INTRODUCTION

A HISTORY OF THE RISE AND PROGRESS OF THE BAPTISTS IN ALABAMA by Hosea Holcombe, Minister of the Gospel, was published in 1840 in Philadelphia by King and Baird, Printers, No. 9 George Street. The HISTORY was written at the request of the Alabama State Convention. Not all churches and associations responded to the letters of Elder Holcombe, who wrote to ask them to send their records and history to him at his home in Jonesboro. Some reports were very sketchy.

The State Convention in Alabama was formed in October, 1823, at Salem Church, near Greensboro; "chiefly through the instrumentality of Rev. J.A. Ranaldson, of Louisiana." The objects of the Convention were to aid in foreign and domestic missions, and the education of pious and intelligent young men called to the ministry."

Elder Holcombe has not included very much biographical material on the Elders and Ministers he names. Often he tells when they professed religion and commenced preaching, and, when recording their death, he tells where and when they were born.

It is the hope of the compiler that this INDEX will assist family historians in learning some things about their ancestors who were prominent in the early Baptist churches in Alabama. Sample of the information: Page 159.

"Bethel. This is likewise in Marengo County. It was constituted in 1828, Elders Fluker, Perkins, and Baker, and William Clark have served in years past; and we suppose Elder John Whitehead is their pastor at present."

Page 188.

Sardis. In 1819, Elders Edmund Pace and Nathan Roberts organized this church with 11 members, and the next year Elder Medy White was called to the pastoral care, who served them until 1825, when Elder William McKee was chosen pastor."


