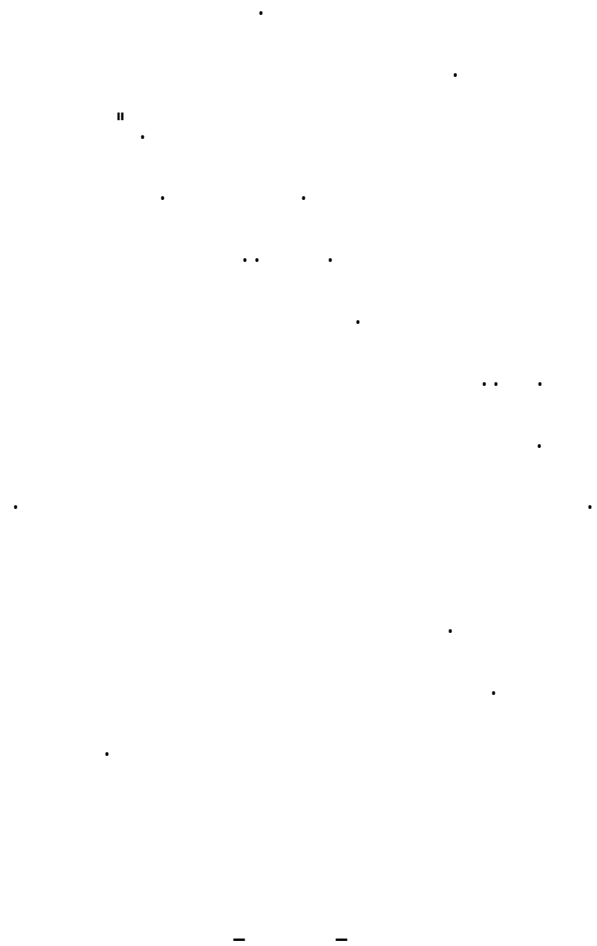


Figure 1. Relationship between the number of children and the number of children in the household.
